

U/M NUMBER 2 CALLED AGAIN AT 12:27 AND STATED "THE FALN IS BACK, BOMBS ARE SET TO GO OFF AT BATTERY PARK AND CITY HALL." NEW YORK OFFICE IS ATTEMPTING TO OBTAIN A TAPE OF THE 911 CALL.
