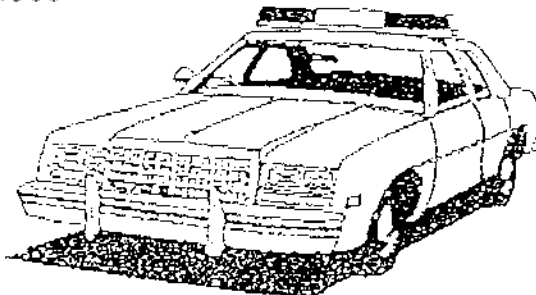
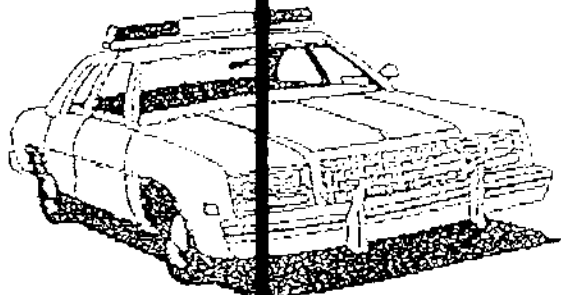

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Some interesting activity this weekend involving my department.

I am FAXing the reports from my department, but basically this is what occurred.

Our Car #2 (Chevrolet Tahoe) was parked in front of our station while the officer was inside the station doing a report. Another officer drives by the front and sees a person by the Tahoe taking pictures with a video camera. He calls the station to advise the other officers and talks to the subject. The subject was taking a video of the back of the Tahoe where "someone" placed a confederate flag sticker. Upon further investigation by the officers a second party sitting in a car about 50 yards away gets out, it is [redacted] from the Hudson Valley Black Press. Upon questioning by the officers [redacted] states that they were driving through and saw the sticker. Unfortunately some words were exchanged (see report) and it is ended. About twenty minutes later a reporter from the Times Herald Record calls and states they received an anonymous tip about this incident.

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From what the officers' state this sticker was only just put on. The driver of the vehicle did not see any stickers on the vehicle when he started his shift at 4 PM (I was in the Tahoe on Friday and saw no stickers on it). We do not put any stickers on our vehicles other than the yearly Back to School ones. The officer that saw the video taping cannot be sure if he saw that subject place it on the vehicle. The sticker's corner was not secured and the officers think that this was done so it could be peeled off again.

The Officers called me right away when this incident occurred. They also called when the reporter called and stated to talk to me on Monday. I think we were set up. I have no reasons to doubt these officers on how this incident occurred and this type of alleged activity is out of character for any of my current officers.

Interesting note [redacted] pre-trial was started on [redacted] in the Town of Newburgh. [redacted] is part of it I believe. It is my gut feeling that this event is not a coincidence.

This statement is made voluntarily, without coercion and of my own free will:

Tonight, February 10, 2001 at approximately 8:36pm while working the 6pm to 12 midnight shift as a uniformed police officer for the Village of Walden Police Department. I pulled up in the front of the police station at One Municipal Square I saw a rebel flag sticker on the rear of vehicle #2 and observed a white male crouching behind the rear passenger side of Walden Police vehicle # 2. As I got closer I saw this individual had a video camera and was taping the rear of P.D. Vehicle #2. When I exited my vehicle the individual taping stood up and started to walk away. I called to this person and he ignored me and I repeated for him to come back to where he was taping. The person who was crouched behind car 2 was reaching towards the car and the sticker when I first pulled up in my vehicle. I can not say with 100% certainty, but it appeared the person taping had placed the sticker on car 2. I questioned this person who stated he was in the area and saw the sticker so he decided to tape it. At this time Officers [redacted] and [redacted] approached and had conversations with the person who I had identified by a New York State picture license as [redacted]

This statement is made voluntarily, without coercion and of my own free will:

Tonight at approximately 8:30 PM I was working a 4 PM to midnight shift in uniform when Officer [redacted] had called on the radio that he would be out in front of the police station with a subject that appeared to be putting a sticker on a police car. Officer [redacted] and myself walked outside to assist Officer [redacted]. We approached the rear of marked car 2 where Officer [redacted] and the subject were standing. The subject identified himself as [redacted] by producing a NYS driver's license. He stated that he observed the sticker on the car and thought it would be interesting to "tape" it. I then asked him what he meant by "tape" it. He said that he meant video tape it, and showed me a video camera. He said that he was driving around the village when he saw the sticker on the car. I asked him where he was when he saw the sticker on the car. He looked around and said that he was driving around the traffic circle. I told him that I thought he was lying and asked him where his car was. He pointed out an older Oldsmobile 4D color Gray parked in front of the Pius office on Scofield Street. I walked toward the car and observed more people inside of it. [redacted] followed me so I told him to stay with the other officers. [redacted] got out of the rear passenger side of the car. I recognized him from concerts where I saw him taking pictures years ago. I asked him who he worked for. He stated that he worked for the Hudson Valley Black Press. I said "that figures". He then asked what I had against the Black Press. I told him that I had nothing against it until they try to set me up. He stated that they did not put the sticker on the car and that they were just driving around the area. I told him that he was full of shit and he was lying. I told him that I did not appreciate being set up. As I walked away, I told them that they were the biggest racists of all.

