The following investigation was conducted by the writer at Syracuse, New York.

Liverpool telephone 69-7817 was listed in March, 1952 to CLARENCE L. WOOD, Hiawatha and Elmcrest Streets. On October 8, 1952 this number was taken over by C. H. REIMMEN of Rhinecliff Avenue, Liverpool, who presently has the number.

Syracuse telephone no. 3-9950 is a public telephone at the Municipal Airport, Syracuse.

Syracuse No. 3-9238 is a public phone of which the Telephone Company has no record at the present time since the number has been discontinued.

Syracuse No. 75-6920 was listed to BENJAMIN L. ESKRIDGE, a salesman at 735 Ostrom Avenue in August, 1951. In May, 1952 this number was transferred to HELEN P. HAND, 735 Ostrom Avenue.

The above information was furnished by Mrs. PURCELL of the New York Telephone Company.

Miss BARBONI, Business Office, Syracuse University, advised that DORA K. POWERS is presently a secretary and clerk in the School of Art, Syracuse University. She was hired September 10, 1951, left June 20, 1952 and was rehired September 1, 1952 and resided at 504 McCool Avenue, Syracuse, N. Y. She was born 10/27/21 at Greenwich, Ohio. Her last employment was with the New York Central Railroad. Her husband is DERWARD R. POWERS, who is Assistant Station Manager for the New York Central Railroad. Mrs. POWERS attended the Central City Business Institute in Syracuse. Her maiden name is KEYSOE and she has two sons, WILLIAM J. COLLINS, born in 1943, and TIMOTHY R. COLLINS, born in 1942.

Neither Miss BARBONI nor Mrs. HUNT, supervisor of the Business Office, knew anything about any previous marriage on the part of Mrs. POWERS.

Referenced report set forth a lead for the Albany Office at Altamont, NY, to locate and interview IRWIN GLAUBERMAN concerning the extent of his relationship with the subjects and for any information in his possession pertaining to the subjects of this investigation.

[REDACTED] Clerk, Post Office, Altamont, NY, advised the writer on 2/27/53 that one IRWIN GLAUBERMAN, who had formerly resided on Route #2, Altamont, NY, had moved away and left a forwarding address of Route #3, Amsterdam, NY. **b7c**

On 2/27/53, the writer interviewed Mr. J. F. HARRINGTON, Assistant Postmaster, Amsterdam, NY, concerning the whereabouts of IRWIN GLAUBERMAN. Mr. HARRINGTON advised that information contained in his records under the date of 1/28/49 reflected that one IRWIN GLAUBERMAN had moved from Route #3, Amsterdam, NY, and had left the following forwarding address: c/o Cayuga G.L.F. Gas Plant, Auburn, NY.

It is suggested that this lead be referred to the Syracuse Resident Agency for appropriate action.
