Enclosed for the FBI Laboratory are the original threatening letter and envelope, plus two photostat copies of the letter and envelope.

Also enclosed are one photostat copy of the letter and envelope for the Minnesota Division.

Victim, who is known nationally as DICK CLARK, Star of American Bandstand, WFIL - TV, Philadelphia, Pa., residence, 308 Dogwood Lane, Wallingford, Pa., was interviewed on 9/20/62 by SA [REDACTED]. Victim advised the threatening letter was received in the mail addressed to his show on 9/18/62. Victim stated he has not appeared in Minnesota and is not acquainted with the name reflected on the envelope. He stated he appeared at a show in Wisconsin about four weeks ago and that was the closest to Minnesota that he has been. Victim stated his volume of mail to American Bandstand was several thousand daily and this was only the second threat he recalled.

The letter was handwritten in blue ink on one side of white paper and mailed in a white envelope postmarked 9/16/62, Saint Paul, Minnesota, addressed to "DICK CLARK, American Bandstand, P. O. Box 6, Philadelphia 5, Pa." The letter contained the following threat:

"You better get off television soon or else I will kill you. I have a rifle and I will use it. You better hire somebody to protect you like you did last year...."

The envelope contained a return address reflecting

[redacted] White Bear Lake, Minnesota."

The enclosed letter has been handled by the victim and the following employees of the American Bandstand:



The Laboratory is requested to examine the enclosed letter and search through the anonymous letter files. Further, it is requested that both the letter and envelope be processed by the Latent Fingerprint Section for latent prints.

The facts of this case were discussed with Assistant United States Attorney [redacted] Eastern District of Pennsylvania, on 9/20/62, by SA [redacted] AUSA [redacted] advised that in view of the threat investigation be conducted to determine the identity of the author.

Minnesota Division will attempt to locate one [redacted] White Bear Lake, Minnesota, to determine his knowledge of instant letter and set out appropriate leads. It is noted that victim received an anonymous post card, postmarked 6/14/62, St. Paul, Minnesota, threatening to kill his wife (PH 9-2297). The picture side of the card reflected a scene of Lake Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, showing North and South Highway. This letter was also addressed to the American Bandstand at Philadelphia. In this instance, AUSA [redacted] Eastern District of Pennsylvania, advised he would not consider prosecution as the threat was not considered serious and no investigation was conducted.

RICHARD W. CLARK, 308 Dogwood Lane, Wallingford, Pa., furnished the following information:

CLARK advised that he is known nationally as DICK CLARK of the American Bandstand, WFIL-TV, Philadelphia, Pa. CLARK stated that he receives several thousand letters of fan mail daily and they are processed by his employees at the television studio. He stated the letter in question was received in the studio mail on September 18, 1962. CLARK stated he was not acquainted with the name [redacted] as reflected on the envelope and stated in all probability it was some juvenile that was responsible for writing the letter. He further stated that he had not appeared in Minnesota and that the closest he has been to that State was Wisconsin where he made an appearance approximately four weeks ago.

CLARK stated that although he receives a large volume of mail daily, this is the only threat that he can recall within the past year. He stated he recalled a similar threat to kill his wife which was also mailed from Minnesota but at that time the threat was written on a postcard.

CLARK stated that he is not in fear of bodily harm and was advised that no protection could be afforded him by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and that if he desired such protection at any time he would have to request it from the local police department.


CLARK produced the letter that was handwritten in blue ink on one side of white paper and mailed in a white envelope postmarked September 16, 1962, St. Paul, Minn., addressed to "DICK CLARK, American Bandstand, P.O. Box 6, Philadelphia 5, Pa." The letter contained the following threat:

CLARK advised that to his knowledge the letter had been handled only by himself and the following employees of American Bandstand:



CLARK stated he could furnish no additional information regarding the letter or the author.

[redacted] public relations employee for the DICK CLARK American Bandstand, WFIL-TV, Philadelphia, Pa., furnished the following information:

[redacted] advised that the letter containing the threat to DICK CLARK was received in the morning mail on September 18, 1962, which was picked up at the 30th Street Post Office Station. She stated that the fan mail is delivered to the studio in a large mail sack and is processed by the employees. She stated the letter in question was brought to the attention of Mr. CLARK and he advised that it should be reported to the FBI. [redacted] stated that letters of this nature have been extremely limited, although the volume of mail received daily is several thousand. She stated the name [redacted] on the envelope was not recalled by her or any of the other employees as an individual who may have requested tickets to one of the shows at any previous time. She stated, however, that she could not be certain, due to the large volume of mail, that this individual had not corresponded with the studio previously.

