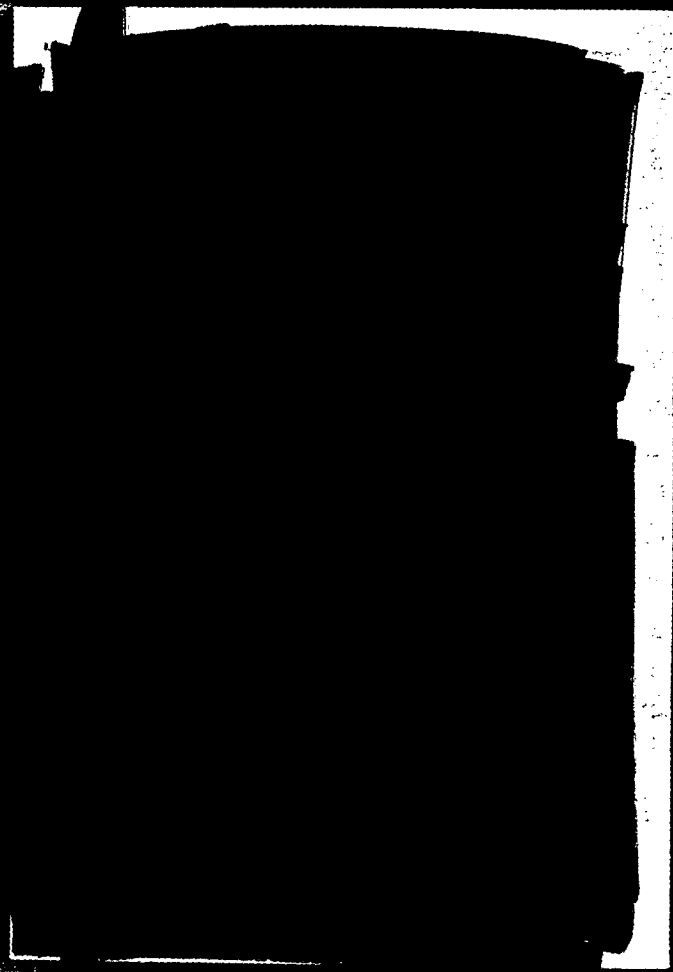



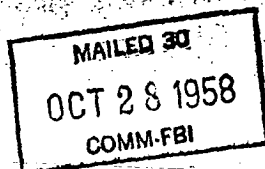

1. Marital Status

ANNE CITRON LANSKY

On June 9, 1958, files of the Dade County Circuit Court, Miami, Florida, were reviewed by SA [REDACTED] Under No: 106443, they reflect the following:

On January 29, 1947, ANNE CITRON LANSKY, plaintiff, filed Bill of Complaint in Action for Divorce against MEYER LANSKY, defendant. She claimed more than ninety days residence in Florida; defendant named as resident of New York. They were married May 9, 1929, at New York City. They had three children: BERNARD, born January 15, 1930; PAUL, born September 22, 1932, and SANDRA, born December 6, 1937. Plaintiff states they were happily married until 1933 when subject began nagging, berating and criticizing her actions, particularly in raising the children. He once threw a hot potato at her. She left subject in 1946, charges extreme cruelty and seeks divorce. BERNARD A. FRANK was attorney for plaintiff.

On February 3, 1947, defendant answered through his attorney, ALBERT M. LEHRMAN. He denied each and every allegation, denied plaintiff is entitled to any relief and asked dismissal of the complaint.

By agreement of the parties, JACK ABBOTT, 927 Lincoln Road, Miami Beach, Florida, was appointed Special Master in Chancery to take testimony and make recommendations. ABBOTT filed a report on February 11, 1947, finding for the plaintiff and recommending a divorce be granted. He also recommended court approval of a written agreement entered into by both parties on September 13, 1946, providing for custody and support of the minor children. This agreement was between MEYER LANSKY, 240 Ocean Parkway, Brooklyn, New York, and ANNE LANSKY, 211 Central Park West, Manhattan, New York, providing they live separately and custody of minor children be given the mother, provided she shall keep subject (father) advised of their whereabouts. The father was to have free and unhampered visits with the children at a reasonable hour at any place of residence. Subject is to select schools and camps for the children and pay therefor. There are no claims for property. ANNE is to receive \$300.00 every

Monday from subject during his lifetime until the children reach maturity, or she re-marries, whichever occurs first. This is to be reduced by \$50.00 per week if a child, by its own wish, returns to subject.

In addition, subject will continue to pay ANNE's rent in New York or up to \$300.00 a month elsewhere. She is to keep the apartment furniture and a new agreement is to be made when the children reach maturity.

A final decree of divorce was signed by Judge M. C. WISEHART on February 14, 1947.

Plaintiff resided at the Wofford Hotel, Miami Beach, Florida. It is known from past inquiries that management of this hotel has changed numerous times in the past ten years and records are not available for more than three years back.