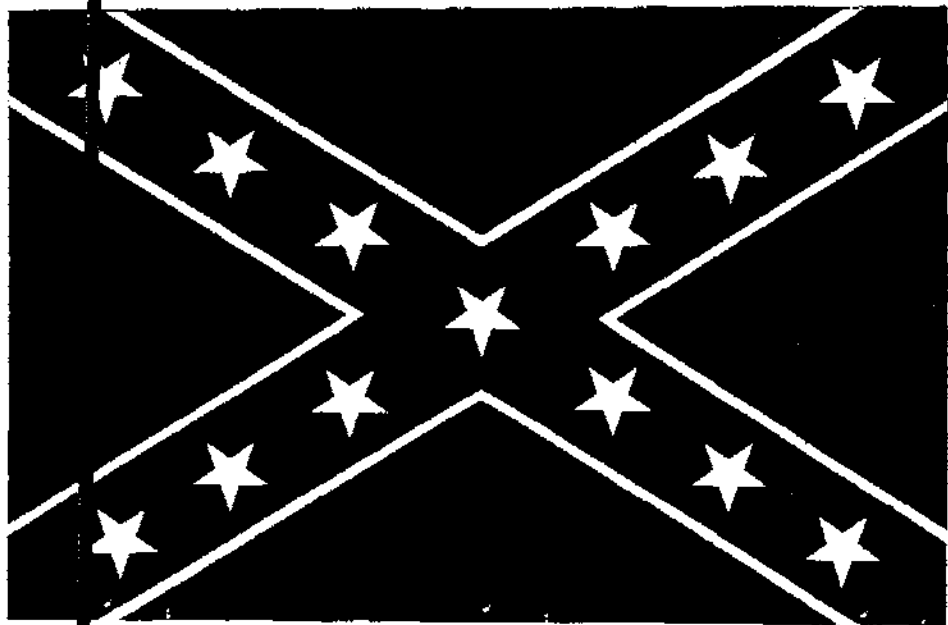

Synopsis: Case predicated on complaint of [redacted] to Congressman MAURICE HINCHEY alleging his prior complaints to FBI, Hudson Valley Resident Agency (HVRA), were ignored. Records reflect multiple visits to FBI, HVRA, by [redacted] complaining of receipt of hate mail. Each and every time [redacted] refused to turn over original letters for processing. By letter of May 23, 2000, [redacted] was formally requested to provide original hate letters to FBI, including respective dates of receipt and the identities of all individuals handling these letters. He responded that these letters "were no longer in his possession and were turned over to the Hudson Valley Black Press (HVBP)" without any additional specificity. Attempts to pursue this matter with [redacted] HVBP, met with negative results. [redacted] although ostensibly cooperative, was not responsive to repeated requests by Special Agent (SA) [redacted] to pursue this matter. Case closed per SAC authority.

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DETAILS:

This case is predicated upon receipt of an undated USDOJ CRU letter to FBI, Albany, enclosing Congressman MAURICE D. HINCHEY's letter of January 10, 2000, setting out copies of hate mail received by [redacted] HVBP.

suspects were developed with respect to the above telephone

On August 12, 1999, [REDACTED] HVBP, Newburgh, New York, personally furnished a copy of a pamphlet circulated by "Stop Big Brother" which he had found attached to his auto windshield. He acknowledged the pamphlet contained no threats. He refused to furnish the original pamphlet for processing.

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Reference NY/EC dated August 16, 1999, captioned "STOP BIG BROTHER, BOX 281, OTISVILLE, NEW YORK, FILE [REDACTED] This information was forwarded to the JTTF, NYO, for review and disposition. No active investigation was initiated.

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OCTOBER 1999

[REDACTED] appeared at the NBRA on October 22, 1999 and advised he had learned that the self appointed local Klu Klux Klan (KKK) Leader [REDACTED] had scheduled a Klan demonstration on his property, Montgomery, New York and that the local Klan planned to burn a cross there.

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Investigation reflected that this story had already been printed in another local newspaper based upon information provided by a local Cleric, [REDACTED]

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This event never occurred.

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[REDACTED] again visited the NBRA on October 28, 1999 and furnished copies of four envelopes and hate notes he received in the mail. [REDACTED] refused to turn over the originals for processing.

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DECEMBER 1999

[REDACTED] visited the NBRA and was interviewed by SA [REDACTED] at the request of United States Department of Justice (USDOJ) Attorney [REDACTED] Civil Rights Unit (CRU). [REDACTED] has been calling [REDACTED] directly during the prior six

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month period and also leaving numerous messages on his voice mail regarding the above complaints. [redacted] reiterated his complaints about hate mail that he received but once again refused to turn over any original documents for processing.

