The subject, ARA J. SUROVELL, alias Abraham Surovell, alias Abe J. Surovell, is living at Tuxedo, Md. He is rooming there with his sister Mrs. Sidney Katz. He formerly lived with she and her husband at 3574-lith St., N.W. They have been gone from the 11th St. address for about three years.

The subject is a white man about 23 years of age, unmarried. He formerly lived with his parents, MR. and MRS. HARRY SUROVELL, and his two brothers at 1245 E.9th St., Brooklyn, N.Y. He graduated from Brooklyn College in 1939.

The subject was given a probationary appointment as a draftsman at the Office of Education, Social Security Board, August 21, 1941.

The brother-in-law of this subject and the person with whom he is living, Sidney Katz, are mentioned several times in our C.P. files as Secretary-Treasurer of the Industrial Union Council of Karyland and the District of Columbia.

There is no C.P., Traffic, or-Criminal record of the subject in the files of the Ketropolitan Police Department. There is no Automobile or driver's license listed to the subject.

In view of the fact that the subject has moved from this jurisdiction and is employed by the United States Government, this request is being returned to your office for whatever action you may deem necessary.



The indices of the Washington Field Division reflect that the above individual is listed in the active indices of the American Youth Congress and the American Peace Mobilization and that he has been reported as having attended the Town Meeting of Youth, Washington Youth Council at Washington, D. C. SURO-VELL formerly resided at 3574 11th Street, M. W., Washington, D. C., and in 1941 was reported to be unemployed and taking a course in national defense at Mo-Winley High School in Washington, D. C.

This matter was referred for investigation to the Metropolitan Police Department, Mashington, D.C., and by report dated December 9, 1913, that Department reported that SUROVELL was presently residing at Tuxedo, Maryland, where he was reoming with his sister, Mrs. SIDNEY KATZ. He was reported to have resided at that address for approximately three years. This report further resided at that SUROVELL is white, about 23 years of age, and unmarried. He formerly lived with his parents, Mr. and Mrst HARRY SUROVELL, and his two brothers at 1215 East 9th Street, Brooklyn, New York, and graduated from Brooklyn College in 1939.

The report of the Metropolitan Police Department further reflected that SUROVELL is a brother-in-law of SIDNEY KATZ who is mentioned several times in the files of the Public Relations Squad of the Metropolitan Police Department as secretary-treasurer of the Industrial Union Council of Maryland and the District of Columbia. With reference to SIDNEY KATZ, it might be stated that there are numerous references to this individual in the files of the Washington Field Division with reference to alleged Communistic activities on his part.

According to the Police Department report, SUROVELL received a probationary appointment as draftsman at the Office of Education, Federal Security Agency, on August 21, 1941. It has been ascertained from the personnel division of this agency, however, that this appointment expired on January 20, 1942, and surrovell has not been employed by the Federal Security Agency since that time nor is there any indication that he is presently employed by anyother branch of the Federal Government.

In view of the fact that this individual is reported to be presently residing in your district, this information is being forwarded for whatever action you deem necessary and no further investigation is being conducted by this office.



A check of the files of the Civil Service record reflects that ESTHER SUROVELL, whose maiden name was SHAICK, worked for the Navy Department, Bureau of Supply and Accounts, from September 26, 1941, until she resigned on November 24, 1944, because of personal hardship.

ABE SUROVELL was employed August 21, 1941, as engineer draftsman, Federal Security Agency, Office of Education Defense, and resigned January 20, 1942. On February 9, 1942, he was employed by the Navy Department as an engineer draftsman, Hydrographic Office, Washington, D. C. He was on military furlough on December 1, 1942, and returned to the same job on February 18, 1946. He resigned June 27, 1947, to accept another position.

COMMUNIST PARTY ACTIVITIES

Confidential Informant T-1, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised on October 24, 1950, ESTHER SUROVELL of 247 Delaware Avenue, S.W.

and her husband, ABE, were at one time members of the Navy Department Cell of the Communist Party in Washington, D. C. ABE was active in the Communist Party from 1942 or 1943 until 1948, at which time he left the Navy Department and moved to New York City.

Confidential Informant T-2, of known reliability, advised on February 18, 1944, that the name of ESTHER SUROVELL appeared on an active list of members of the Washington Bookshop under the date of February 20, 1943. The address given at this time was 2408 57th Avenue, Tuxedo, Laryland.

Confidential Informant T-3, of known reliability, stated that on October 18, 1948, subject was in touch with ETHEL WEICHBROD, who has been identified by T-1 as having been a member of the Housewives branch of the Communist Party in Washington, D. C.