THELMA SHEER SCHWARTZ

On June 9, 1958, Dade County, Florida, marriage records were checked for the period September 1, 1948, through August 1, 1950, and failed to reflect a marriage for subject to THELMA SHEER SCHWARTZ.



b7C On January 4, 1959, an individual identifying himself as [REDACTED] called the Office of the Legal Attache and stated "a nasty story" had appeared in the newspaper, "The New York Times," concerning MEYER LANSKY and indicated that LANSKY was running away from Cuba. [REDACTED] LANSKY was at the Hotel Havana-Riviera taking care of the personnel there even though he was very sick and should be in the hospital.

MEYER LANSKY then got on the telephone and advised the Legat, Havana, that he had received a telephone call from PAUL BRUUN, a newspaper columnist in Miami Beach, that a newspaper had published a short story to the effect that the FBI or INS was looking for MEYER LANSKY since he was back in the United States. LANSKY stated he was still in Havana taking care of the personnel of the hotel. LANSKY stated he had appeared before the McClellan Committee two weeks before and had a subpoena to appear before this Committee again. LANSKY indicated he merely wanted to make a matter of record with the Embassy that he was still in Havana.

MEYER LANSKY

On January 7, 1959, at approximately 8:30 A.M., [REDACTED] was notified by INS, Miami office, that MEYER LANSKY had arrived at the Miami International Airport on a flight from Cuba, and was being detained there for questioning by us pursuant to prior agreement.

He proceeded to the airport by car immediately and interviewed LANSKY. Prior to our arrival he had been questioned by [REDACTED] Supervising Customs Agent. LANSKY'S attitude was friendly, but he declined to answer any specific questions relating to his activity. The purpose of the trip, he stated, was to see his father about a condition he believed to be fraudulent. His immediate destination was the TUSCANY HOTEL which is owned and operated by his son. He disclaimed any interest in it. In response to a specific question, he disclaimed any interest in the TUNZBERG HOTEL.

LANSKY admitted connection with the RIVIERA GAMBLING CASINO in Havana, but said he did not own any of it. He indicated, however, that he soon expected to acquire an interest in it. He denied having any interest in the NATIONAL CASINO; however, he did work for it before it was sold in early October to New York interests. He refused to name the old owners or new purchasers.

With regard to the revolution in Cuba, LANSKY stated that the large Casinos had not been damaged, though many of the smaller ones had. He expected to continue in business, and did not anticipate trouble from the new government, he said. He was surprised, he alleged, at the number of Casino employees who proved to be members of the July 26th Movement. Under the BATISTA government it had been necessary to pay off government officials, he said. As far as he knew, he was the first of the gamblers to leave Havana, and denied that any had left on Friday or Saturday, January 2nd or 3rd, 1959 in a group, as written up in the newspapers.

LANSKY advised us that he can be reached by us at any time through his son at the TUSCANY HOTEL.

The Miami Daily News, Miami, Florida, under date-line March 31, 1959, carried an article pertaining to the Plantation Key Properties, formerly owned by MEYER LANSKY. The article stated "ARTHUR B. (MICKEY) MC BRIDE, former owner of the Continental Race Wire Service, today moved to foreclose a mortgage on Plantation Key Properties, Incorporated, once a plush gambling resort.

"MC BRIDE claims there is a total of \$131,041 owing in principal and interest on a mortgage assigned to him by EARL G. KEHOE, North Miami, Beach Attorney.

"MC BRIDE's suit, filed in Federal Court here, follows the deportation to Italy of MICHAEL SPINELLA, a racketeer whose estate included stock in the Plantation Key Yacht Harbor.

"In the government's case against SPINELLA it was alleged that JOSEPH A. VARON of Hollywood, and MEYER LANSKY also owned stock in Plantation Key.

"They later gave quit claim deeds to the property and SPINELLA was described as sole owner.

"In the course of the long litigation, Federal Court appointed WILLIAM C. LEWIS of Coral Gables, receiver for Plantation Key Properties.

"Last week, LEWIS petitioned the court for permission to sell it at private sale for \$200,000.

"Immediately, MC BRIDE filed his foreclosure action against Plantation, VARON and LEWIS.

"MC BRIDE alleges KEHOE loaned Plantation \$85,000 on November 5, 1953. The loan was secured by a mortgage bearing 10 per cent interest.

"MC BRIDE charges principal and interest are in default."

Within two weeks of the time he entered the hospital, LANSKY suffered a severe attack and was close to death. At this time, large amounts of fluid formed around his heart, and the heart became enlarged. All of February and March and part of April, 1959, LANSKY was confined to

the hospital, with the exception of a few scattered days when he was strong enough to leave the hospital. LANSKY is presently residing at the Tuscany Motel, which is directly opposite the Diplomat Hotel.

b7C { [REDACTED] advised LANSKY is under heavy sedation and is only able to move around for three or four hours a day before tiring. He is under strict orders not to excite himself and although he is improving, there is a 20 per cent chance that the illness will reoccur.

b7D { [REDACTED] advised LANSKY is extremely worried about his financial investment in Cuba, due to the present unstable political situation. LANSKY has expressed concern over opposing political factions in the Government, which could be a serious problem to the United States in the future.

