Details:

On May 3, 2019, writer and SA [REDACTED] with the assistance of members from the United States Coast Guard (USCG) and USCG- Investigative Service SA [REDACTED] responded to the cruise ship vessel Island Princess, operated by Princess Cruises, at approximately 11:30 AM. The Agents responded after receiving a notification, via email, that a crew-member was found deceased from an apparent suicide earlier that morning en route to the next port of call; Juneau, Alaska.

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Title: (U) Opening EC
Re: 45A-AN-3105004, 05/06/2019

In summary, it was reported that a crew member, NEMANJA JANKOVIC, date of birth 03/06/1996, was found hanging from a cord/strap tied inside the ventilation duct above the bunk beds in cabin 2351. Attempts to revive JANKOVIC by medical personnel were unsuccessful and he was pronounced dead by the Island Princess' Senior Doctor at approximately 02:55 hours on May 5, 2019. The ship's coordinates at the time of death was 55' 43.1N - 134' 27.9W, approximately within four miles of the Alaskan coast.

As part of the investigation, Agents conducted multiple interviews of the crew and conducted a search of JANKOVIC's cabin via consent from JANKOVIC's roommate. The interviews and cabin search will be documented in the case file in separate 302s.

The Alaska State Medical Examiner's Office (ALMEO) was contacted and the body was subsequently released to the director of Legacy Funeral Homes and Cremation Services [REDACTED] at 4:25 PM. [REDACTED] is working with ALMEO on transporting JANKOVIC to their office for an autopsy.

Based on the results of the interviews and search of the cabin, it appears the cause of death is suicide pending ALMEO's autopsy findings.

A copy of JANKOVIC's biographical information, the above referenced email notification, [REDACTED] business card, and a map, which was provided by Island Princess Chief Security Officer (SECO) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] showing the ship's approximate location, will be maintained in the 1A portion of the file for reference.

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Good Morning, [redacted]

Here are the details on our crew member suicide on the Island Princess this morning.

At 04:30 hours this morning, Security Officer [redacted] was called to cabin 2351 to what appeared to be a suicide of a crew member last night.

The medical team was called to the cabin after the cabin mate had found the victim, 23-year-old Serbian (Nemanja Jankovic) hanging from a cord tied inside the ventilation duct above the bunk beds. Attempts to revive him by the medical personnel were unsuccessful and he was pronounced dead by Senior Doctor at 02:55 hours.

Ships coordinate at the time were 55' 43.1N - 134' 27.9W and within 4 miles of the Alaskan coast.

I have attached the cabin mates statement which gives a bit of an idea about the background behind possible motive for self-harm. Also attached are a couple of photos that may be of interest. The vent cover was found on the desk and the noose was put in this position by the medical team after the victim was cut down. As far as the SSO could see both knots were undisturbed. The cord used may have been a strap from one of the life jackets in the cabin.

Cabin and adjacent cabin (Shared bathrooms) are sealed with a security sentry posted.

The Juneau Port Agent has been notified and subsequent notification was given to the Juneau PD. The ship will be arriving in Juneau at approximately 11: 00 hours today (3 May 2019).

