FOR INFORMATION OF RECEIVING OFFICES, CAPTIONED VISIT IS UNDERWAY. MANDELA EXPERIENCED SOME HEALTH PROBLEMS WHICH DELAYED HIS NEW YORK ARRIVAL APPROXIMATELY TWO (2) HOURS, WHICH ALSO CAUSED SOME SCHEDULE DELAYS.

NUMEROUS THREAT CALLS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED BY 911 OPERATORS ON JUNE 20, 1990 TO INCLUDE:

10:50 U/M NUMBER 1 CLAIMED TO BE FROM ARYAN KNIGHTS AND STATED THERE WERE TWO (2) BOMBS ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE. ARYAN KNIGHTS IS AN UNKNOWN GROUP TO THE NEW YORK OFFICE, INDICES NEGATIVE.

U/M NUMBER 2 CALLED 911 TWICE, FIRST CALL AT 12:15 STATED HE WOULD KILL EX-CONGRESSMAN HERMAN BADILLO AND NEW YORK CITY MAYOR DINKINS WITH BOMBS. U/M NUMBER 2 CALLED AGAIN AT 12:27 AND STATED "THE FALN IS BACK, BOMBS ARE SET TO GO OFF AT BATTERY PARK AND CITY HALL." NEW YORK OFFICE IS ATTEMPTING TO OBTAIN A TAPE OF THE 911 CALL.

17:16, U/M NUMBER 4 STATES "A HIT SQUAD WILL KILL MANDELA TODAY OR TOMORROW." MOSSAD AND WHITE SOUTH AFRICANS. NEW YORK OFFICE HAS NO SPECIFIC THREAT INFORMATION REGARDING THESE GROUPS.

PA NY & NJ ARRESTED AN INDIVIDUAL ON JUNE 20, 1990 AT APPROXIMATELY 10:00 FOR CRIMINAL TRESPASS. THE INDIVIDUAL APPEARED IN RECEIVING LINE AT JFK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT PRIOR TO MANDELA'S ARRIVAL. INDIVIDUAL IS BEING HELD TO UNDERGO PSYCHIATRIC

EXAMINATION. INDIVIDUAL IS DESCRIBED AS [REDACTED] DOB [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] MALE, HISPANIC, 6'11, BROWN EYES, BROWN HAIR,

ADDRESS [REDACTED]

RE NY teletype to the Bureau dated 5/25/90.

Enclosed for the Bureau and WMFO is tentative schedule of MANDELA'S activities while in New York.

MANDELA is currently scheduled to arrive 6/20/90, 9:00AM, JFK international airport and depart 6/23/90, 8:00AM enroute to Boston. During MANDELA'S visit, he will stay at Gracie Mansion, the residence of the NYC Mayor. Several activities are planned which are expected to elicit a large attendance.

United States Department of State (USDOS), who has primary security responsibility for MANDELA, will be operating a Command Post (CP) for the duration of MANDELA'S visit. The USDOS will be operational from 6/20/90 through 6/23/90. The NYO Domestic Terrorism Task Force (DTTF) will have a member in the USDOS CP 24 hours, working 12 hour shifts. Additionally, DTTF will have two teams of one agent and one NYCPD detective on each 12 hour shift. These teams will be with the USDOS advance team and motorcade in order to respond to any PFO violation re MANDELA that may arise. The U.S. Attorney's Office (SDNY & EDNY) have been apprised of MANDELA'S visit and are available re any possible PFO violation.

The NYO will keep the Bureau and WMFO apprised of any developments.

6. (U) DR. GECELTER, WHO HAS REPORTEDLY ATTENDED TO MANDELA SINCE HE PERFORMED A PROSTATE OPERATION ON THE ANC LEADER IN 1986, ADDED, "(MANDELA) IS A VERY FIT YOUNG MAN FOR HIS AGE." HE SAID A THOROUGH CHECK-UP OF MANDELA HAD REVEALED NO MEDICAL PROBLEMS. HE AND OTHERS CLOSE TO MANDELA SAID THE OPERATION ITSELF DID NOT REQUIRE A 6-DAY

RECUPERATION PERIOD, BUT THE CLINIC AFFORDED A QUIET PLACE