On August 28, 1950, ABRAHAL J. SUROVELL of 1102 Lifth Street, S.E., Washington, D. C., was interviewed by Special Agent ROBERT SPELTZER and LOUIS GLEIN regarding MORTON SOBELL who is to be tried on espionage charges at New York City. SUROVELL denied knowing SOBELL and stated that he never has been and is not now a member of the Communist Party and that his wife, ESTHER, has never been a member of the Communist Party. He did state, however, that he was a member of the Washington Bookshop from 1942 until 1946 but that when he read in the newspapers that the Bookshop was a Communist front organization, he requested that his name be removed from the membership list. He also stated that he had attended a meeting of the American Youth Congress sometime in 1940 or 1941. He stated that he was invited and did not participate as an official or a member. At the time of the interview, a statement was taken by the interviewing agents but SUROVELL refused to sign it.

lirs. C. COOKSIE of 1100 hoth Street, S.E., advised that she had lived next door to the SUROVELLS for two and one-half years and that she knows nothing of their outside activities. She stated that they appeared to be good neighbors; that ESTHER has twin boys who occupy all of her time and that ESTHER seldon goes out of the house. She stated that she had never heard them discuss Communism and that ABE, who is a draftsman, stays home at nights working on plans.

Mrs. JOHN KNOX, of the same address, could give no information that would indicate disloyalty to the United States or any information that would indicate subject and husband were members of the Communist Party.

Mrs. LOUISE MATTHAI, 1104 46th Street, S.E., could not give any information concerning subject's activities in the Communist Party, stating that as far as she knows subject and her husband appeared to be good citizens and spend most of their time at home.

Confidential Informants T-5, T-6, and T-7, of known reliability, could give no information regarding subject's Communist Party activities or affiliations.

A check of the files of the criminal records of Metropolitan Police Department and of the files of the House Committee on Un-American Activities was negative in nature.

Confidential Informant T-9, of known reliability, advised on or about October, 1947, that subject's name appeared on the membership list of UPW, Women's Auxiliary.

Confidential Informant T-10, of known reliability, advised that subject received a pamphlet on or about Larch 13, 1951, indicating that ARTHUR STEIN, Chairman of the District of Columbia Progressive Party, would make a speech on March 15, 1951, at a rally for the American Peace Crusade. The American Peace Crusade has been cited by the House Committee on Un-American Activities as being a Communist front organization.

On October 27, 1950, the New York Field Division advised by teletype that ABRAHAM SUROVELL testified before the Federal Grand Jury, Southern District of New York and that SUROVELL refused to answer questions regarding WILLIAM DANZIGER on Communist Party activities on the grounds that to do so might incriminate himself.

The investigative files of the Civil Service Commission were checked and found to be negative in nature regarding subject.



On the evening of June 16, 1951, at 8:45 p.m., Special Agents
JOHN B. VAN ETTEN and GILBERT G. BENJAMIN instituted a surveillance
in the vicinity of 4863 Potomac Avenue NW. the residence of BILL and
BETTY HAYS. Confidential Informants
advised that the Progressive Party was sponsoring a party at the
residence of BILL and BETTY HAYS, the purpose being to raise funds to
send delegates to the American Peace Congress in Chicago, commencing
June 29, 1951.

At 8:57 p.m., WILLIAM S. JOHNSON was observed departing from BILL and BETTY HAYS'S residence in a terraplane, D. C. tags 27370.

At 9:10 p.m., a 1947 Chevrolet bearing D. C. tags 8-6650, and a 1949 Chevrolet bearing D. C. tags 36175 were observed parked in front of the HAYS residence. At 9:18 p.m., a 1949 Plymouth sedan, gray with what appeared to be a transmitting antenna mounted on the rear, bearing D. C. tags A-2002, arrived at the HAYS residence with four women occupants, all of whom went into the HAYS home.

At 9:27 p.m., ANNE YALOM was observed arriving at the HATS residence in a cab and entering the HATS home. At 9:30 p.m., SHELION DRESSLER, driving a blue Kaiser sedan, D. C. tags 95621, arrived with JOE FORER as a passenger and an unidentified woman was riding in the back seat all along. MARCUS GOLDMAN also arrived at 9:30, driving a new Studebaker, bearing Virginia tags 291750.

At 9:32 p.m., a dark green Studebaker bearing D. C. tags D-4137 with approximately four passengers parked in front of the HAYS residence and the occupants then entered the HAYS home. At 9:34 p.m. a 1949 Chevrolet bearing D. C. tags E-2906, arrived, and the occupant of this car was observed to enter the HAYS residence.

