





ROBINSON, Chief of Police, Natchez, Mississippi, advised that he has been unable to obtain any information which definitely indicates that the subject has been involved in any interstate transportation of females for purposes of prostitution. He advised that he has heard this on several occasions but that he has been unable to substantiate it in any way.

On June 12, 1969, the facts in this matter were discussed with Assistant United States Attorney

Jackson, Mississippi, and at that time he advised that he would not consider any prosecution in this matter inasmuch as there is no substantial evidence to indicate any violation of the Federal statutes.
