Gentlemen:

For the past few years we have been attempting to develop a method for voice communication over a beam of light. As a result of this work, we have recently devised a new and practical method for accomplishing this purpose. We feel that this system would be a valuable war weapon.

Our preliminary theoretical analysis has shown that we will be able to transmit audio frequencies having a band-width of from 300 to 3000 cycles, with very little attenuation at the upper limit. In addition to securing good intelligibility, we have determined that the system will automatically reject noise, with a resultant excellent signal-noise ratio. The improved signal-noise ratio will permit transmission over a range far exceeding that of ordinary systems.



In order to complete the first working model of this device, we find that we require certain laboratory equipment, which we are at present unable to procure. We have been informed by officials of the Defense Plant Corporation that this equipment is available to private individuals working on government sponsored projects.