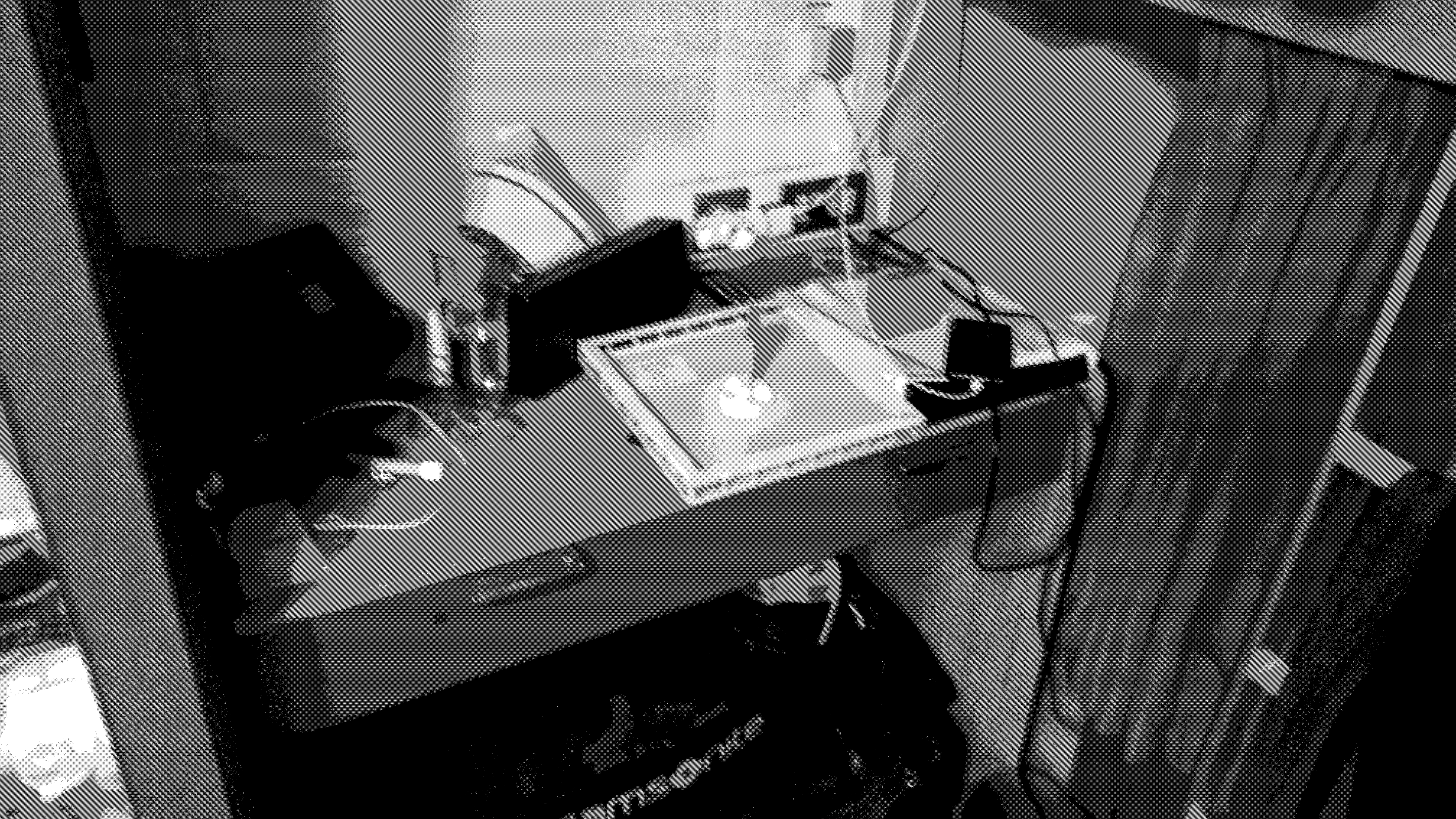

his shirt and applied the pads and did another pulse check. The AED advised not to shock. They continued chest compressions, which was about when then medical team began to arrive one at a time.

Initial response to the cabin was [REDACTED] and nurse [REDACTED]. 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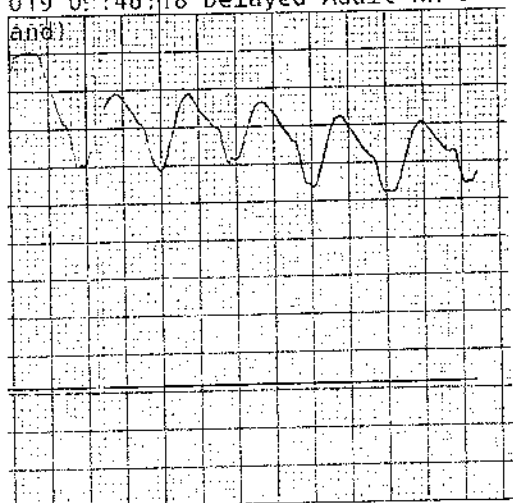

