Using authority of Section 7604 Title 26 U. S. Code, United States Courts connive and obtain a verdict of guilty, claiming the accused subject to the penalties usual for contempt of court if a person refuses to answer a warrant to appear in court with his accounts for purpose of calculating tax. See Case of Meyer Lansky, U. S. District Court, Miami, Florida, now in progress

Use of Section 7604 against natural persons is a violation of Articles 4 & 5 Amendments to U. S. Constitution. See Daly v U. S. 393 US 373, April 11, 1968.

Grantkanaxdirented Section 7604, which is in chapter 78 of title 20 directs penalties of Section 7210, which is in chapter 75 of Title 20 to be used for failure to respond to the summons.

"Person defined. The term 'person ' as used in this chapter' includes an officer or employee of a corporation or a member or employee of a partnership, who as such officer employee or member is under a duty to perform the act in respect of which the violation odcurs." End quote Section 7343

Chapter 75, Title 26 U. S. Code

Congress connived this vague statute, placing the authority for the summons in Chapter 78 which contains no definition of the term person and placing the penalties for failure to tespond to the summons in chapter 75. An important part of this intrigue was placing the penalties and the definition of the term person in separate sections. An accused, who read both Section 7604 and Section 7210 would have no knowledge about exactly to whomthe law should be applied. Only by the chance search of the entire law could an accused find Section 7343 and that section's relation to section 7210 and section 7604. The law really does restrict use of Section 7604, as the court found in the Daly Case, to those defined in section 7343.

No provision in the Constitution of United States was made to protect papers of entities such as corporations and partnerships, therefore laws made regulating and providing for inspection of accounts of these entities are not unconstitutional. It is the use of these corporate laws against natural persons which is unconstitutional.

This FRAUDULENT intrigue of Congress and the United States Courts was exposed by Grayson v U. S. 11,809 U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals, which was an appeal of #9867 U.S. District Court, Toledo, C The Court refused to file an opinion, thereby blocking appeal on thi matter of right. Congress then revised the Code, omitted Section 14 but retained the same style of law in the sections explained above. Paragraph (d) of Section 145 reads the same as Section 7343 quoted above.

LANSKY entered St. Francis Hospital, Miami Beach, Florida, for open-heart surgery on 3/16/73 and was discharged 3/31/73. Subject's trial, rising out of March of 1971 indictment charging income tax evasion, scheduled, SDF, 7/9/73.

On February 28, 1973, Federal Grand Jury (FGJ) convened, Southern District of Florida (SDF), returning the guilty verdict against MEYER LANSKY, charging him with criminal contempt. LANSKY was free on bond and his attorney, DAVID ROSEN, was given two weeks to file motions. No date had been given by the U.S. District Court (USDC) Judge JAMES L. KING for sentencing. Upon receiving the verdict, ROSEN made a formal motion requesting that the verdict be set aside on the grounds that it was against the weight of evidence presented by the government during the trial.

On April 5, 1973, LANSKY's attorney, DAVID ROSEN, appeared in the USDC, SDF, Miami, Florida, and requested that MEYER LANSKY's criminal contempt conviction be set aside and a new trial be granted. ROSEN stated that his client should be given a directed verdict of acquittal because the government failed to prove criminal contempt.

USDC Judge JAMES L. KING postponed ruling until after he had read legal briefs submitted to him.

It is noted that MEYER LANSKY, along with MORRIS LANSBURGH and LANSBURGH's partner, SAM COHEN, were indicted by a FGJ, Miami, Florida, on March 25, 1971. They were charged with conspiracy to skim profits from the Flamingo Hotel Casino, Las Vegas, Nevada, during the years 1960 to 1967, with the purpose of avoiding paying taxes on the skimmed proceeds.

Other overt acts set forth in the indictment included an agreement that MEYER LANSKY was alleged to have executed for a \$200,000 "finder's fee", on September 9, 1960, when interests of MORRIS LANSBURGH purchased the Flamingo Hotel Casino.

On March 16, 1973, MEYER LANSKY was admitted to St. Francis Hospital, Miami Beach, Florida, where he underwent open-heart surgery.

The surgery was completed without complications and LANSKY was discharged from the hospital on March 31, 1973.

