**Details:** For the information of the Bureau and New York a Full Field Investigation was authorized by the Bureau on [redacted] [redacted] KHALIFAH, [redacted] financier of international Islamic Radical Fundamentalist groups, had been arrested by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) agents on December 16, 1994, in Morgan Hill, California. KHALIFAH's U.S. visitors visa had been revoked by the U.S. State Department because of criminal charges against KHALIFAH related to acts of terrorism in Jordan. [redacted] [redacted] was in the vehicle with KHALIFAH at the time of the arrest.

Investigation determined that KHALIFAH entered the U.S. on 12/1/94, and stayed with [REDACTED] at his [REDACTED] residence up to the time of his arrest. The focus of the investigation was to ascertain if [REDACTED] was in contact with individuals or organizations known to be involved in terrorist activities.

In San Francisco airtel dated 8/2/95, captioned as above, with copies to the Bureau and New York, the results of a 6/16/95 interview of [REDACTED] were provided. In summary, [REDACTED] did not appear to be engaged in activities in support of international terrorism or conducting clandestine intelligence activities. It appeared that [REDACTED] was to enjoying the Western lifestyle while making an attempt to attend classes at the [REDACTED]. At around the time of the interview MOHAMMAD KHALIFAH had just given up his fight with the U.S. judicial system and voluntary returned to Jordan. [REDACTED] had advised the FBI that KHALIFAH simply got tired of the boredom in jail and felt that he (KHALIFAH) had a good chance of winning his freedom in Jordan. [REDACTED] advised that he was intending to travel to Saudi Arabia in July, 1995, and he would inquire about KHALIFAH.

On November 30, 1995, [REDACTED] appeared at the San Rafael Resident Agency for an interview. He provided the following information:

[REDACTED] advised that he returned to California from Saudi Arabia in late August, 1995 [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] is a university student completing her studies who will join him in 1996. He stated that she came to [REDACTED] area with him and stayed approximately two weeks.

While in Saudi Arabia he spoke to MOHAMMAD KHALIFAH who was acquitted by a Jordanian court of committing terrorist acts. The family was happy to see KHALIFAH acquitted and glad that he was back home in Saudi Arabia. According to [REDACTED] KHALIFAH feels that he (KHALIFAH) was set up in Jordan and [REDACTED] believes him.

The interviewing agents tried to reinforce upon [REDACTED] that the FBI feels that KHALIFAH is involved in Islamic terrorist activity. He was advised that in international circles around the world where violence has taken place to promote Islam, the name of KHALIFAH always seems to appear. When told by the interviewing agents that KHALIFAH's name was found in the telephone/address directories of recently arrested subjects in the Philippines and Pakistan, [REDACTED] could not offer a plausible explanation, nor could [REDACTED] answer as to why KHALIFAH while incarcerated at the Alameda County Jail, Santa Rita Facility at Pleasanton, California, KHALIFAH received a visit from the HAMAS leader based in Santa Clara, California. [REDACTED] appears to be a bit naive, but he believes that KHALIFAH travels the world to teach about Islam and to promote his agricultural projects.

In the earlier interview on 6/16/95, [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] USAMA BINLADEN, had been cut off from the family because of his Islamic extremist activities. ( USAMA BINLADEN who has been identified as an financier of Islamic Radical Fundamentalist groups, and currently resides in the Sudan.)

When asked if KHALIFAH would receive the same fate if he was found to be engaged in Islamic extremist activity, [REDACTED] answered the family probably would not deal with him. He added that to this day the family still has no contact with USAMA BINLADEN. He was advised by the interviewing agents that the FBI believes that KHALIFAH acts as the front man for USAMA BINLADEN.

[REDACTED] advised that he told KHALIFAH that he [REDACTED] had been interviewed by the FBI. He stated that KHALIFAH questioned as to why the FBI felt it necessary to talk to him [REDACTED] since he (KHALIFAH) had nothing to do with international terrorism.

[REDACTED] stated that KHALIFAH is currently maintaining a low profile and is probably not allowed to travel outside Saudi Arabia as he heard that relations between KHALIFAH and the Saudi Government are strained. [REDACTED] did not know what KHALIFAH was doing to occupy his time but added that his Filipino wife has reunited with him in Saudi Arabia. He advised that he plans to visit his family after the Christmas holidays and plans to discuss with KHALIFAH information gleaned from this FBI interview.

Arabia as he heard that relations between KHALIFAH and the Saudi Government are strained. [redacted] did not know what KHALIFAH was doing to occupy his time but added that his Filipino wife has reunited with him in Saudi Arabia. He advised that he plans to visit his family after the Christmas holidays and plans to discuss with KHALIFAH information gleaned from this FBI interview.