At 9:37 p.m., ANNE and ARTHUR STEIN, EMMA ROBINSON, and an unidentified Negro (dark skinned) were observed departing 4907 Potomac Avenue NW, the residence of ROBERT J. SILBERSTEIN, and walking to the HAYS house. Earlier in the evening surveilling agents had observed what appeared to be a dinner party in progress at the SILBERSTEIN residence. Also at 9:37 p.m., several men were observed carrying chairs from the SILBERSTEIN residence which chairs were placed in a Nash rambler station wagon which was parked in front of the SILBERSTEIN residence along with ARTHUR STEIN'S Dodge, D. C. tags 9-4238. The Nash station wagon was later observed in the HAYS driveway. The station wagon bore Maryland tags 321-206.

At 9240 p.m., a man and a woman arrived in a two-toned tan Mash sedan with D. C. tags 81505 and were observed to enter the HAYS residence.

At 11:00 p.m., KIN SILBERSTEIN was observed leaving the HAYS residence and returning to her bwn residence on foot.

During the evening, surveilling agents overheard MEYER AUERBACH making statements to the effect that GERHARDT MISLER had been persecuted in the United States. Special Agent BENJAMIN understood AUERBACH to say that the U.S. Government did not want to deport BISLER, but rather wanted to put him in prison. AUERBACH was heard by both agents defending the position of the eleven top Communists and stating that they had not taught nor advocated the overthrow of the Government by force and violence. Both agents BENJAMIN and VAN ETTEN believe that the individual to whom AUERBACH was directing these statements was one MARGARET WALLACE.

AUERBACH was also heard to express a desire to attend the American Peace Congress to be held in Chicago, and an unidentified female was overheard instructing AUERBACH that he should get in touch with SELMA RRIN of the South East Club to make such arrangements.

From approximately 9:40 p.m. to 12:00 midnight, a large number of automobiles arrived at the HAYS residence. The occupants of some of these automobiles were observed by surveilling agents to enter the HAYS residence. Other automobiles were observed subsequent to the departure of their occupants, and it could not be definitely determined whether the occupants did in fact go to the HAYS residence.




On December 8, 1951, Special Agents JOHN B. VAN ETTEN. WINFRED H. ANDERS and the writer stationed themselves

The above agents arrived in the vicinity at approximately 9:30 a. m. and discontinued at 4:00 p. m. Both moving and still thotographs of the persons entering and leaving were taken by the agents. These photographs will be maintained in the Photographic Surveillance File 979 (100-21653).





Informant reported that local police appeared at the party about 11:55 P.M. There were two uniformed Privates, one Lieutenant, five or six Plain-Clothes! Men, and Inspector LUTZ who was in charge of the group. Three of the Plain-Clothes! Men, two colored and one white, had been at the partyall evening and claimed they had been sold whiskey. Mrs. EMMA ROBINSON was placed under arrest and was taken down to the Women's Bureau. MARIE RICHARDSON, ART STEIN and MORRIS MURRAY went with her voluntarily. ART STEIN immediately called JOE FORER to find out where to go to bail them out. ANNIE STEIN made a few calls to DAVE REIN to tell him of the happenings. No one was allowed to get their coats or even go to the rest room, and the police announced that they were going to take the names and addresses of all who were present, but ANNIE STEIN told the guests that they should not give out this information. She called DAVE REIN who said that it was O.K. to give the police the names and addresses. Then the guests, one by one, were permitted to get their coats, and as they left, the police obtained their names, addresses and places of employment. One uniformed policeman was taking the license numbers of all cars parked out front. ANNIE STEIN took one of the Plain-Clothes! Wen's badge number - 885 - and said that she was going to report him. There was no search warrant, but the police said that they were making the arrest on the charge that liquor was being sold without a license. EMMA ROBINSON was the one who was selling tickets for the drinks and for that reason she was the only one placed under arrest. & U




A review of the Baltimore files disclosed no additional information on the subject.

A review of the Paltimore files reflected the following information on JULIA KATZ:

The Daily "orker for November 14, 1942 identified JULIA KATZ as the newly elected National Director of the CIO, Women's Auxiliaries, and listed her among the women who had, under Communist auspices, signed and sent a telegram of encouragement to the women of Russia, England and China.

The August 7, 1943 issue of "Yardbird", official organ of Local 43, International Union of Marine and Shipbuilding Workers of Emerica, stated that JULIA FATZ as National Director of the Congress of Tomen's Auxiliar-ies, had served as a member of the Women's Policy Committee of the National War Manpower Commission, and had acted in an advisory capacity to the Women's Eureau of the U.S.Department of Labor, the CPA and the Children's Fureau. "Yardbird" stated that KATZ had been a matter of the Labor Committee of the U.S. Department of Health and Welfare.