On April 10, 1973, it was determined through a review of the records of the USDC, Miami, Florida, that the trial of LANSKY on the charges of income tax evasion that arose out of his indictment on March 25, 1971, has been scheduled to begin on July 9, 1973, before USDC Judge JOE

The indictment against LANSKY charged that he and co-defendant DINO incelling, had kept from the government and the Internal Revenue Service monies that they collected from VINCENT TERESA and CARMINE MASTROTOTARO. The funds represented gambling debts incurred by patrons of the Colony Sporting Club, London, England. It was contended that on two different occasions in 1968 a total of \$94,000 was brought to LANSKY and CELLINI in Miami by TERESA, who was described as a Massachusetts loan shark and who had cooperated with the Federal Government.



MEYER LANSKY was found guilty of criminal contempt by a United States Federal Grand Jury (FGJ), Southern District of Florida (SDF), Miami, Florida, on February 28, 1973. On June 14, 1973, LANSKY was sentenced to a one year and one day term to be spent in the medical center for Federal prisoners in Springfield, Missouri. This sentencing was appealed by LANSKY and he was released on \$200,000 appeal bond. Arguments concerning the appeal were scheduled to begin on October 19, 1973, and DOUGALD MC MILLAN, Chief, Strike Force, SDF, Miami, Florida, anticipated the arguments would take several weeks.

On July 25, 1973, MEYER LANSKY was acquitted by a FGJ, SDF, Miami, Florida, on charges of income tax evasion. The charge arose out of indictments in which LANSKY was charged with not reporting funds allegedly received by him representing gambling debts incurred by customers of the Colony Sporting Club in London, England.

On March 25, 1971, MEYER LANSKY, along with MORRIS LANSBURGH and LANSBURGH's partner, SAM COHEN, were indicted by a FGJ, SDF, Miami, Florida, charging them with conspiracy to skim proceeds from the Flamingo Hotel Casino, Las Vegas, Nevada, during the years 1960-67, with the purpose of avoiding paying taxes on the skimmed proceeds. LANSBURGH and COHEN pled guilty to these charges and were sentenced to one year in prison on April 27, 1973. LANSKY, because of health reasons, had his trial postponed to January 7, 1974.






The heat on the "button men," who have until recently been free to go into anything but dope running, sears them from both inside the families and from law enforcement agencies.

So effectively has the 1973 phenomenon of local and federal coordination hit the mob, for example, that truck hijacking, a lucrative swift moneymaker, has plummeted. It's just gotten too dangerous. So much so that the thieves can't get a "drop" or a garage in big towns such as this Gotham for less than \$5,000 an hour in which to hide, "break" the load down and distribute the loot into smaller conveyances.

The Mafia isn't "cooling it" out of Yuletide sentiment. First they're old and want to die a natural death after a long life. They know, and it is fact, that law enforcement agencies, especially the respirited FBI, have broken through the old Cosa Nostra omerta -- wall of silence.

The bureau now has informers in the highest underworld echelons. This significant breakthrough came in the past six or nine months. And in all--repeat, all--of the Mafia families.

This is corroborated by Jerry Shur, chief of the U.S.

Justice Department's criminal intelligence unit. He tells

me there are some 650 informers. Most of them are from

within organized crime. These men and their families,

totaling about 2,000 in all, have been put under protection

on military bases or have been moved from their original


cities under the witness relocation program.


"Hundreds of men have been convicted who otherwise would have been free were it not for these witnesses," Shur says. "We give a witness in organized crime trials an alternative to death. So we relocate them. Vinnie Teresa (a self-avowed New England underworld thug who turned--VR) alone helped us put away at least 20 gangsters."

So the Mafia dons are careful. They don't know who'll turn and they'll hit the headlines. One informer's testimony convicted the late Gyp De Carlo.

Furthermore, the elders are growing weaker--physically. Note the final days of Meyer Lansky, last of the old Murder, Inc., era. Justice Department officials tell me he'll never be tried again though Meyer is scheduled for a Las Vegas courtroom in January.




There are others like Lansky who, though not as sick, are antediluvians from the late '20s. Some of them are just about holding their men in line--such as the alleged boss of bosses Carlo Gambino, the most powerful labor manipulator of them all. Others are dead or have gone into exile as has an erstwhile boss of the Chicago mob. Justice Dept. investigators believe that the legendary crowd will be led by John (Jackie the Lackey) Cerone, an unknown to the rest of the nation.

Wherever one looks there are vacuums. Though the Rhode Island parole board is considering freeing the alleged New England boss, the imprisoned Ray Patriarca, the post still is open. So is the leadership of virtually all Eastern families. Slowly the Colombo family leadership is going to prison or into retirement in Florida, for example.







