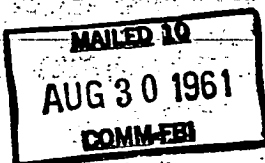

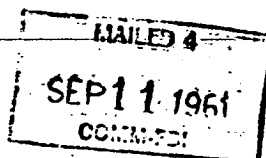

It is a matter of public knowledge that ANTHONY J. ACCARDO was tried in the Federal District Court of the Northern District of Illinois in September, October, and November of 1960, for income tax fraud. He was convicted after an eight-week trial and sentenced to two years each on three counts.

[REDACTED] furnished substantial information on (b)(2) approximately 15 occasions during the fall of 1960 that MURRAY HUMPHREYS was directing and "master-minding" the strategy to be used in the defense of TONY ACCARDO, who at that time was being tried for income tax fraud. This informant advised that just prior to the initiation of the trial, HUMPHREYS was able to obtain the list of jurors who comprised the jury panel and that he directed many of his associates and underlings to conduct investigation concerning the background of the prospective jurors with a view towards later approaching them during the course of the trial in order to obtain from them favorable treatment for ACCARDO. Informant advised that at no time, however, did he receive any information indicating that HUMPHREYS or his associates made any such approach to any member of the ACCARDO jury. Instead, this informant received information indicating that ACCARDO was most adamant in his position that the case of the Government against him was so weak that the possibility of his conviction was extremely remote. ACCARDO felt for this reason, according to the informant, that any such approach to the jury or to witnesses against him in order to influence their decision or testimony would be the source of additional trouble for ACCARDO and his associates and, therefore, no such tactics were to be utilized in this instance. This informant also advised that MURRAY HUMPHREYS did not agree with ACCARDO in his position but that since it was ACCARDO who was on trial, he had no recourse but to submit to it. [REDACTED] advised that

HUMPHREYS indicated that in the event that another prominent leader of organized crime was tried, that approaches would be made to jurors and witnesses and that these tactics would be employed especially if HUMPHREYS himself was to go on trial.

[REDACTED] also furnished information corroborating (b)(2) the above information furnished by [REDACTED] in reference to the fact that HUMPHREYS was interested in investigating the background of jurors in the ACCARDO case with the possibility of approaching them later to influence their decision in favor of ACCARDO and also in regard to the information that ACCARDO believed that the case of the Government against him was so weak that he would not resort to the usual tactics utilized by underworld leaders on trial in resorting to violence and intimidation against Government witnesses and would not resort in making a financial approach to the jurors. This informant, however, was not able to corroborate the information of [REDACTED] indicating that HUMPHREYS obtained a list of the jury panel and conducted a background investigation concerning each prospective juror.

Concerning ██████████ ██████████ learned that HUMPHREYS and his associates learned that ██████████, an associate of HUMPHREYS who has responsibility for gambling activities on the west side of Chicago, had a cousin who ran a gasoline station in Wood Dale, the residence of ██████████. ██████████ stated that HUMPHREYS and his associates considered requesting ██████████ to contact the filling station operator in order to determine additional details concerning the background of ██████████.

In spite of the above information furnished by ██████████ concerning the identity of the jurors pinpointed by HUMPHREYS and his associates for possible contact, it should be noted that at no time did this informant, or any other, furnish any information indicating that such approaches were consummated and, to the contrary, this informant furnished information indicating that due to ACCARDO's position, as set out above, these approaches were never made. However, it should be noted that this informant did not furnish information indicating definitely that the approaches were not made. He merely furnished information indicating that in all probability they were not made.

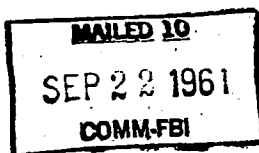

DURING RECENT MEETINGS ON THREE OCCASIONS HUMPHREYS ALONG WITH SEVERAL OF HIS HOODLUM ASSOCIATES HAVE INDICATED THAT THEY ARE MEETING AT A MEETING PLACE WHICH THEY REFER TO AS "MURPHY'S." AND EXHAUSTIVE SURVEY ON THE NEAR NORTH SIDE HAS BEEN CONDUCTED IN AN ATTEMPT TO LOCATE "MURPHY'S." IT IS KNOWN FROM [REDACTED] THAT "MURPHY'S" IS LOCATED WITHIN WALKING DISTANCE OF CELANO'S. HOWEVER, THERE IS NO RESTAURANT OR SIMILAR PLACE WHICH IS NAMED "MURPHY'S" AND INVESTIGATION HAS NOT DETERMINED THAT ANY SUCH PLACE IS MANAGED BY A MAN NAMED MURPHY.  In May of this year attempts were made to contact HUMPHREYS' associate, [REDACTED] is a prominent attorney with offices and residences in Chicago, [REDACTED]. After two or three contacts with [REDACTED] secretary, [REDACTED] contacted this office and advised that he had obtained information which led him to believe that he was under investigation by the FBI and that for this reason "the FBI has forfeited all right to talk with me." However, after conversation with him he advised that he would consider discussing his relationship with HUMPHREYS with the Agent assigned the HUMPHREYS' investigation in Chicago. When he failed to recontact this office a message was left with his secretary that the FBI continued to desire to converse with him. [REDACTED] has not contacted this office in response to the above message. The Bureau then instructed that no further contact be made of [REDACTED] and as a result all efforts to contact him were discontinued.