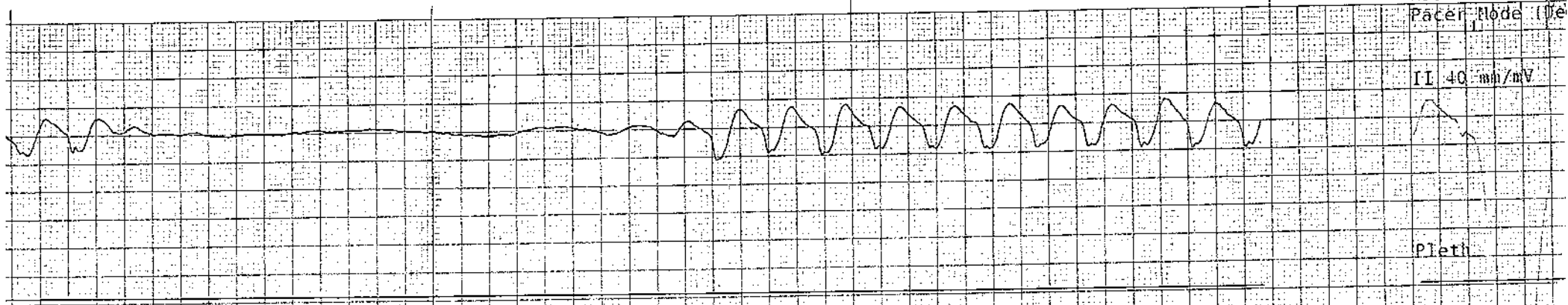

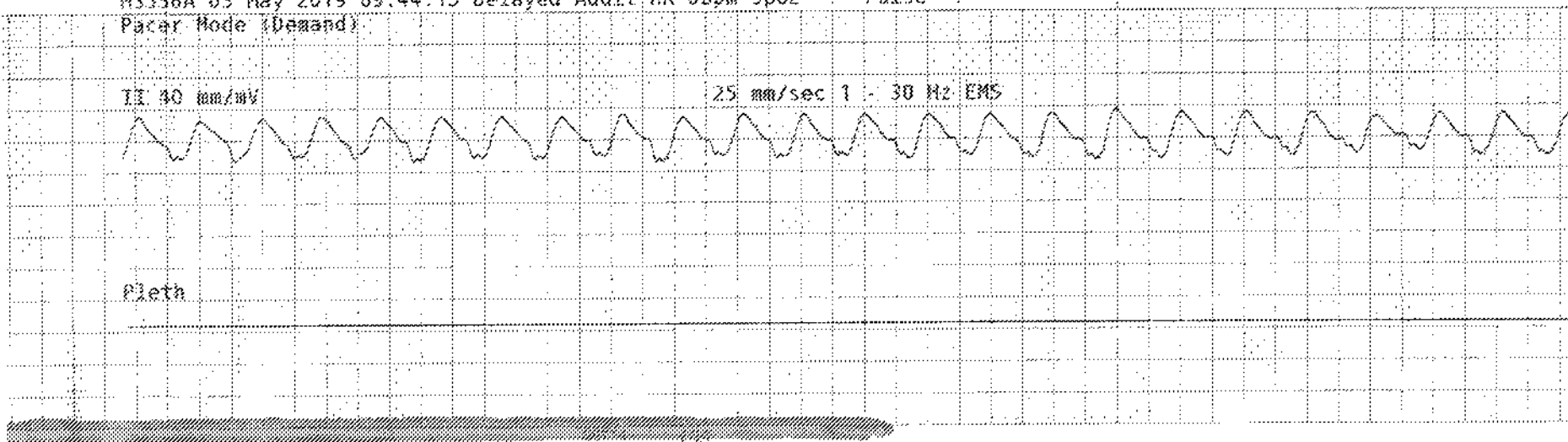

On the 3-May-2019 at about +- 01:55 I Received a knock on my door by on call nurse [redacted] stated she needed help with a 911 call received, moments earlier, I followed her and two other crew member (Augusto) to cabin 2351.

->01:56 we entered the cabin (cabin mate [redacted] opened door)

I Noted crew member hanging from the air vent via a black nylon belt, unresponsive, pale.

I lifted him up by the knees, instructed nurse to call MRT.

