Mario Savio, leader of the Free Speech Movement, has been on the payroll of the philosophy department at the University of California in Berkeley since October.

Employed as a reader at \$2.97 per hour, he drew a check for \$15.53 on Feb. 8 while out on bail pending trial for his part in the Dec. 3 sit-in demonstration at Sproul Hall.

His payroll form was cleared by the administrailin in October, after he had been suspended for his part in the initial Free Speech demonstrations.

As late as January, while ne was no longer a student, he was called in for 71/2 hours work. As of yesterday his card still was in the files as a reader.

Readers are employed to review and suggest a grade on examination papers. Over the years this work has been done, for pay, by graduate students and in some instances by senior students. Savio was a junior at the time his application was le ce ved and accepted.

Bavio was hired on the approval of Joseph Tussman, head of the Department of Philosophy, who acted upon the recommendation of Prof. John Searle.

Tussman has been an outspoken advocate of the Free

Searle, in a TV discussion the provisions contained in the mitial statement adopted by the Academic Senate in support of the FSM, a state ment which later was modify fied.


Seatle was an unsuccessful candidate in a faculty election naming members of the special Academic Senate committee which dealt with the Board of Regents and administration on the FSM problem.
