Concerning the organizations mentioned above in the explanation of the different colored cards the following is to be noted:

1. Southern Conference for Human Welfare

This organization was cited as a Communist front which received money from the Robert Marshall Foundation, one of the principal sources of funds by which many Communist fronts operate (Special Committee on Un-American Activities, Report March 29, 1944, p. 147).

2. National Guardian

The 1949 report of the California Committee on Un-American Activities cited the "National Guardian" as a publication launched in New York in 1948, aiming at National circulation, which they found to be from its inception notoriously Stalinist in its staff, writers, management and contents.

Concerning JOHN ABT, mentioned above, who instructed GERTRUDE EVANS to include other names in her file, the following is to be noted:

LOUIS BUDENZ (cover by T. Symbol) self-admitted former Communist stated in 1950 that ABT was a concealed CP member. WHITTAKER CHAMBERS, self-admitted former Communist and courier in a Communist underground group in Washington, D. C., stated that he knew ABT as an important member of the CP underground in the Federal Government in the late 1930's.

One copy of this memorandum is being placed in each file of the names furnished by [redacted] since it is a fuller explanation of the nature of the list of names maintained by GERTRUDE EVANS.

If the card is one of the 440 cards recovered from the trash of SELMA REIN it will be attached to this memorandum. In the case of husband and wife combinations, the card will be attached to the husband's memorandum.



On 4/12/57, ESTHER SUROVELL was contacted in connection with an official interview of her husband, ABRAHAM JACOB SUROVELL. It will be noted that according to [redacted] her husband was at home at the time of this contact.

ESTHER SUROVELL denied that her husband was at home, stated that he had not been at home and she did not know when he would be at home. She then requested the identity of the interviewing agents and upon being advised of same stated flatly that neither she nor her husband would "have anything to say to the FBI." At that point she was informed that the contact concerned her husband and that she was unaware of the nature of the inquiry. She then stated that her husband might speak to this Bureau concerning someone applying for a government position but would not speak to the Agents concerning anything else. She was asked where her husband could be contacted or when he would be home. She replied that the interviewing agents could telephone for an interview at some future date. Inasmuch as the interviewing agents were aware that subject and her husband planned to move to New York in the immediate future, and since they had reason to believe that he was actually in the house at the time subject was advised that the agents considered it a waste of time to make arrangements for such an interview and again requested to speak to her husband.

Subject replied that she was paying our salaries through taxes and that she did not consider it a waste of time. She then reiterated that neither she nor her husband had anything to say, to this Bureau now or at any future time and requested the interviewing agents to leave.

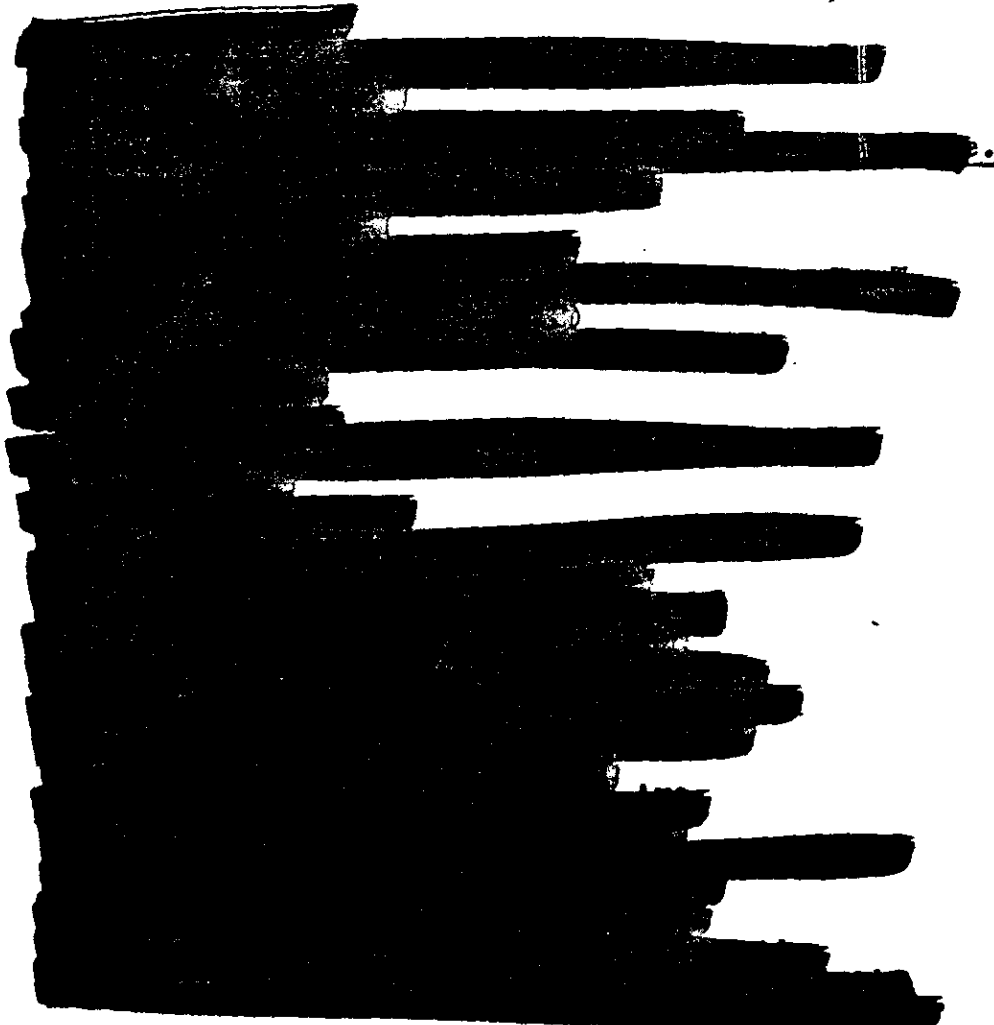