On arrival in cabin 2351 Senior Nurse [redacted] and Nurse [redacted] were present on scene and performing CPR on crew member Nemanja Jankovic, Initial rhythm check performed using the AED and rhythm was non-shockable.

According to the first responders, crew member had been found hanging in his cabin. Ligature marks were noted around his neck and pupils were already fixed and dilated.

High quality CPR was continued with compressions and bag mask ventilation was initiated with adequate chest rise.

Senior Doctor [redacted] arrived on scene and led the resuscitation efforts with the assistance of the medical team.

IV access was obtained, IV fluids were started. Glucose was noted to be 2.8mmols/litre and was corrected with IV glucose. Glucose when rechecked later was noted to be 8.8mmols/litre.

Initial difficulties with obtaining reading on AED therefore changed to MRX.

Resuscitation was continued according to ACLS principals with a total of 9 doses of adrenaline received. Patient remained in asystole throughout. CPR was continued for >20 cycles with no return of spk circulation.

H's and T's:

Patient most likely suffered from asphyxiation secondary to hanging.

Alcohol intoxication with hypoglycemia is a possible contributing factor and hypoglycaemia was corrected.

In retrospect;

3 May 2019 01:58 Ship's Tannoy and paging for MRT event, I proceeded to crew cabin 2351 finding crew member Nemanja JANKOVIC supine on his cabin floor and our Senior Nurse [redacted] compressions, assisted by on call medic Nurse [redacted] They both reported responding to an emergency call placed by C/M [redacted] (cabin mate of JANKOVIC), the two first arriving on finding C/M JANCOVIC hanging from his cabin ventilation inlet. SNurse [redacted] lifted JANCOVIC, Nurse [redacted] placing the Ship MRT call and assisted by cutting the material from which JANCOVIC was ventilation duct. SNurse [redacted] reported putting JANKOVIC on the cabin floor and finding him unconscious, no breathing and no central pulses, both medics started with basic life support after removing neck. Ship's Doctor [redacted] arrived on scene and assisted with ventilation and chest compression until the full medical team arrived.

I identified myself as the resuscitation lead, finding no central pulses and confirmed no breathing and him being unconscious, dilated and fixed pupils with ligature markings (hard to the touch) around his cold, initiating advanced cardiac life support with the assistance of the full on board medical team as we did not know how long he had been hanging.

The first two medics reported AED prompting no shock advised during the initial 2x2 minute BLS cycles. On my initial and subsequent assessment, the AED could not find an analyzing rhythm, with asys soon after using our MRX monitor, the same as for during the rest of the ACLS effort.

Hypoglycemia was diagnosed early during the resuscitation with BS 2.8mmol/L, remaining 2.8mmol/L after first 50ml 50% Dex IV, using a patent peripheral IV left arm line providing also 0.9% N/Saline v access (total of 700ml administer during the resuscitation). BS 8.8mmol/L achieved after a second 50ml 50% Dextrose IV. We needed to place a second peripheral IV line (just before IO would have been good results.

He received a total of 9 Epinephrine 1mg IV doses during our efforts, following the ACLS non shockable algorithm, the MRX persistently demonstrating asystole.

After approximately 57 minutes of ACLS efforts, I declared crew member Nemanja JANKOVIC deceased at 02:55 3 May 2019, Ship's Dr [redacted] concurring.

At no time during our cardiorespiratory resuscitations did he respond clinically or noted by MRX monitoring. His pupils remained dilated and fixed throughout our efforts.

Due to the location of the body, Agents gained entry to cabin 2351 through the adjoining cabin; cabin 2349. Cabin 2349 was not searched.

Entry photographs were taken. During the search of the cabin, Agents located the two parts of the ligature used in JANKOVIC's apparent suicide. One part of the ligature still remained tied to a bracket on the room's vent, and the other part was located adjacent to JANKOVIC's body. SA [REDACTED] removed the portion of the ligature from the vent's bracket. Both pieces of the ligature were combined into one evidence bag. Per the direction of the medical examiner, the evidence bag with the ligature remained with the body.

Agent Note: In previous interviews, which are documented in the captioned case, it was stated that the ligature was cut into two parts after JANKOVIC was found and the ship's medical personnel tried to revive him.

