





It is noted the records of the New York Welephone Company reflect Shirk is an engineer with Monroe Heating and Plumbing Corporation, 1066 Bedford Avenue, Brooklyn, New York, and is also a receiving investor for the United States Government at CO 7-0602. Report also indicates CS NY-2 records indicate telephone number GR 7-9194 as of 2-28-54 was listed to Daniel A. Shirk, 20 Fifth Avenue, and further that one Daniel A. Shirk was listed in the Manhattan telephone directory for 1955-1956 as an attorney at 170 Broadway. Rerep also reflects the name Dan Shirk 205 Fifth Avenue, GR 7-0331, was listed in the Bates List Finder in the home of Alfred Sarant on July 19 and 20, 1950, and that Sarant described Shirk as a prominent New York City attorney who is a personal friend of Louise Sarant's mother, Mrs. Minna Ross.



In accordance with instructions contained in New York letter of 3/5/56, the interview was conducted to determine the nature and extent of her association with subject and LOUISE SARANT. In view of the period of her association, it is felt New York and the Bureau may have further specific interrogation to suggest. Mrs. KNAUTH has indicated that she will be available if such is requested. In this connection, it might be noted that Mrs. KNAUGHT appears completely unaware of the involvement of the subject in Soviet intelligence, since she asked if investigation was being conducted because he was an applicant for a Government job.

Through him she met LOUISE and MONGONEZ. Later, MONGONEZ returned to Haiti and LOUISE started going with SARANT.


Mrs. KNAUTH said SARANT was living on Morton or Bank Streets, New York City, during the time she met him first. She recalled he had a fine collection of records; that he was a chemist, and she seemed to recall that he was working for a company which was manufacturing musical recordings. She said she couldn't recall having been in his apartment, but probably was.

After the SARANTS were married, which she thought was sometime in about 1945, they moved almost immediately to Ithaca and she has had no contact with either of them since, although there were a couple of letters exchanged perhaps during the first few months. She stated she had no knowledge of their activities whatsoever since the SARANTS left New York City.

Mrs. KNAUTH stated that to her knowledge ALFRED and LOUISE SARANT were not members of the Communist Party or Communist Political Association during that period in which she knew them. She described them as "very left wing." When asked to define this term, Mrs. KNAUTH changed the characterization to "left-wing," and said "Russia was doing so much to win the war that people thought differently of Russia then. She said she couldn't be more specific on the subject.

ALFRED SARANT has advised that OSCAR BRAND is a friend of his wife, who is a folk singer.

On May 18, 1950, LOUIS F. BUDENZ, former Managing Editor of the "Daily Worker" and a Communist Party (CP) functionary, until he broke with the Party in October, 1945, advised SA WILLIAM J. MC CARTHY, JR., that OSCAR BRAND, a "folk-rong" singer was known to him as a "concealed" Communist.

On June 30, 1950, BUDENZ advised SA WILLIAM J. MC CARTHY, JR., that OSCAR BRAND, singer of "folk" songs and other individuals entertained a closed session of the national convention of the CP in connection with "Mother" BLOOR's Anniversary sometime in 1944.

People's Songs, Incorporated 123 been designated a Communist front organization by the California Committee on Un-American Activities in 1ts 1948 report, page 392.

OSCAR BRAND, 300 West 12th Street, New York City, was interviewed on December 1, 1953, February 8, 10, and 11, 1954, by SA JOHN S. TODD. TODD was accompanied by SA EUGENE J. MORRISON on December 1, 1953, SA CARL E. ANDERSON on February 8, 1954, SA JAMES MC MAHON on February 10, 1954, and SA ROBERT S. MUGAVIN on February 11, 1954.

BRAND denied that he had ever been a member of the CP or any of its front organizations. BRAND stated he never subscribed to Communism or aligned himself with any Communist movement or group. BRAND stated he never attended any meetings of a closed nature where the principles of Communism were discussed or taught. BRAND readily admitted that he had appeared before many organizations and groups in the past which were supported by the CP for the purpose of furthering Communism in the United States. BRAND stated he never supported any group or organization, before which he appeared, through membership in same, contributions, or by any other means.

BRAND said his sole function at these affairs was that of a paid entertainer. BRAND emphasized that he was always paid for his appearances, and never contributed his services free of charge.

BRAND advised that the name SARANT was not familiar to him, and he did not recall ever having met anyone by this name. BRAND stated he did not know and was not acquainted with LOUISE SARANT.

PETER SEEGER





the apartment she occupied last Fall and Winter at 445 North Tioga Street, the residence of Mr. and Mrs. HAROLD FELDMAN. The entire residence, including the upstairs apartment, now in the FELDMANS absence, appears to be rented by students.

The partment of the property MARKS further advised that about two to three weeks ago, he observed LOUISE SARANT and BRUCE DAYTON moving some furniture and belongings from the apartment.