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[redacted] complained that he received four (4) moving violations from the NEW YORK STATE POLICE (NYSP) because he is Caucasian and works for the HVBP. On January 12, 2000, [redacted] NYSP, Internal Affairs Bureau (IAB), advised SA [redacted] that [redacted] complaints were investigated and deemed unfounded. He further advised that after filing an initial complaint, [redacted] became uncooperative.

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[redacted] further alleged that the NYSP gave him speeding tickets because they were secret Klan members. In response to SA [redacted] inquiry, [redacted] acknowledged that two of the troopers were African American, but still insisted they both were Klan members.

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[redacted] further alleged that [redacted] self-appointed local KKK leader had publicly announced that 60-80 local police officers are secret Klan members. He had no additional evidence to support this.

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[redacted] advised [redacted] HVBP has been receiving hate phone calls. [redacted] was advised to tell [redacted] to contact the NBRA if he wished to pursue the matter.

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On January 21, 2000, [redacted] was recontacted by SA [redacted]. He advised that more hate flyers had been placed on his auto windshield. He once again refused to turn over the originals. [redacted] advised that USDOJ Attorney [redacted] told him not to turn any original documents to the FBI. On January 21, 2000, [redacted] was contacted by SA [redacted] and advised of [redacted] statement. [redacted] stated that he never gave any such instructions to [redacted].

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The following investigation was conducted by Special Agent (SA) [redacted] Federal Bureau of Investigation:

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On June 13, 2000, [redacted] Hudson Valley Black Press (HVBP), 343 Broadway, Newburgh, New York, was contacted and told that [redacted]

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[redacted] had indicated that the originals of some hate mail he had received had been given to the HVBP. [redacted] advised that he may have the originals but is not sure and would have to check his files. He did not recall when or if [redacted] gave them to him nor if other employees have had access to them. Copies of the hate mail were forwarded to him for his perusal (copies appended hereto).

[redacted] advised that the HVBP has been receiving hate calls since 1987. The City of Newburgh Police Department (CNPD) had investigated the matter a few years ago without success. [redacted] stated the calls have no pattern but it sounds like the same "white guy". A typical call might be "fucking niggers go back to Africa". He was advised to keep a log and to utilize call-back function and/or #57 to trap any incoming calls and that this matter would be discussed in person with him.

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On June 16, 2000, attempts to telephonically contact [redacted] met with negative results. A message was left at the HVBP to have him call writer to schedule an appointment to discuss [redacted] hate mail and the harassing calls to the HVBP.

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On July 3, 2000, [redacted] left a return message on writer's voice mail.

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On July 10, 2000, an attempt to telephonically contact [redacted] upon writer's return from vacation met with negative results. A message was left for [redacted] to contact writer for an appointment.

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On July 13, 2000 writer contacted [redacted] at the HVBP. [redacted] advised he was extremely busy and had a death in the family and would be unavailable for the next 7-10 days. He was asked if he had attempted to locate any of [redacted] original hate letters. He said he did not look for them yet and was not sure where they are or if he even has these documents.

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On July 25, 27, and 31, 2000, attempts to contact [redacted] telephonically at HVBP met with negative results. HVBP staff stated he was not in the office. On each occasion, writer

HINCHEY, U.S. Congressman, 26th District of New York attempted to board U.S. Air Shuttle #6490 from Washington National Airport (DCA) to New York, at which time it was determined that he had in his carry on baggage a Walther PPK, 7.62 automatic pistol. The security personnel immediately advised the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority Police Department, (MWAAPD), who arrested HINCHEY for the possession of a dangerous article at the airport.

HINCHEY upon interview stated that he had forgotten that the weapon was in his bag, in that he had been in a hurry during a transition period, and had not realized that the weapon was still in his bag that he grabbed and hastily packed. HINCHEY expressed remorse for the incident and stated that he was completely embarrassed by this incident, and stated that he would be more careful in the future.

NCIC inquiries met with negative results relative to the weapon, and HINCHEY. The weapon was confiscated by the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority Police Department. HINCHEY appeared before an Arlington County Magistrate at which time he entered a no contest plea, and surrendered the weapon.

AUSA [redacted] advised that in view of the local prosecution, no further investigation should be conducted, and this matter should be closed.

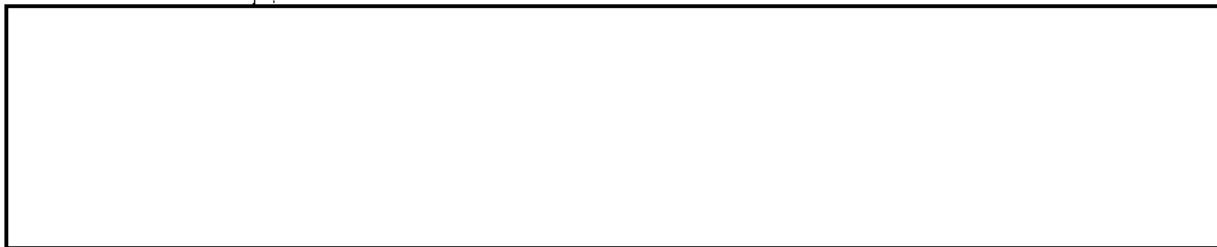