It is felt that there is not much likelihood that [REDACTED] would be a co-operative interviewee concerning his knowledge of the activities of HUMPHREYS; however, it is known that [REDACTED] has been in contact with HUMPHREYS for at least two decades probably on a frequent basis and that [REDACTED] has represented HUMPHREYS' interests in Las Vegas on numerous occasions. Therefore, [REDACTED] is certainly in a position,

he were so inclined, to furnish information which would result in the successful prosecution of HUMPHREYS for failure to report his income. It is also noted that [REDACTED] has been contacted on four previous occasions during recent years by the Agent assigned the HUMPHREYS' investigation and, in [REDACTED] own words, "a very pleasant relationship has always existed" between this Agent and [REDACTED]. It is, therefore, felt that if this office were allowed to pursue the interview of [REDACTED] that there is some possibility that some pertinent information may be obtained.

It is noted that [REDACTED] was under investigation by the Los Angeles Office up until the early part of this year but that this investigation has been closed since that time.

The identity of ██████████ is unknown, although it is possible ██████████ here refers to ██████████ of the Justice Department in Washington.

From the above conversation, it would seem that ██████████ has developed a source, apparently ██████████ who is able to provide him information concerning the identity and authority of agents and supervisors in the IRS office in Chicago. It is not clear from the above conversation whether ██████████ has been able to obtain information from ██████████ or any of the above-named individuals concerning their investigations.

██████████ also reported on September 29, 1961 that a conversation took place on that date between top hoodlum (b)(2) ██████████ and an individual believed to be ██████████ (b)(7)(C):C, a Chicago attorney who is known to be associated with all Chicago top hoodlums. The informant advised that HUMPHREYS took no part in this conversation but possibly was present during it. In view of the fact that HUMPHREYS took no part in the conversation and was possibly not present, this information is not being reported in the body of this report; however, it is noted that the conversation concerned an apparent payment of \$15,000, probably in regard to the impending trial of top hoodlum JIMMY ALLEGRETTI and his hoodlum associates. From the information provided by the informant, it was not clear whether the payment was being made surreptitiously as a bribe for the corruption of judges having to do with the trial of ALLEGRETTI or whether the payments were being made in an entirely legal manner for attorneys' fees.

Re Bureau airtel dated 11/15/61 suggesting consideration be given to determining whether SAM DE STEFANO is a proper subject for investigation as a top hoodlum.

(b)(7)(C)

The Chicago Office gave such consideration to DE STEFANO on several occasions during the recent two years or so. DE STEFANO has been interviewed on several occasions by SA [REDACTED] of this office. Although he has been considered by this office and by the Chicago Police Department as a prime suspect in scores of gangland type killings, in the Chicago area, no information has ever been developed indicating that DE STEFANO is a member of organized crime, even on a lower level, in the Chicago area. DE STEFANO has advised that although he grew up and has committed crimes in his youth with several hoodlums who are now prominent in this area, he is not in any way associated or connected with these individuals at the present time. It has been the opinion for some time of the Chicago Office that DE STEFANO is a psychopathic killer who has neurotic urges which he cannot resist, making him an extremely dangerous individual. For this reason, although he has furnished some information of value which has been of assistance in the investigation of Chicago's top hoodlums, he has never been considered a potential criminal informant due to his extreme emotional instability.

As confirmation of the above feelings of this office, attention is directed to my daily summary airtel entitled, "ACTIVITIES OF TOP HOODLUMS IN THE CHICAGO AREA," dated 11/16/61 wherein [REDACTED] reported that it is the feeling of the top members of organized crime that they are being subjected to unfair newspaper publicity due to DE STEFANO's actions and that they should have heeded HUMPHREYS' advice that they get DE STEFANO straightened out sometime ago. It was the comment of TONY ACCARDO that nobody would be able to connect DE STEFANO "with us" since WILLIE "POTATOES" DADDANO is the only one "who ever hung with him." The others indicated that they had never had anything to do with him and only said hello from time to time.

For the above reasons it is the opinion of the Chicago Office that DE STEFANO is not a proper subject for investigation as a top hoodlum. His status in this area does not justify such investigation. However, consideration is being given at this time to make additional contacts with DE STEFANO in an attempt to secure information of assistance to the Criminal Intelligence Program.