Appeal Arguments Open on Lansky's Contempt Sentence

A federal appeals court began consideration Wednesday of mobster Meyer Lansky's bid to overturn his contempt of court conviction and escape a year-and-a-day jail sentence.

In New Orleans, Lansky's attorney E. David Rosen, argued before the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals that his 72-year-old client hadn't had enough time to prove he was medically unable to obey subpena and fly from Israel to the United States.

But a government attorncy, Peter M. Shannon Jr. of the Department of Justice, told the court the delay was Lansky's own fault because he had evaded service on the subpena demanding he appear before a grand jury investigating gambling.

Lansky, the government claimed in the trial here that brought his February, 1973, conviction, had fled to Israel to

avoid prosecution.

He was brought to trial only after Israel deported him and he was unable to obtain sanctuary in a number of Latin


American countries.

Lansky's attorney argued then, and again Wednesday, that his client was too ill to leave Israel but would have been willing to give sworn testimony there.

U.S. District Judge James Lawrence King handed down the year-and-a-day sentence last June, adding the "day" to make certain the conviction and sentence would be recorded as a felony.


Later in the year, Lansky was acquitted of one income tax evasion charge, but still faces trial at Las Vegas where the government has accused him of "skimming" casino gambling receipts before they had to be reported as income.

On April 2, 1974, Strike Force, Southern District of Florida, advised that LANSKY's appeal from the contempt of court conviction handed down in June, 1973, was still under consideration by the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals in New Orleans, Louisiana, as all arguments have been concluded.



The "Miami Herald", a Miami, Florida daily newspaper, in its issue of January 10, 1974, on page 4B, contained an article captioned "LANSKY Trial Re-Scheduled". The article is as follows:

Lansky Trial Rescheduled

'The trial of Meyer Lansky, reputed underworld financial genius, was rescheduled in federal court in Las Vegas for May 7 after being removed from the court calendar for January.

Lansky's defense attorneys asked for another delay in the trial on the grounds that the 72-year-old man was ill and had suffered several heart attacks and minor strokes.

He faces trial on charges that he was involved in a \$36 million operation to skim profits from gambling at the Flamingo Hotel casino during the 1960s and avoid paying taxes on them.

He was acquitted in Miami last year on other income tax evasion charges.



MEYER LANSKY was found guilty of criminal contempt by a United States Federal Grand Jury (FGJ), Southern District of Florida (SDF), Miami, Florida, on February 28, 1973. On June 14, 1973, LANSKY was sentenced to a one year and one day term to be spent in the Medical Center for Federal Prisoners in Springfield, Missouri.

On June 28, 1974, the Fifth United States Circuit Court of Appeals, New Orleans, Louisiana, ruled that LANSKY should not have been convicted for failing to answer a subpoena and, accordingly, reversed LANSKY's contempt conviction.

On March 25, 1971, MEYER LANSKY, along with MORRIS LANSBURGH and LANSBURGH's partner, SAM COHEN, were indicted by a FGJ, SDF, Miami, Florida, charging them with conspiracy to skim proceeds from the Flamingo Hotel Casino, Las Vegas, Nevada, during the years 1960 - 1967, with the purpose of avoiding paying taxes on the skimmed proceeds.

LANSBURGH and COHEN pled guilty to the conspiracy charges and in April, 1973, were sentenced to one year in prison. They were released after serving approximately four months.

LANSKY, through his attorney, was granted five continuances of his trial, because of health reasons. On August 22, 1974, United States District Court Judge ROGER D. FOLEY, Las Vegas, Nevada, granted LANSKY a sixth continuance and, in his order granting this continuance, stated that the


case would lie dormant on the court calendar until LANSKY dies or Government counsel dismisses the indictment.

Judge FOLEY stated that the case should be dismissed for health reasons indicating that medical evidence in the record of the case shows that it is almost a certainty that LANSKY will never be well enough to undergo the rigors of a trial.



The grand jury investigation in Miami is being ditected by Dougald McMillan, southeastern regional chief of the Justice Department's Organized Crime Strike Force.

Prior to Carlton's appearance, McMillan summoned and questioned several other Miami men, one of them Jack Grill, chauffeur for underworld financial wizard Meyer Lansky.

Also questioned was Morris Stein, the driver for Lansky associate Hymie Lazar; Rodney Roth, and Morris Katz.