[REDACTED] stated he believes LANSKY might be receptive to interview by the FBI with regard to his problem, and stated he would determine LANSKY's attitude.

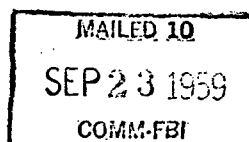

MEYER LANSKY was interviewed May 22, 1959, in the office of JOSEPH VARON, Attorney, 2432 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, Florida, by SAs [REDACTED] b7c

It was noted LANSKY appeared pale and drawn. He moved very slowly and seemed to be in pain. LANSKY advised his doctor had instructed that he could remain on his feet only three or four hours a day. His attitude was friendly.

LANSKY advised that regardless of public opinion of his personal life, he feels strongly about the security of the United States. He pointed out that this concern is partially based on selfish motives because in the event the government of the United States were to be undermined or overthrown, all citizens would suffer regardless of reputation or position. LANSKY advised that he is a student of political history. Throughout conversation LANSKY showed an excellent grasp of political science, current and past, and the ability to express himself.

He stated his main concern was the political unrest in Cuban government headed by FIDEL CASTRO. He advised that study had shown him the time was ripe for Communist factions to entrench themselves in government. He advised he had heard many rumors that there are Communists in high places in the Cuban government and the entire government will soon be Communistic. When pressed for particulars LANSKY advised he was not in

a position to furnish facts. He stated he based his statements on the general socialistic trend in the Cuban government and the unexplained source of revenue which allowed CASTRO to wage an expensive war against BATISTA. LANSKY speculated that the source was Communistic. He stated he could not name any individuals in the present government who had publicly described themselves as Communists nor could he offer any facts which would set one person aside from the others as a Communist.

LANSKY admitted that American gambling interests have been hamstrung during the CASTRO regime and he, LANSKY, could lose heavily unless the situation changed. He stated he could not deny that the possibility of this loss contributed to his decision to discuss the Cuban situation. Nevertheless, he felt that the United States government should be well aware of the changing political situation in Cuba before it developed into a threat to national security.

It should be noted that all of LANSKY's comments were general in nature. He advised although he does not anticipate return to Cuba in the near future, it is possible that factual information pertaining to Communist infiltration in the Cuban government would come to him through his established sources. He offered to make this information available. The interviewed was terminated.

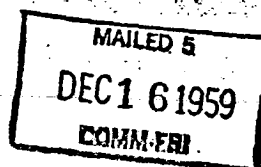

A review has been made of the Criminal Intelligence Program, including top hoodlum investigations, and the following is submitted for your future guidance in a program directed toward the fullest possible development of criminal intelligence.

At the present time, your office has pending investigations of five top hoodlums. There have been a number of cases closed and others opened on individuals coming to your attention who may be of top hoodlum stature. This approach is desirable and should be continued in order to keep in sight the individuals who are newly rising in this element.

Despite the active program in effect in your office, it appears that there has been a lack of penetration into the innermost workings of the upper echelon hoodlum and racketeering figures. The lack of real penetration into the organized crime field is pointed out rather strongly by the type of information obtained from [REDACTED]

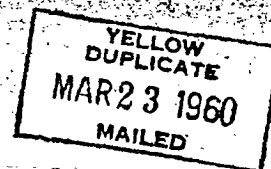

in a segment of the criminal element. In pursuing investigations in your Criminal Intelligence Program, you should not overlook the possibility of employing extraordinary investigative techniques with reference to Lansky. Because of the loss of the lucrative Cuban gambling situation, Lansky is presently in a position of having to make decisions as to his future course of action. This may be a propitious time for close coverage of Lansky.

It is desired also to point out to you the need of continuous alertness to develop the existence or nonexistence of the "Mafia." Persons who furnish information in this field should be thoroughly interviewed for a determination of what they mean by the use of the term "Mafia." It is the Bureau's desire to determine whether or not this is a mere term used to characterize criminal groups made up of a preponderance of persons of Italian birth or extraction, or whether it is a term denoting something of greater significance. Complete details of any facts available should be obtained from any persons contending that it is an actual organization which can be characterized as being a "Mafia."

The Criminal Intelligence Program in your office should be closely analyzed and the Bureau advised by April 15, 1960, of plans formulated and action to be taken for the purpose of effecting coverage of organized criminal activities along the lines indicated in this letter.

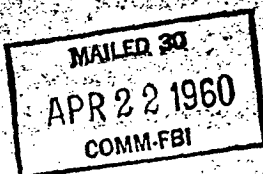