On October 16, 1956, T. E. S. MINTER. Who come cottage next door to the Victor K. D. Ross residence and cottage, at 1099 Taughannock Boulevard, advised that as far as he has been able to determine through observation, LOUISE SARANT and children are still residing in the Ross Cottage.

On October 16, 1956, T. ROSS LAMEN. Itendance of Filer, Ithaca Board of Education, advised that the SARANT children, JEREMY and STEPHEN, are attending Fall Creek School and that attendance and census records reflect their address as 1099 Taughannock Boulevard, eelephone 31665 (which is the Ross Cottage telephone).

On October 16, 1956, Confidential Informant Albany T-1, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that LOUISE SARANT is still residing with her children in the Cottage of her stepfather, VICTOR K. D. ROSS, at 1099 Taughannock Boulevard. It is the informant's understanding that she had intended to move into the ROSS residence which adjoins the Cottage for the winter months but this had been delayed because of a recent heart attack suffered by ROSS. T-1 continued that WELDON BRUCE DAYTON (ala BRUCE DAYTON), has been a steady visitor at the ROSS Cottage during the Summer and Fall and that he (T-1) believes that DAYTON and LOUISE SARANT will marry in the near future. Informant advised that LOUISE SARANT is unemployed. He added that BRUCE DAYTON intends to go to India to work if and when he is able to obtain a passport.

WELDON BRUCE DAYTON is the husband of CAROL DAYTON, who fled the United States with ALFRED SARANT in the Summer of 1950, and their whereabouts are unknown.



On October 18, 1956, and on October 25, 1956, Confidential Informant Albany T-2, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that he had determined that LOUISE SARANT is residing at 1099 Taughannock Boulevard, adding that he observed her at this address on October 25, 1956.

Bank Account Data

It was previously reported that LOUISE SARANT maintains a checking account at the Tompkins County Trust Company and that periodic deposits of \$32.20 are made to this account.

On October 16, 1956, Confidential Informant Albany T-3, who has furnished reliable information in the past, and who can produce such information in court only upon issuance of a proper subpoena, advised that he would attempt to determine the nature of these deposits. Informant further advised that he had learned that a deposit of \$400 was made to this account on July 2, 1956, and a deposit of \$500 on September 12, 1956. He stated that he would attempt to also determine the nature of these deposits. At this time, returned items charged to this account were examined but nothing of significance was noted.

On October 25, 1956, Confidential Informant Albany T-3 advised that the deposits of \$32.20 are made practically every month to this account. He stated that he had ascertained that these are all checks payable to LOUISE SARANT and made by WILLIAM M. WOODWARD, R. D. #1, Cayuga Heights, Ithaca, New York. Informant added that the deposits of \$400 and \$500 were cash deposits and could not be further identified. It will be here noted, as previously reported, that WOODWARD was the purchaser of the residence formerly owned by ALFRED and LOUISE SARANT in Cayuga Heights.

Contacts of LOUISE SARANT

Confidential Informant Albany T-4, who has furnished reliable information in the past, and who can produce such information in court only upon issuance of a proper subpoena, advised on October 18, 1956, that apparently BRUCE DAYTON was staying at the ROSS Cottage during August 17 and 18, 1956, since leveral calls were made by DAYTON on these dates from the Cottage elephone 31665. These calls were made to the following individuals:

Dr. ALBERT CREWGER, Department of Physics, Delphi Cottage, Garden City, New York; Professor JOHN MAJOR, Department of Physics, Western Reserve University, Cleveland, Ohio; Professor C. S. SMITH, Department of Physics, Case Institute of Technology, Cleveland, Ohio; E. U. CUNDER, Physics Department, University of Wisconsin, Madison, Wisconsin; Dean HARRY ROWE, Bates College, Lewiston, Maine; AUSTIN H. WELCH, College of Advanced Science, Canaan, New Hampshire; SHERWOOD F. PROWN, Physics Department, Colby College, Waterville, Maine.

Informant further advised that DAYTON charged a call to this telephone on August 15, 1956, from Lancaster, Pennsylvania, telephone 38152, and that he sent a telegram from this phone on August 23, 1956, to Hastings, Minnesota.






Efforts to Locate ALFRED SARANT



He worked for Bell Telephone Laboratory, New York, October, 1942, until September, 1946, when he moved to Ithica, New York, and became self-employed in 1950. Sarant was associated with the Julius Rosenberg network and occupied an apartment at 65 Norton Street, New York City, and after he left New York in 1946 it was rented in his name until 1950. Rent for the apartment was paid by different members of the Rosenberg network. In August, 1950, Sarant fled the United States after preliminary questioning by the Bureau and his present whereabouts is unknown. When he fled he took with him I'rs. Weldon Bruce Dayton, wife of his next-door neighbor.