Erases Only Successful Federal Case Against—Him

Lansky's Conviction Is Overturned

Meyer Lansky's only federal conviction was reversed Friday when the Fifth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals ruled Lansky should not have been convicted for failing to answer a subpena.

The ruling by the appeals court in New Orleans means the reputed financial wizard of organized crime will not have to serve the year and a day sentence handed down one year

Lansky, 71, has been free on bond since he was convicted of contempt in a jury trial last June for failing to respond to a subpena for his appearance before the U.S. grand jury in Miami

THE GRAND jury, which was investigating allegations that Lansky skimmed gambling profits from a Las Vegas hotel, ordered him on Feb. 22, 1971, to appear in 19 days. Lansky was living in Israel and did not accept the subpeas until March 4.

"When the government requested that the court fix Merch 11 as the return date of the subpena, it made compliance by the defendant virtually impossible," wrote Judge Robert A. Ainsworth in an opinion for the appeals court.

U.S. Justice Department Strike Force attorney Dougald McMillan, who prosecuted the case for the government, had argued that Lansky deliberately evaded early service of the subpena and the March 11 return date was only set after his attorney's refusal to agree on any date.

Lansky, who lives at the Imperial House, 5255 Collins Ave., Miami Beach, and his attorney, E. David Rosen, could not be reached Friday for comment.

Judge Ainsworth said in his opinion that U.S. District Court Judge James Lawrence King should have directed the jury to acquit Lansky, because the government failed

AFTER FAILING to answer the subpena, Lansky remained in Israel until he was forced to leave that country in November 1972. He was arrested upon his arrival from Israel in Miami on Nov. 7, 1972.

The reversal of his contempt conviction crases the federal government's only successful case against him. His only previous conviction was on a minor state gambling charge in New York in the 1950s.

Lansky openly operated illegal gambling casinos in South Florida during the late 1940s and is identified by many organized crime experts as the most influential man in the growth of regional racketeering into a national syndicate with close ties to the Mafia and other organized crime groups.

that he was not in Miami in 1968 at the time a government witness said he was receiving unreported gambling income.

Lansky, who underwent open heart surgery last year, is facing trial in Las Vegas in a skimming case that led to the conviction of Miami Beach hotelmen Morris Lansburgh and Sam Cohen.


The defendants were charged with illegally removing gambling revenue from the Flamingo casino in Las Vegas during the 1960s to avoid paying taxes.

ALTHOUGH Lansky is officially waiting triat on that charge, there has been persistent speculation that the government will eventually drop that charge for lack of evidence.

Lansky is the target of continuing investigation by a special U.S. Justice Department task based in Washington and is currently under investigation by a U.S. grand jury in Miami directed by McMillan looking into illegal bookmaking.

McMillan said Friday he was deeply disappointed by the appeals court reversal. "It was a very expensive trial for the government both in time and money. All I can say is that we did our job and a jury convicted him." MM 92-102

Meyer Lansky spent about five minutes yester-day with a federal grand jury in Miami probing gambling racketeering and possible links with public officials.

Lansky, said by the U.S. Justice Department to be a financial genius of organized crime, appeared under subpena before the jury which has questioned several persons, including a retired chief justice of the Florida Supreme Court about gambling junkets to Las Vegas.

Tooking somewhat tired and drawn, Lansky, 71, arrived at the federal courthouse at 10:45 a.m. with his attorney, David Rosen, and was called into the jury chambers at 11:30. He emerged twice for hurried, whispered conversations with Rosen, and then emerged for the final time at 11:44.

Lansky declined to comment on his appearance ba-

fore the jury, saying only, "Ask them in there (the jurors)."

Also appearing before the jury today was Pam Carlton, daughter of Vassar Carlton, who returned last February as chief justice of the state Supreme Court. Miss Carlton is a secretary at a Miami Beach law firm.

Her attorney said the jury questioned her in regard to travel to Las Vegas, but not specifically about pambling junkets. Her fattier had testified sunder subpena to the jury June 26 on a number of matters intuming his acquaintance

erates gambling junkets and has been observed meeting Lansky.

Carlton said he told the jury that he had heard the name of Hymie Lazar, but they were not personal friends and he (Carlton) had not taken any of the junkets to Las Vegas.

Refusing, initially, to testify to the jury today were well-known racing boat-builder Don Aronow, and his son, Michael Aronow.