On December 10, 1944, SA JAMES G. MAGHIR furnished a program issued by the Baltimore Council, American—Soviet FriendshipClub for its mass relly held at the Lyric Theater in Ealtimore on the above date. The program listed a Mrs. SIDNEY KATZ among those having submitted greetings to the Council.

Informant's report stated that the meeting began with the singing of the "Star-Spangled Banner", at the CASEY GUREWITZ at the piano. (u)

Informant stated that a few introductory remarks were made by the chairman of the evening, ARE BLOOM, concerning the victory in the Court decision regarding the custody of the ROSENBERG children. (u)

JOSEPH FORER made a very short speech in tribute to the memory of EMMANUEL BLOCH, according to the Informant. (4)

Then, Dr. FRANCE, an elderly man formerly of Rollins College in Florida, was introduced by the chairman; the Informant furnished the following information concerning Dr. FRANCE's speech: Dr. FRANCE outlined his own career as k wyer, professor of economics, liberal and fighter for civil rights. He spoke of the dangers to civil liberties presently loose in this country, making the point that no danger exists from the Communist Party but that unscrupulous politicians seeking power thems elves are the main source of infection. Addressing himself to "any of Mr. HOOVER's young men who may be present", he said that if this country is so shaky that a handful of Communists can overthrow it, then it ought to be overthrown; he added that he does not believe that this is the case and that it will not be the case so long as the rights of the people are preserved from those forces seeking to destroy them. He said that although he may disagree with Communists he believes that a defense of their civil rights must be made if these rights are to be preserved to all of our people, and that the time to get to work on such preservation is at the present moment when they are threatened. The Informant noted that Dr. FRANCE had nothing to say about proven treason and espionage. The audience reportedly gave him a big hard.

Informant stated that the next item on the agenda was the collection

appeal which was made by one JCE SAKS from Baltimore, not previously known to the Informant. It was a ter announced that \$302.00 was donated. Informant stated that "SAKS" was introduced as a former organizer for UPWA, and that he, himself, referred to all the good people of this city who went to bat for him when he needed it in his fight with reactionary forces. (It spears that this individual may be identical with JOSEPH WILLIAM SACHS.)

Informant stated further that after the collection, the Chorus sang songs; CASEY GUREWITZ played, and BILL SHONICK directed the singers, including LINDA SOLOMON and JACK HYAMS. It was stated that they sang a couple of Negro spirituals, a Warsaw ghetto lament, and a song from the Spanish Civil War.

Informant described as the highlight of the evening a drama entitled where Rock, whose scene was laid mainly on Alcatraz and which had as its hero HORTON SOBELL, played by JACK HYAMS. Informant described this as propaganda in its purest form. One scene reportedly showed an FBI Agent implying that if SOBELL would only say those things the FBI wanted said, he would save himself. Informant did not know the man who played the part of the Agent, nor the one who played the part of ELITCHER; BILL SHONICK acted the role of the prosecutor. The final scene showed SOBELL behind bars, reflecting aloud on the rightness of the course he had followed and implying that one man, namely, MORTON SOBELL, stood and still stands between the people of this country (4) and the terrors of fascism.

Informant stated that "This gripping drama which caused some emotional souls to weep" was followed by an appeal for pledges from all those present for \$30.00 each, to be either donated by themselves or collected from their friends, to be used to carry on the fight to free the unjustly imprisoned MORTON SOBELL. The appeal, according to the Informant, was made by the man who acted the part of KLITCHER.

The evening closed with refreshments, punch and cookies; the refreshments, according to the Informant, were in charge of MARY CHARSKY and RAE KAOAR.

With regard to the Dr. FRANCE mentioned as a speaker, above, the Informant stated that he was one of the lawyers who defended the "Baltimore Six" which he called his first case in the fight for civil rights.

HARTMAN advised that he is the principal administrative official of the firm and also prefers to handle matters pertinent to security and plant protection. He was formerly employed by the Navy Hydrographic Office for a number of years and has been with the captioned plant since about 1951.

WFO indices reflect no derogatory information identifiable with HARTMAN.

As reflected in re memo, captioned firm is an entgrowth of a partnership firm formerly operated by J. GILBERT SANGSTER and ABRAHAM J. SUROVELL, under the name of Sangster-Surovell Associates. SUROVELL, as previously

noted, is a Security Index subject of WPO (100-5587), who had been self-employed as a free-lance draftsman since about November, 1953.

Instant file also contains a Dun and Bradstreet report of 2/16/55, which identifies PRED J.