On an unrelated topic regarding the bombing which occurred at the Saudi Arabian/ American military facility at Riyadh, [redacted] did not appear to be bothered that Saudi extremists acting on Saudi soil may have been responsible. He also did not seem to be aware of dissatisfaction among the Saudi middle class with the Saudi Royal families.

Based on the results of these two interviews San Francisco will close its Full Field Investigation of [redacted] [redacted] as investigation has not shown that he is engaged in activities in support of international terrorism or working under the direction of a foreign based organization. On 7/26/95, The Regional Security Office, American Embassy, Amman, Jordan, reported that Jordan's State Security Court acquitted Muhammad Jamal Khalifah and found him innocent of all charges due to a lack of evidence. Khalifah's case will not be reviewed. He was allowed to return to Saudi Arabia.

[redacted]  
[redacted] was interviewed 6/16/95 and 11/30/95 in the FBI office near his [redacted] residence. He insisted he has no knowledge of any terrorist affiliations by Khalifah or associates in [redacted] other than himself. He cited Khalifah's acquittal in Jordan as further indication of his innocence. [redacted] acknowledged having seen Khalifah during a visit to Saudi Arabia and claimed the elders of the [redacted] family seem accept Khalifah without reservation, unlike Usama Binladen who is disowned by the family for his Islamic extremist activities. Khalifah's Filipina wife is also with him in Jeddah.

This is a translation of a hand written Arabic document, written in English on first page "I.R.I.C.", this document found in the luggage of a Mr. MOHAMMAD JAMAL KHALIFAH.

The first two lines are not clear.

The document is a catalogue for a school called Institute of al-Imam al-Shafi'i for Education. It outlines courses or curriculum to be taught at the school at different stages of the curriculum or what is referred at times as rounds.

The document begins by defining the administrative and physical frames, of the institute, followed by a sketch. It enumerates a list of internal by-laws and punishments netted for breaking any by-laws. The document directs on how to recruit students and the bases on which the final selection of students is to be made. It states that the educational process is divided into four stages, defines the stages, outlines study courses, in some instances gives names of books and/or reference material to be used in an outlined course and at times gives names of instructors.

Bellow is a summary and at times verbatim translation of the document, verbatim translation is indicated by (vtim.) at the beginning and end of the verbatim translation:

(vtim) The Institute is a project of the International Relations Information Center "I.R.I.C" headquartered in Manila.

The person in charge of the Institute is the person in charge of the "I.R.I.C.", brother ABU AL-BARA'.

The Institute is internally supervised by a group of Arab and Philippine teachers, three Arabs and one Philippine. A group of advisors direct the day to day activities: One accountant and purchaser, two night guards, four cooks, one Karate instructor from out side the Institution. (vtim).

Students are divided among thirteen rooms (five in each room, gives name of the rooms.

Every room is assigned a prince (one person in charge), no students from the same area are put in the same room. The students are divided into educational families, each two rooms constitute a family supervised by an advisor. In the final stage, 'implementation stage', families are divided according to level

of students and their specialties. Students are assigned to various committees to perform various activities.

Pages 2 and 3 are a description of the physical frame of the school and a sketch identified as "Iman Al-Shafi'i Institute for Education".

Pages 4 enumerates 17 by-laws, verbatim translation of some:

- 1 - Only with a special permit can one leave the Institute on other than Fridays.
- 2 - It is forbidden to speak in any language but Arabic inside the Institute.
- 4 - it is forbidden for more than two persons from the same tribe to congregate together.
- 7 - it is forbidden to talk about the course of activities of the institute with any one from outside the Institute.
- 8 - Visitors can only enter the visiting area.

Page 5 talks about system of punishment, conditions for expelling students and system of family groupings within the institute.

Page 6 is titled System of Study of the Institute

#### Choosing Students:

The brothers advisors make a tour of, almost, all Moslem areas, meet with students, in principle, graduates from prior rounds help in recruitment of new students, recruiting a number of them. A camp is held for the recruits during which the final list is selected. Prerequisite of final selection:

- (vtim) 1 - exhibits the mental, psychological and physical readiness, in principle, to implement the aims of the Institute.
- 2 - has completed "English High School" fourth level secondary in English.
- 4 - age between 17 and 25, has not passed this age.
- 5 - be single.
- 6 - be free of dangerous intestinal ailments.

Note that the student does not graduate from the Institute with an academic degree, but graduates only as a **Mujahid** =(struggler or warrior) caller (vtim).

