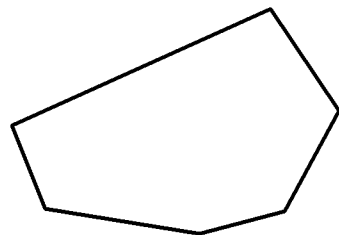

"LAST WEEK I RECEIVED A PACKAGE IN THE MAIL THAT INCLUDED A XEROXED LETTER FROM THE CITIZENS COMMISSION TO INVESTIGATE THE FBI". U

ON THIS DATE NAT HENTOFF, TWENTY FIVE FIFTH AVE., NYC, INTERVIEWED IN ATTEMPT TO ASCERTAIN WHAT WAS IN PACKAGE AND TO OBTAIN XEROXED LETTER HOWEVER, HE REFERRED AGENTS TO HIS ATTORNEY  EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF AMERICAN CIVIL LIBERTIES UNION, ONE FIVE SIX FIFTH AVE., NYC. HENTOFF ADMITTED RECEIVING PACKAGE AND XEROXED COPY OF LETTER BUT WOULD NOT SAY WHAT WAS IN PACKAGE. THE ARTICLE QUOTES THE XEROXED LETTER AS FOLLOWS: U