Agents located an Adidas bag in the closet that appeared to be the source of the ligature. The bag was missing a strap and the ligature appeared to match the one strap that still remained on the bag. Photographs of the

Per the medical examiners request, measurements of the distance from the vent's bracket to the floor and the height of a chair, which was in the immediate vicinity of the body, were taken. The distance from the bracket to the floor was 7'4" and the height of the chair was 18". Agents placed plastic bags on JANKOVIC's hands and secured them with zip ties.

Agents assisted the ship's medical staff with placing JANKOVIC's body in a body bag for transport to the Alaska Medical Examiner's Office. The body was then removed from cabin 2351 and taken to the ship's medical facility to await transport.

Exit photos were taken and the search was completed at approximately 4:20 PM.

At 4:25 PM, [REDACTED] with Legacy Funeral Homes and Cremation Services, took possession of JANKOVIC's body to prepare it for transport to the Alaska Medical Examiner's Office in Anchorage, Alaska.

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The search warrant photos were transferred to a compact disk, which will be maintained in a 1A portion of the file. A copy of the FBI form FD-26 "Consent to Search" form for a search of the cabin signed by [REDACTED] will also be maintained in the 1A portion of the file for reference.

The body is that of a well-developed, thin male appearing consistent with the reported age of 23 years. The body weighs 123 pounds and measures 70 inches in height. The body is cool to the touch and has been previously refrigerated. Rigor mortis is 3 to 4+ in the lower extremities and 1 to 2+ in the upper extremities. The body is showing early green color decomposition change to the lower abdomen. The body has not been embalmed.

The scalp is covered with dark hair, measuring between 1/4 and 1/2 inch in length. The eyes are natural with white sclerae. There is early tache noir noted with a pink-appearing, drying and slightly congested appearance on the right and left eyes. The ears and nose are well formed and symmetric. The mouth is atraumatic. The oral cavity contains natural teeth in good condition. The neck is normally formed. The chest is well formed and symmetric. The abdomen is flat.

The upper extremities are normally formed as are the hands. The fingernails are trimmed 1/16 inch beyond the nail beds. The lower extremities are normally formed as are the feet. The toenails are trimmed less than 1/16 inch beyond the nail beds. The soles of the feet are unremarkable. The external genitalia are those of a normally developed adult male. There is a pink-tan appearance to the skin of the scrotum, consistent with postmortem drying artifact. The back and anus are normally formed.

EVIDENCE OF INJURIES

HEAD AND NECK

A ligature furrow is noted about the neck. The ligature furrow measures 1.5 cm in width in the anterior midline of the neck. The ligature furrow shows no significant depth in this region. The ligature furrow continues posteriorly and superiorly along the lateral left neck where it measures between 0.4 and 1.0 cm in width. The furrow continues posteriorly and superiorly. The furrow marking is noted 5 cm inferior to the left external auditory canal. The ligature furrow ends in the posterior hairline approximately 5.5 cm posterior and inferior to the left external auditory canal. The ligature marking continues posteriorly along the lateral right neck initially horizontally and then continues superiorly. The ligature marking on the lateral right neck measures 2 cm in width and is noted 10 cm inferior to the right external auditory canal. The posterolateral right neck ligature furrow turns superiorly and ends in the hairline of the posterior neck 9 cm posterior and inferior to the right external auditory canal. The ligature marking is consistent with a posterior point of suspension.

The ligature consists of two segments of previously cut woven strap-like material. The strap material measures approximately 2 cm in width. The dry red, abrasion-like marking of the ligature furrow on the skin is consistent with the received ligature.

EXTREMITIES

A 7 x 2 cm area of purple-pink contusion is on the lateral left wrist. Three small puncture marks are noted on the skin surface in this region and may possibly represent IV therapy versus injection site. A punctate, red, skin puncture-like mark is on the anterolateral left forearm and may represent IV therapy versus IV injection site. A punctate pink area of skin puncture is in the right antecubital fossa and is consistent with possible IV therapy efforts versus injection sites.

A 2 x 1 cm, faint pink-gray, healing contusion is on the anterior right leg.