Dougald McMillan, Jusfice Department attorney who leads the Miami Strike

force, took the Aronows before U.S. District Court Judge Clyde Atkins, who granted them immunity from prosecution in exchange for their testimony. It was disclosed that the jury wanted to ask them about alleged meetings with bookmakers at Calder Race Track.

Meyer Lansky is a free man.

The organized crime chieftain, who has successfully zig-zagged through legal obstacles for more than five decades, has beaten the only conviction the federal government ever got on him.

Lansky's victory came this week when the U.S. Justice Department decided its case was not strong enough for an appeal of its, reversal to the U.S. Jupreme Court. Lansky had been sentenced to a year and a day in prison for failing to answer a federal grand jury subpens.

The Fifth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals tossed out the June 1973 jury conviction, contending the government failed to prove Lansky willfully and contemptuously avoided compliance with the subpena.

LANSKY, now 72, has waited for the legal battle to end in his plush apartment at the Imperial House

in Mami Beach. He had been free on bond since his conviction, but up until a monte ago he was required to phone his whereabouts each week to Dougald Mc-Millan, the man who prosecuted him.

McMillan, who heads the Justice Department's Organized Crime Strike Force in Miami, said those weekly phone chats were cordial but formal. "There was no real conversation, we never developed any rapport."

There have been few glimpses. of. public short, graying Lansky since his highly publicized trial last year. His health declining, the aging man has never looked the image of the lord of rackets or the onetime confederate of such notorious underworld figures as Frank Costello, Bugsy Siegel, Lepke Buchalter, Joe Adonis, and Luckey Luciano. His most public pastime now is walking his dog along Collins Avenue. .

estimated by federal agents. Some have had a full-time job probing his web of vast financial holdings. His personal fortune has been estimated at \$300 million.

FBI agents have been assigned to keep him under constant surveillance. One agent reported frequent chats with the man he was assigned to follow.

The reversal of the contempt conviction in June and the government's decision not to appeal it erases Lansky's record of ever violating a federal law. His

only previous conviction was on a minor state gambling charge in New York during the 1950s.

Though he has evaded the law with classic success, the aging Lansky has earned himself the reputation of being a giant in organized crime in America. He openly operated illegal gambling casinos in South Florida during the late 1940s and in the process corrupted many major police agencies in the area.

FOR LANSKY, the success in beating the convetion was his third major legal victory in just over a year.

He was acquitted last summer in Miami of an income tax chare charge when a federal jury believed his wife's testimony that he was not in Miami in 1968 at the time the government witness said he was receiving unreported gambling income.

And charges were recently dismissed by a federal

judge in Nevada in a case which accused Lansky of skimming millions of dollars a year from a casino operation. That case led to the conviction of Miami Beach hotelmen Morris Lansburgh and Sam Cohen. The trio was charged with illegally removing gambling revenue from the Flamingo Hotel's casino in Las Vegas during the 1960s to avoid paying taxes.

The judge said Lansky, who had undergone open heart surgery and was in poor health, was too sick to stand trial.

AT THE TIME, Lansky was so distrusted that rumors circulated that cardiologists who performed the heart surgery on Lansky had merely made an incision and then sewed him back up.

The surgeons, to relieve any suspicions, saved some of Lansky's heart tissue, and sent it to a laboratory to be preserved as proof.

The case that brought Lansky's short-lived contempt conviction stemmed from the investigation that led to the Las Vegas indictment.

The grand jury investigating the skimming operation ordered Lansky on Feb. 22, 1971 to appear as a witness on March 11. Lansky was living in Israel and did not accept the subpena until March 4. He didn't show on March 11 to testify, contending his health was too poor. McMILLAN argued at the trial that Lansky deliberately evaded early service of the subpena and the March 11 return date was only set after Lansky's attorney refused to agree on any date.

But, in writing the opinion reversing that conviction by the appeals court, Judge Robert Ainsworth wrote it was "virtually impossible" for Lansky to comply with the subpenary March 11.

The Justice Department had the option of dropping the case or appealing. Solicitor General Robert Bork made the decision not to appeal.

"It was a decision he had to make. He didn't think the chances of a favorable supreme Court ruling were good enough," McMillan said.



Lansky may get immunity, testify in gambling probe

Reputed underworld banker Meyer Lansky of Miami Beach is expected to go before a judge in Fort Lauderdale today and be granted immunity as a prelude to testimony before a statewide grand jury.

It will be Lansky's second appearance before the state grand jury, which is probing organized gambling in South Florida.

