READ CAREFULLY

1. A special return certificate (SRC) permits the holder thereof to return to the Philippines with the same admission as when he departed provided that he meets the other requirements of the immigration laws.
2. The initial validity of the SRC shall be six (6) months, but on good cause shown, it may be issued with an initial validity of one (1) year, provided however that in no case shall the validity of an SRC exceed the holder's authorized stay.
3. The SRC shall be extended for six (6) months, but on good cause shown, it may be extended for one (1) year, provided however that in no case shall an SRC remain valid for a continuous period of more than five (5) years.
4. The SRC shall be valid for a single entry unless it is expressly stated that it shall be valid for multiple entries.
5. An issuance and/or extension fee of P250.00 and a legal research fee of P10.00 shall be assessed on the issuance and/or extension of an SRC for a six (6) months period.
6. Where the validity of the SRC has expired, no extension thereof shall be granted, and a holder of such SRC must obtain an appropriate visa from a Philippine Consul before embarking for the Philippines.
7. Any erasure or alteration shall render the SRC null and void.
8. Upon return to the Philippines this SRC shall be surrendered to the Immigration Inspector and the holder thereof shall secure the return of his immigration papers from the Commission on Immigration and Deportation within 30 days from the date of his return.

Dear Mr Khalifah

The Australian Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs has decided that there is a ground for cancellation of your visa under paragraph 116(1)(e) of the Migration Act 1958 because the competent Australian authorities have assessed you to be, directly or indirectly, a risk to Australian national security.

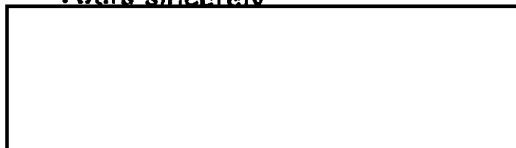
Your visa was therefore cancelled on 12 December 1994. The reasons for not cancelling your visa were not considered sufficient to outweigh the existence of the ground for cancellation because the assessment of the competent Australian authorities is conclusive.

You should forward your passport to this office so that your visa evidence can be stamped inoperative. Other relevant agencies have been advised that your visa has been cancelled.

As you are no longer the holder of an Australian visa, you are not entitled to travel to Australia. If you do, you will be refused immigration clearance and will be removed from Australia. Relevant offices in Australia have been advised that your visa has been cancelled.

You may wish to make another application for a visa, however I can give no indication of the possible outcome of that application. You should contact your nearest Australian mission for further information.

Pursuant to a search warrant issued and executed on December 20, 1994 by United States Chief Magistrate Judge F. STEELE LANGFORD, the luggage and personal possessions belonging to MOHAMMAD JAMAL KHALIFAH were searched in the offices of the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) at San Francisco. Among the items searched was a black canvas carry on bag with the brand name "Ace." Items found and seized included an 8" by 11" sheet of paper with blue ink Arabic handwriting.
