OFFICIALS IN WASHINGTON, D. C.:

BUFFALO DIV. WAS ADVISED BY WFO THAT ON FEB. 27, 1985, LETTERS CONTAINING DEATH THREATS WERE RECEIVED BY SUPREME COURT JUSTICES BLACKMUN AND POWELL. THESE LETTERS BORE RETURN ADDRESSES AND NAMES OF INDIVIDUALS IN THE BUFFALO, NY AREA, IN ADDITION TO POSTMARKS REFLECTING THEY HAD BEEN MAILED FROM BUFFALO TO WASHINGTON, D.C. ON FEB. 28, 1985, BUFFALO DIV. WAS ADVISED THAT SENATOR ALFONSE D'AMATO RECEIVED AN IDENTICAL LETTER WITH A BUFFALO POSTMARK AND RETURN ADDRESS.

INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED BY BUFFALO DIV. INCLUDED THE LOCATION AND INTERVIEW OF THE INDIVIDUALS LISTED AS SENDERS OF THESE LETTERS. ONE OF THE INDIVIDUALS WAS LOCATED AND INTERVIEWED BY BUAGENTS IN TOLEDO, OHIO. ALL DISCLAIMED KNOWLEDGE OF THE THREATENING LETTERS AND INDICATED THEY KNEW OF NO REASON WHY THEIR NAMES WERE LISTED AS THE SENDERS. ALL EXPRESSED WILLINGNESS TO UNDERGO POLYGRAPH EXAMINATION. INVESTIGATION FAILED TO INDICATE A COMMON DENOMINATOR OR BOND AMONG THE THREE INDIVIDUALS.

DURING THE AFTERNOON AND EVENING OF MONDAY, MARCH 4, 1985, VARIOUS NATIONAL WIRE SERVICES RAN A STORY REGARDING THE RECEIPT OF THE LETTERS AND THE FACT THAT A SHOT HAD BEEN FIRED INTO

JUSTICE BLACKMUN'S RESIDENCE. THIS STORY RECEIVED WIDE-SPREAD MEDIA ATTENTION IN THE BUFFALO AREA DURING THE EVENING OF MARCH 4, 1985 AND THE MORNING OF MARCH 5, 1985. AS A RESULT OF THIS MEDIA EXPOSURE, THE BUFFALO DIV. RECEIVED NUMEROUS TELEPHONE CALLS FROM LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IN THE WESTERN NEW YORK AREA INDICATING THAT NUMEROUS GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS ON THE STATE, COUNTY AND LOCAL LEVELS RECEIVED IDENTICAL DEATH THREAT LETTERS AS THOSE RECEIVED BY BLACKMUN, POWELL AND D'AMATO.

BUFFALO DIV. HAS INITIATED COORDINATION OF INVESTIGATIVE EFFORTS ON THE PART OF ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES TO FULLY DEVELOP FACTS OF CASE AND IDENTITY OF SENDER OF LETTERS.

On 8/8/86, the Office of Special Investigations of the AIR FORCE, Bolling Air Force Base, telephone (301) 767-5751, advised that they received information that a letter conveying a bomb threat was received in the Office of the Assistant Vice Chief of Staff of the AIR FORCE Major General CARL SMITH in The Pentagon, Room 4E944, telephone (202) 695-7911. The letter was opened by a secretary in that office, [redacted] who was said to have been the only person to have handled the letter. It was turned over to the FEDERAL PROTECTIVE SERVICE in The Pentagon for safe keeping.

The letter was postmarked 8/4/86, from Buffalo, New York, and inside the envelope was one sheet of paper saying in typed letters, "A bomb is going to exploded where you work soon." An explosive's team was dispatched but failed to locate any bomb.