Last month, Lansky spent only five minutes in his previous appearance before the grand jury, apparently having invoked his constitutional privileges against self-incrimination.

Meanwhile, Metro police yesterday arrested three Dade men on gambling chargings after they were named in some of the 14 indictments returned by the grand jury. Six others were arrested eisewhere. Some of those arrested were named in more than one indictment.

A fourth Dado County man, Marty Lewis, a Bal Harbour cabana operator, was taken into custody on a contempt citation after he refused to answer questions before the jury after being granted immunity.

The three men arrested in Dade County-and the charges against

thent are Arthur Young 44, 1233 Collins Ave., Miami Beach, one count of conspiracy to commit bookmaking; Samuel Nemath, 63, 2215 NE 204th St., four counts of unlawful wagering; and Walter Joseph Miller, 52, 1616 NW 19th Ter., one count of unlawful wagering.

A police source said they expect to make additional arrests based on the remaining sealed indictments.

Among those arrested in Broward County were Maurice Slutsky, 64, of Hallandale, who was charged with two counts of bookmaking, and Edward Vose, 61, of Dania, charged with wagering.

Lansky has been supenaed to appear this morning for his second session before the probers. It was expected that Lansky will again invoke constitutional privilege and then be taken before a Circuit Court judge and granted immunity.

According to Special Prosecutor Eugene Whitworth, Lansly will be questioned "only about organized crime in relation to linegal gambling."

Whitworth also said that the immunity granted Lansky would guarantee his freedo n from prosecution in any subsequent case linked to his testimony and that the questions he wants to ask Lansky "will not be directly connected with cases the grand jury has been hearing at this time."

If Lansky still refuses to testify after being granted immunity, he could be held in contempt of court and jailed. He was convicted of criminal contempt in federal court in Miami for his failure to respond to a federal grand jury suppena while he was in Israel, but the conviction was reversed by the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals in New Orleans.

He also is the center of attention for a special statewide grand jury investigating organized illegal gambling. By reputation at least, Lansky knows the field as few men do.

It is the grand jury that has summoned him here to the Broward County Courthouse in Fort Lauderdale. It is trying something different

For years, prosecutors and grand juries have tried to get at Lansky from beneath, hacking away at the elaborate criminal substructure they believe insulates him from legal attack. It has never worked.

On Friday morning, this grand jury tried to do it the other way around — getting at the substructure by hacking away at Lansky.

ITS TACTIC was to give him immunity from prosecution for anything he might say about himself. He could testify or face a jail sentence for contempt.

Tancky rectified Whether or not the grand jury's strategy works remains to be seen. Testimony it hears, is, by law, secret. Special prosecutor Eugene Whitworth was careful not to relate Lansky's testimony, only to characterize it as generally affable.

Lansky surely was affable with the bored corps of reporters and photographers who waited with him while the grand jury spent most of the morning plotting strategy with him out of the room.

Once openly hostile to journalists, especially those with microphones, Lansky appears to have mellowed late in life.

"Sure I've changed." he said when asked about that. "You've changed. Doesn't every hody change?" He smiled and joked a lot. laughed at blatantly leading questions and returned jihes. Nothing whatever of substance, but then no one expected any.

LANSKY WAS asked if he would acknowledge his financial wizardry, underworld or not.

"Ha, ha. No, I wouldn't. Ha, ha. I'm going to the poorhouse," he said.

Which poorhouse?

"You'll spend your whole life guessing, won't you?" he replied.

On November 17, 1972, Departmental Attorney HAL WEBB, United States Department of Justice, Strike Force 18, presented evidence against GERSON BLATT and BENJAMIN SIGELBAUM to a Federal Grand Jury (FGJ), Miami, Florida, alleging Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) violations and an indictment was returned on that date by the FGJ charging GERSON BLATT and BENJAMIN SIGELBAUM with violations of SEC laws. BLATT and SIGELBAUM pleaded not guilty and both were acquitted after a trial that concluded on May 3, 1973, in United States District Court, Miami, Florida, before United States District Court Judge PETER T. FAY.

The March 9, 1974, edition of "The Miami Herald", a Miami, Florida, daily newspaper, contained an article "Six are Accused of Duping Clergy in Stock Deal". The article in part related that six Greater Miami men had been accused of cheating the Catholic Archdiocese of Detroit, Michigan, the Bishop of Lansing, Michigan, two other Michigan priests, and a secretary out of \$350,000. The suit was filed in Detroit, Michigan, by the SEC. Named as the six Greater Miami men were RICHARD SADOWSKI, BENJAMIN SIGELBAUM, GERSON BLATT, MILTON PEPPER, HERBERT RUBIN, and BARTON S. UDELL. A seventh defendant was JOHN PULLMAN.

