

Hall Village, Alexandria, Va., advised SA DARWIN M. GREGORY on 9/19/52 that he attended the summer session in 1950 at the Virginia Polytechnic Institute, Blacksburg, Va. ROW stated that he has stayed overnight at the home of Mrs. MARY ANN MATTUS when he went to V.P.I. but that she was not at home. ROW stated that LEONARD CAPLAN and his wife were staying at Mrs. MATTUS' home.

ROW stated that he had about six visits with Mrs. MATTUS and he drew the conclusion from those visits, that Mrs. MATTUS was teaching the Marxist doctrines to the CAPLANS. ROW stated that the CAPLANS were very willing students in that Mrs. MATTUS would lend them books on Marxism and they would read these books and return to Mrs. MATTUS to discuss the theories that they had read. According to ROW, the CAPLANS idolized Mr. and Mrs. MATTUS and Mrs. CAPLAN was always wanting to do things for the down-trodden.

Major ROW advised that LEONARD CAPLAN was studying at V.P.I. in 1950 in order to get a Masters Degree in Chemical Engineering and that he had received his Bachelor's Degree at Tufts College, Medford, Mass.

Newark Confidential Informant T-1, of known reliability, advised on 10/20/52 that the subject, LEONARD A. CAPLAN and his wife no longer reside at Apartment 83C, Parkway Apartments, Haddonfield, N. J. but have moved to Pennsauken, N. J., exact address unknown.

Subject's whereabouts are still unknown. It is believed that stops should be maintained with INS and Customs officials on the Mexico-United States border in the State of Arizona.