Goes on to say that in the first two stages students are divided (at times into two session, one for beginners, one for advanced, then to outline the four stages of study:

- 1 - Preparatory stage, 2 - Explanatory stage, 3 - Formation stage, 4 - Implementation stage.

Pages 7-20 is an outline of the course studies for the four stages, in some cases name of instructor is given.

Page 7 lists topics to be studied during each stage.

pages. 8-11 outlines in detail each topic and gives reference material to be used in the program. In the Preparatory stage the Arabic language and some Quranic laws are taught, one class under the heading: Words and Short Sentences in English, taught by [redacted] Under the heading, General Education, a class in general geography is taught, using as reference material The Correct World atlas, by ADAL TAMA BOUNAS. A class on farming - chicken raising, first aid: drowning and burns, bone breaks, snake bites, methods of prevention, communicable diseases, Philippine Constitution, various forms of Arabic scripts, and how to utilize them are taught.

Pages 12-13 outlines the study course for the Explanatory stage, concentrating on study of the Quran: interpretation, religious law, conduct, the calling: characteristics, importance, its principles; those who call, their position in Islam and their character, those who are called, their rights, duties, types called and how to deal with them.

Page 14 -15 gives outline of courses for the advanced 'excellant' level. Propaganda: introduction, its relation to jihad, illustrations of Islamic propaganda, Zionist hegemony over channels of propaganda, practical program: issue magazines, read and summarize news, write propaganda material for practice.

Special (or private) work, outline of special 'organizational' work: introduction, importance, organizing, types, methods, work with university students at "M.S.U". and coordinating with the specialized leadership: contacts, steps to organize individuals, structure of well known organizations and their internal-organizational structure, 'organizational infiltration', 'organizational terms', 'studies from Islamic work', security studies.

Practical program: plan of work with M.S.U., choose three students from M.S.U. to implement plan of individual contact, organize a trip for those called, write a detailed report about the contact.

Pages 16-18 gives outline of courses for the medium level. Security: introduction importance, glances at secrecy and security in the course, Security of Organizational Work: security of individuals, surveillance, how to escape surveillance, security of secret houses and secret documents, methods of information gathering on individuals, reporting of security

reports, propaganda and how to confront it, use of symbols in writing, spies and spying.

Investigation: introduction, its factors of success and aim, methods: psychology and nerves, how to resist, importance of steadfastness and judgement to confession, Methods of torture used in investigations.

Assassinations: causes, and methods, how to safeguard important persons.

(vtim) Practical agenda: 1- Oversee the security of the Institute, 2- Observing any movement outside the Institute, 3- Participate in the activities of the Institute as a security committee, 4- Writing of security reports about camps (military), university presidency, Christian organizations, 5- Surveillance of individuals, writing of reports, 'surveillance of one another for practice'.

training: Put together torn papers, reading of torn papers, writing with (not clear) ink, swallowing papers, hiding of papers or things inside the clothes, searching for something hidden, passing and remembering commercial places and car license numbers, training on weapons if possible (vtim).

Then goes on to outline courses of general or public work, work: aim, methods, (moral) characteristics, how to plan it: camps, trips, parties ..... act., how to build relations with people, gain friends and deal with people, and outline for a study program on comparative religion, study of about Jesus in the Quran, is the Bible the word of God.

Practical agenda: A plan of work with students in Arabic and English schools in Marawi (ph, name of area or town in Philippine) "aims and methods of the program", at public parties in cities and at schools, show videos, specially during Ramadan, train for lessons and Friday speeches within the Institute and out side it if possible.

Page 19 outlines course curriculum for the weak and medium level students. The page is divided under columns

Under column specialization is: Jihad.

Sections of the program column: important religious laws in understanding jihad.

- Legal provisions for assassinations and kidnapping.
- Legal provisions for assassinate priests and Christians.
- Legal provision for bombing churches and places of worship.
- Legal provisions for martyrdom operations.
- Legal provisions for reconciling with the enemy, and other various methods.
- Writing research on these issues and others, where it is researched in a scientific method.
- research in security and investigation.




In that assault, ASG stormed the town in a para-military operation, shot many of the residents, took hostages, and burned the town to the ground before escaping by sea.

Khalifah opened BIC and IRIC offices on Mindanao and used those facilities to train the ASG terrorists. This training included explosive courses taught by veterans of the Afghan war. Khalifah himself resided in Manila, married a Philippine national, and in 1994 applied for permanent resident status. In November 1994, Khalifah traveled to London and then on to the United States (using a visa obtained in Saudi Arabia). He was arrested shortly after his arrival in San Francisco in the company of [redacted]