The article continued by stating the charges set out claimed the defendants purchased stock in a land development company from the victims for one dollar per share, after having had prior knowledge that the stock had increased in value because Exquisite Form Brassiere and Girdle Company purchased 92% of the shares of the land development company. The SEC contended that failing to tell the victims of the stock's increased value violated SEC laws and sought an injunction against future violations.

On October 7, 1974, United States District Court Judge JOHN FEIKENS, Eastern District of Michigan, granted the defendants' request for a change of venue from Detroit to Miami.

But sometimes it just doesn't do Sixty-year-old . Morris, the dude. died. That was the other morning in Miami Beach's Imperial House (what else?) just about the time friend Meyer, his neighbor in another Imperial House condominium, was walking the dog.

SOMEHOW Meyer overcomes, When his friends Sam Cohen and Lansburgh went to prison, he was let off the hook, though he too had been with them on charges of skimming the \$36 million and transporting the cash, Lansky told the federal judge some four years ago he was suffering from a heart condition, diabetes and chronic ulcers. The judge was very upset that the Justice, Department should be so unthinking that it wanted to put this ailing little man through the rigols of a public trial.

Apparently nothing but act of God upsets Meyer. This hasn't been a good winter for him. First he couldn't walk the dog along the Beach's Collins Avenue (near 55th Street) because it got too cold. So he was late for his daily coffee and Danish and later for his rendezvous with the courier and his personal court (like in royalty) in the Singapore Hotel lobby.

That Meyer is a romantic chap. He spent one of his honeymoons in Atlantic City. But now he's interested in one of the resort: town's hotels. In November, shortly after the people of New Jersey approved legalized gambling in what is corf-sidered by federal authorities to he the territory of reputed Philadel plia Mafia boss Angelo Brund

Leneburgh rushed to Atlantic City to case the creaking town.

Now here's a coincidence. Back in 1966, according to the authoriserved (or was served) four months' ties, brothers Morris and Angelo I flew together to case a new casino or two in London. And they didn't you any good to know the boss. Exactly get to know each other at the plane gate. Boss Bruno has had a long and devout interest in all sorts of gambling for years. How could such as he not have known Meyer and Morris?

> That venture into the Queen's English didn't work either., And later Angelo got sick - sick of body and sick of the crusading New Jersey Commission of Inventigation. Its gutsy chairman, Joseph Rodriguez, is dedicated to the as-sion for forcing Angelo Brund to testify about the underworld or

stay in prison for contempt for life if necessary.

WELL, in the gambling calino buliness lots of roads lead to Lansky. Even when he doesn't get a piece of the action. Somehow he knows almost everybody in the Las' Vegas gaming or hotel world. After all, he was a real pioneer. He was deep in the Hotel Flamingo milieu. And that was when the Vegas strip was mostly sand.

So it didn't come as any surprise when Florida and Nevada investigators told one newsman that Meyer was a friend of real estate investor: Alvin Mainik. Of Miami, of course.

Malnik is associated with the sons of Samuel Cohen, a former president of the Flamingo Hotel. Cohen was in the mass indictment with Lansky and Lansburgh. He, too, served four months in prison during 1973. The charge read:

"Defendants Samuel Cohen, Morris Lansburgh and Jerry Gordon and unindicted co-conspirators would operate the gambling casino of the Flamingo and conceal

from the Nevada gambling authorities and the U.S. Treasury Department, the true casino receipts by understating approximately \$4.3 million, or more of casino income yearly."

The sins of the father can't be visited upon the sons who are Male nik's partners in a deal with a Lag. Vegas establishment known as Caesar's World, Inc., a parent com-. pany of Caesar's Palace.

NOW it turns out that the Chicago go-based Central States Teamsters, fund holds a first mortgage on Cae sar's Palace. The mortgage is worth \$13.3 million.

There have been reports that Mainik is a reputed associate of Meyer Lansky. So it's all one walk of wax. Very difficult to seel through, A strange world of cash. nos and mortgages and loans and people who know each other so-cially, sometimes professionally and keep criss-crossing each othoers wheeling and dealing.





