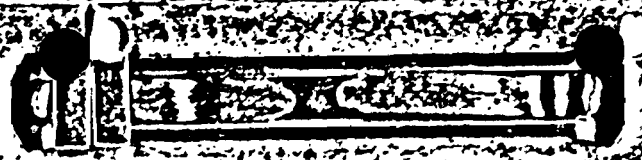

Re: Money Order Check

This memo is being submitted in accordance with your verbal request.

The Ithaca Post Office has checked all money orders from July, 1947 to date in an effort to locate all those received by subject during that time. All stubs prior to July, 1947 have been destroyed as per statute.

From July, 1947 through November, 1948, stubs have been located for every month with the exceptions of February, 1948 and August, 1947. The remitter in every instance with one exception has been WILLIAM PERL - HENRIETTA SAVAGE was the remitter for the July, 1947 order.

From December, 1948 to January, 1950, only one stub has been located. This was remitted by VIVIAN GLASSMAN in August, 1949. The Post Office has checked all orders emanating from New York City and Ohio during this period. Though the Post Master has been very cooperative in this regard, the task of checking every money order received during this period at the Ithaca Post Office would be quite an order. The following has been suggested by the Money Order Clerk. If he was in possession of a numerical list showing the number assigned to each post office in the country, he could check the daily sheets for this period. These sheets show the amount of the order, the date, and the number of the issuing office. He could check for all orders in the amounts of \$45, \$45.50, \$46, and \$47. Then knowing the identity of the number of the issuing office, he could go to the proper bundle and check for the individual stub to determine if subject was the payee.

No such numerical list is available in the Post Office. The Postal Guide lists first the office name and then the office number.

It is therefore suggested that as you observed, you contact the postmaster in Albany to see if he has such a numerical list. If none is available, it is strongly urged that the Bureau be requested to attempt to obtain such a list from the Office of the Postmaster General in Washington.

On August 17, 1950, the writer interviewed DR. HANNA H. PETERS at Sunset Point, Hancock's Camps, Seventh Lake at Inlet, New York. At that time, Dr. PETERS stated that she had seen CAROL DAYTON at Rochester, New York for one day during the week of July 23, 1950. At that time DR. PETERS stated she received a telephone call from CAROL DAYTON and asked her if she might come down and stay with her for one day to rest up. Subsequently, CAROL DAYTON did arrive there and stayed one day. She subsequently took a bus for either Boston or New York and Dr. PETERS was unable to advise as to which one it was. According to Dr. PETERS, CAROL DAYTON did not advise her of any infatuation or indicate any interest in the subject. As she recalled, she did not tell CAROL DAYTON that she was going for a vacation to Seventh Lake and as far as she knows, CAROL DAYTON did not know that she would be there and therefore, DAYTON would be unable to contact her there. She denied having received any information as to the present whereabouts of the subject or CAROL DAYTON.

The writer saw the two DAYTON children at the Camp and in this connection she stated that her husband, DR. BERNARD PETERS, had visited BRUCE DAYTON at Ithaca, New York and inasmuch as BRUCE DAYTON was extremely busy attempting to finish his thesis and doing the concluding work on the cyclotron, Dr. PETERS offered to take the DAYTON children off of BRUCE DAYTON'S hands so that he could concentrate on finishing his work there.

Dr. HANNA PETERS indicated that she was amazed at the conduct of CAROL DAYTON and could not explain it. She stated that they intended to remain there until Saturday, July 29, 1950 and then she would be returning to Rochester, New York. She promised that in the event that CAROL or the subject of this case contacted her, that she would immediately telephone the Albany Office.

Re Albany let to Director, 9-1-50 advising that stops are being requested for all Mexican Border INS and Customs Offices.

For your information a mere name stop with either of these offices is of little value. Both of these offices are presently carrying in their files hundreds and in some places thousands of name stops. INS especially has a name stop on each of the thousands of Mexican aliens who are deported annually.

When an individual enters the United States from Mexico about the only question he is asked by immigration officers is his birth place. If the entrant advises he was born in the United States, does not appear to be a foreigner, and does not speak with an accent he is ordinarily passed without further questioning. In the event his baggage is examined by customs authorities and he has nothing to declare, the baggage examination is very cursory and little note, if any, is made of individuals' names.

Therefore suggest your office submit sufficient photographs to border offices for posting in the various INS and Customs Stations where stops are to be maintained. Suggest forward Phoenix twelve copies of photograph.