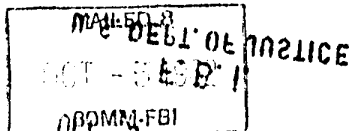

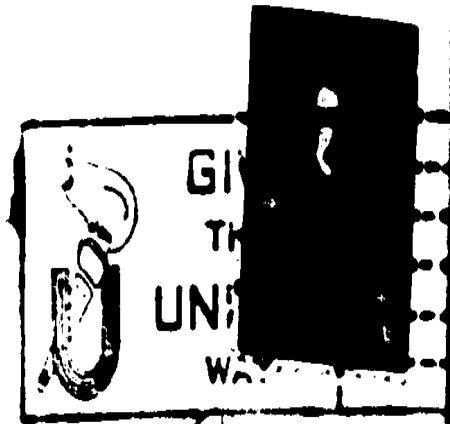

He stated that he knows no other [redacted] or [redacted] other than his brother but would have no reason to suspect his brother of having written to the Dick Clark Show. It should be noted that [redacted] who was very cooperative, has been recontacted and he advised that neither he nor any of his relatives have any knowledge of this matter and all apparently expressed concern because it would appear that someone is using the family name in a derogatory fashion. [redacted] further advised that he is unable to recognize the handwriting on the envelope of the extortion letter.

On July 26, 1985, WARREN D. KNOWLES (former Governor of Wisconsin) received, through the United States Postal Service, a letter and a tape delivered to his home, [REDACTED] from [REDACTED]. During the course of the 90 minute tape [REDACTED] threatened HENRY MAIER (Mayor of Milwaukee, Wisconsin); ANTHONY EARL (Governor of Wisconsin); [REDACTED] TV newscaster); [REDACTED] TV newscaster); [REDACTED] (Milwaukee County Executive); and [REDACTED] childhood counselor). Although KNOWLES was not threatened, [REDACTED] demanded \$6,000.00.

The Milwaukee Division became aware of the letter and tape on July 29, 1985, and between July 30, 1985 and August 1, 1985, all the aforementioned victims were notified, excluding [REDACTED]. Additionally, Special Agent (SA) [REDACTED] United States Secret Service (USSS), was notified of [REDACTED] threats. [REDACTED] indicated that the USSS was already aware of [REDACTED] as he had telephoned the White House in 1981 stating that he had a vision that someone with special weapons was going to kill President RONALD REAGAN.

On July 31, 1985, [REDACTED] was arrested by the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department under authority of a state warrant

charging disorderly conduct. [REDACTED] was subsequently committed to the Winnebago Mental Health Center for a twenty to thirty day evaluation. On August 1, 1985, Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) [REDACTED] authorized filing a complaint against [REDACTED]. On that same date United States Magistrate (USM) ROBERT L. BITTNER, Eastern District of Wisconsin, signed the complaint charging [REDACTED] with violation of Title 18, USC, Section 876.

KNOWLES, on August 8, 1985, received a second letter and tape, postmarked July 31, 1985, from [REDACTED]. During the course of the second 90 minute tape [REDACTED] threatened to kill United States Senator ROBERT KASTEN; television personalities JOHNNIE CARSON, ED MC MAHAN, DICK CLARK, and [REDACTED] (phonetic); and President RONALD REAGAN.

The Los Angeles Division was requested to contact victims CARSON, MC MAHAN, CLARK and [REDACTED] regarding the threats made against them by [REDACTED] U.S. Senator ROBERT KASTEN'S office, 517 East Wisconsin Avenue, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, was notified on August 9, 1985, of [REDACTED] threat against Senator KASTEN. Additionally, SA [REDACTED] USSS, was advised on August 9, 1985, of [REDACTED] threat to kill President REAGAN.

SA [REDACTED] subsequently interviewed [REDACTED] at the Winnebago Mental Health Center, on August 9, 1985. [REDACTED] also interviewed [REDACTED] psychiatrist (unidentified) who reported that he did not believe that [REDACTED] was dangerous.

Upon completion of his psychiatric evaluation, [REDACTED] was released without being prosecuted on the state disorderly conduct charges.

On September 26, 1985, [REDACTED] received through the United States Postal Service, postmarked September 23, 1985, from [REDACTED] a cassette tape, a photograph of [REDACTED] business card, and a short letter. In the cassette tape [REDACTED] makes another threat against CARSON.

This matter was presented to AUSA [REDACTED] on December 19, 1985. AUSA [REDACTED] declined to prosecute, citing minimal involvement.
