This case is presently assigned to SA [REDACTED] *b7c*

[REDACTED] Referenced letter sets forth lead to verify subject's employment at the Industrial Process, Newark, New Jersey. This apparently refers to Industrial Process Engineering Company, 8 Lister Avenue, Newark, New Jersey. Newark indices show that the subject is a close friend of ALBERT LEWISON, President of this company. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] furnished information in 1950 showing that MIRIAM MOSKOWITZ, who was also a subject in this espionage matter, and BROTHMAN were in frequent contact with LEWISON. LEWISON's wife once remarked that ABRAHAM BROTHMAN was a genius and she was hoping that her son would follow in his footsteps. During 1949 and 1950 BROTHMAN was employed by the Industrial Process Engineering Company, and it appears logical from the above that he is presently employed there. However, in view of his close association with the president of the company, it is felt that no direct inquiry would be made to verify this point. It is suggested that efforts be made to verify this employment through neighborhood sources in Dumont, New Jersey, and that if this is not possible, a photograph of BROTHMAN be obtained from New York and verification of his employment be done through observation. *b7c/b7d*

In attached referenced New York letter, it was pointed out that a NAOMI BROTHMAN had a check drawn on the County Trust Company, Dumont, N. J. in the amount of \$67.00, made payable to the UNITED STATES FESTIVAL COMMITTEE.

A check of the Bergen County telephone directory lists only one BROTHMAN and that is A. BROTHMAN, 17 Franklin, Dumont, N. J.

A review of the files of the Newark Office reflects that ABRAHAM BROTHMAN (NK file 100-33638) who resides at 17 Franklin, Dumont, N. J., has a wife NAOMI and in 1950 had two children who were then aged 9 and 5 and today would be 21 and 17.

It would appear unlikely that NAOMI BROTHMAN would plan to attend the Youth Festival and the possibility exists that the check for \$67.00, which would cover the cost of ten days at Helsinki, Finland, would be for one of the two BROTHMAN children.

It is being recommended that a new case be opened on NAOMI BROTHMAN for the purpose of determining who is planning on attending the Eight World Youth Festival in Helsinki, Finland, on July 27 to August 5, 1962. It is recommended that the identity of the children of BROTHMAN

The records of the Garden State Credit Bureau, Clifton, N.J. checked on 10/22/62 revealed that the Jersey Machine Mfg. Co. maintains offices at 8 Lister Ave. Newark, N.J., Market 4-4400. A chattel mortgage in the amount of \$300,000 was obtained from the Small Business Administration on 12/4/61. The Small Business Administration was not further identified and credit records contained no reference to it. Loans were also obtained from the 1st National Bank, Jersey City on 10/9/62 and 1/11/61. Credit records contained no information regarding the INDEPENDANT PRODUCTS CO.

- JERSEY MACHINE MFG. CO. -

The records of Dun & Bradstreet 90 Halstead St. East Orange, N.J. checked on 10/26/62 reveals that this is a NJ corporation chartered in March 1947 as INDUSTRIAL PROCESS EQUIPMENT Corp. On October 30, 1950 the name was amended to the one now in use. Officers are:

- Alfred Lewison, born 1905 in Germany - Mechanical Eng. Educated in Germany, came to US in 1926 to start this business. He is principal stockholder and general mgr.
- J.F. Garrard, born US about 1904. Agraduate engineer formerly employed MW Kellogg Co. NYC for 20 yrs. Joined subject company in 1951.
- Edward and Paul Lewison, sons of the President have spent their entire careers with this organization.

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