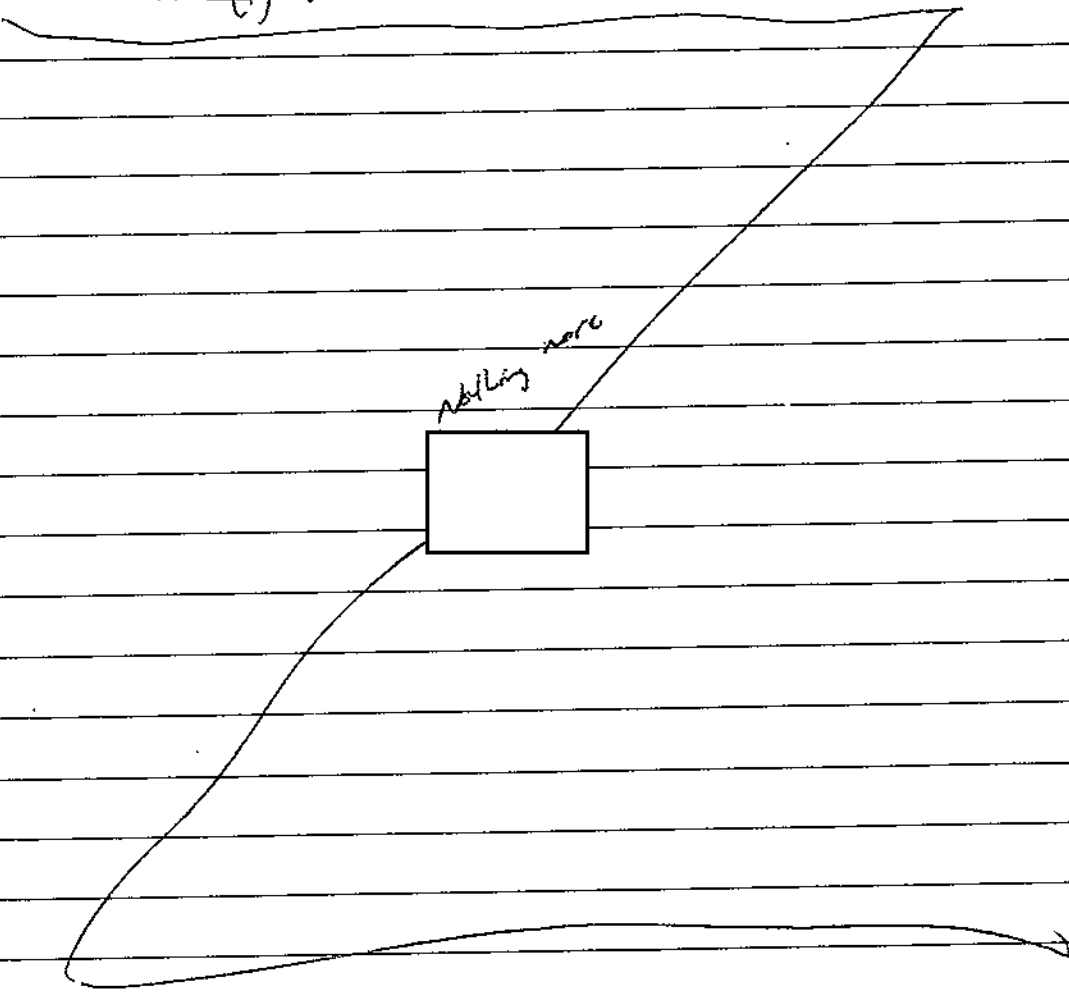

Dr. Vantor was directing the medical operations from the corridor while the rest of the medical team was rendering aid to (V) Jancovic. Carranza described (V) Jancovic as impulsive. After a few weeks of dating, he began saying things like "You are my world, you are my princess, I want you" and (PK) Carranza found this odd.

A few months ago, (PK) Carranza sent a text message to (V) Jancovic and they started to communicate again. When (V) Jancovic found out (PK) Carranza was scheduled to be on the M/V Island Princess at the same time as he was (V) Jancovic thought this was a sign that they were meant to be together romantically and that it was destiny. (PK) Carranza described her communication with (V) Jancovic as casually romantic but (V) Jancovic was very serious about his intentions to be romantically involved with her.

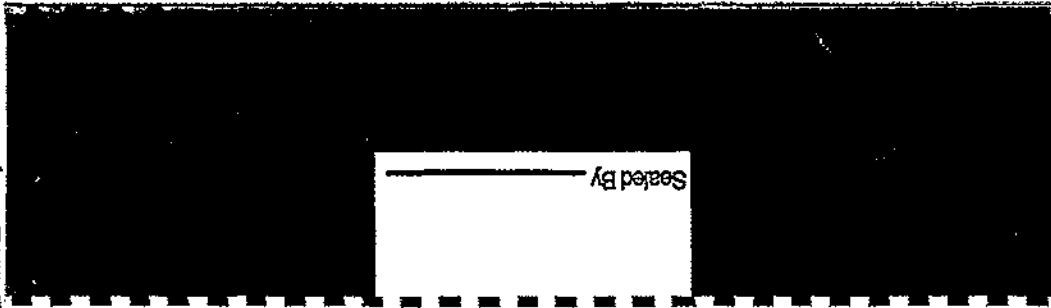

Authorization for Release of Remains

There is no legal requirement for the use of a funeral home or embalming. The State Medical Examiner's Office (SMEO) does not embalm or provide other funeral home services. At the direction of the next of kin, the SMEO can release remains directly to the family or to a funeral home. Funeral homes are often able to make the body more presentable and therefore help prevent additional trauma to the family. Because the SMEO assumed jurisdiction to determine the cause and manner of death, the SMEO will pay for the remains to be shipped back to the community nearest death. If a request is made to ship remains to a different community, and there are additional costs, the family will be responsible for the additional cost.

If the legal next of kin elects not to use a funeral home and to pick the remains up from our office in Anchorage or have the remains shipped directly to a community:

- The State Medical Examiner's Office (SMEO) will pay to transport the remains to the community nearest the location of death via common carrier (airlines).
- If the next of kin requests the remains to be shipped to a location other than the location of death, the family is responsible for any additional transportation costs incurred as a result.
- If the next of kin chooses to designate someone other than a funeral home to receive the remains, a Burial Transit Permit will be issued thru the Medical Examiner's Office at the time the remains are received. There is no charge or wait time for a Burial Transit Permit.
- The SMEO does not provide any embalming, dressing, casketing, or cosmetizing of the remains before transportation. The SMEO will provide for cosmetic services to make the head, face, neck and hands of the deceased presentable if those parts are disfigured by the SMEO examination.
- The remains will be transported back to the location of death in an approved airline shipping container, provided at no cost by our office. This container is constructed of plywood with a corrugated cardboard top. These containers are disposable and do not need to be returned.
- Transportation of the remains will be dependent upon the schedule of the SMEO and accommodating airlines.
- If the next of kin or designated individual is receiving the remains from our office, they need to call ahead to schedule an appointment. You may contact the office at our main phone number, (907) 334-2200, between 7:30 AM and 4:30 PM Monday thru Friday. If the next of kin chooses to transport privately, they will incur the transportation costs as a result.

If the legal next of kin selects a funeral home for embalming, dressing, casketing or cremation:

- The State Medical Examiner's Office (SMEO) will pay to transport the remains from Anchorage to the community nearest the location of death via common carrier (airlines).
- If the next of kin requests the remains to be shipped to a location other than the location of death, the family is responsible for any additional transportation costs incurred as a result.
- If the family selects a casket, the family is responsible for paying the additional transportation costs (extra weight the casket adds) of shipping the casketed remains back to the location of death.
- The required burial transit permit will be provided by the funeral home.
- The family is responsible for paying the selected funeral home for any embalming, transport or other services provided by the funeral home.
- The family is responsible for paying the funeral home for any clothing, dressing, or casketing provided by them.
- Certain funeral homes will not accept personal property. If a funeral home is selected that does not accept personal property it will be the responsibility of the next of kin to make arrangements to pick up the property at the State Medical Examiner's Office. Property can NOT be mailed.
- Some funeral homes will not release the remains until all costs have been paid.
