REBUTEL AUGUST EIGHT LAST, NEW YORK TEL TO NEWARK AUGUST SEVEN LAST, AND NEW YORK TEL TO NEWARK AUGUST NINE LAST ENTITLED VIVIAN GLASSMAN, ESP DASH R. SUBJECT AND HER MUSBAND, STEPHEN L. JAVNA, SEPARATELY INTERVIEWED AUGUST NINE LAST. SUBJECT ADVISED SHE WAS BORN MOUNT VERNON, NEW YORK, TWENTYSEVEN YEARS OLD, MARRIED STEPHEN L. APARTMENT IN DECEMBER NINETEEN FORTYSIX LIVED THERE ABOUT SIX MONTHS OR UNTIL SUMMER NINETEEN FORTYSEVN. SUBJECT STATED SHE ACCIDENTIALLY MET VIVIAN GLASSMAN SOMEWHERE ON LOWER EAST SIDE OF MANHATTAN SOMETIME IN SUMMER OF NINETEEN FORTYSEVEN AT WHICH TIME SHE TOLD GLASSMAN APPART-MENT AT ONE THREE ONE EAST SEVENTH STREET WAS AVAILABLE FOR RENT AND SUG-GESTED TO GLASSMAN THAT SHE CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT PREVIOUSLY MENT-IONED. SUBJECT STATED SHE FIRST MET GLASSMAN WHEN BOTH WERE SOCIAL WORKERS AT BROOKLYN STATE HOSPITAL IN NINETEEN FORTYTHREE AND NINETEEN SHE ADVISED SHE WAS NEVER VERY FRIENDLY WITH GLASSMAN, BUT FORTYFOUR. WAS ACQUAINTED WITH HER THROUGH TWO MUTUAL GIRL FRIENDS WHO WERE SOCIAL WORKERS AT THE HOSPITAL, NAMELY GERRY TUPPA AND EILEEN FIERNAN WHO WERE BELIEVED TO BE PRESENTLY RESIDING IN ROCHESTER, NEW YORK, ADDRESS UNKNOWN. SUBJECT DESCRIBED GLASSMAN AS AN EXTREME EXTROVERT AND TALKA-TIVE PERSON, BUT HONESTAND SINCERE AND BELIEVED HER TO BE A LOYAL AMER-ICAN. SUBJECT KNEW NOTHING OF ASSOCIATES OF GLASSMAN EXCEPT THOSE PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED, BUT DID ADMIT THE NAME JOEL WARR WAS FAMILIAR AS POSSIBLY BEING GLASSMANS BOYFRIEND. SUBJECT STATED SHE HAD NEVER

MET BARR AND WAS UNABLE TO RECOGNIZE PHOTO OF BARR. SUBJECT ALSO FAILED TO RECOGNIZE PICTURES OF ANY OF THE SUSPECTS IN THE ROSENBERG ESPIONAGE APPARATUS WITH EXCEPTION OF VIVIAN PLASSMAN, JULIUS ROSENBERG AND AND DAVID REENGLASS. THE LATTER TWO, SHE ADVISED, SHE RECOGNIZED FROM PICTURES IN THE NEWSPAPERS. SHE STATED TO HER KNOWLEDGE NONE OF THE PERSONS IN THE PHOTOGRAPHS HAD EVER BEEN TO ONE THREE ONE EAST SEVENTH END PAGE TWO

STREET. SUBJECT STATED THAT AFTER HER EMPLOYMENT AT THE BROOKLYN STATE HOSPITAL SHE WAS EMPLOYED BY THE AMERICAN RED CROSS, NYC, AS A SOCIAL WORKER UNTIL HER MARRIAGE IN DECEMBER NINETEEN FORTYFIVE. SUBJECT AD-VISED THAT SHE HAD VERY LITTLE CONTACT WITH GLASSMAN FROM NINETEEN FORTY TO THE PRESENT. ILL FELLINGS WERE CREATED BY GLASSMAN OVER PAYMENT OF UTILITY BILLS AND RENT ON INSTANT APARTMENT SUBSEQUENT TO GLASSMAN MOVING INTO THE APARTMENT. SUBJECT ADVISED THE NAME AND R ENGINEERING COMPANY WAS VERY FAMILIAR BECAUSE OF BUSINESS DEALINGS BETWEEN THEM AND HER HUSBANDS COMPANY, THE MAGNETIC DEVICES CORPORATION. SHE RECALLED THAT THE NAME JULIUS ROSENBERG WAS FAMILIAR TO HER BECAUSE OF HIS ASSOCIATION WITH THE G AND R ENGINEERING COMPANY. MARRIAGE RECORDS, BUREAU OF VITAL STATISTICS, TRENTON, NJ, REFLECT THAT JONAS JAVNA MARR-IED JUDITH MENDELSOHN DECEMBER TWENTYTWO NINETEEN FORTYSIX AT NEWARK, AT THAT TIME HE WAS RESIDING AT FIVE NINE FOUR FORT WASHINGTON AVE., WASHINGTON HEIGHTS, NY, THAT HE HAD BEEN BORN JUNE TWENTYFOUR NINETEEN ' TWENTYFOUR IN THE BRONK, NY, AND HIS OCCUPATION WAS LISTED AS A SINGER. MENDELSOHNS RESIDENCE WAS LISTED AS ONE FOUR FIVE SCHUYLER AVENUE, NEWARK, NJ, AND SHE WAS BORN JANUARY THREE NINETEEN TWENTYSEVEN IN NEWARK NJ. NEWARK INDICES NEGATIVE ON JUDITH MENDELSOHN. WHEN STEPHEN JAVNA WAS INTERVIEWED. HE GAVE SUBSTANTIALLY THE SAME INFORMATION REGARDING SEQUENCE OF OCCUPANTS OF APARTMENT AT ONE THREE ONE EAST SEVENTH STREET, STEPHEN JAVNA ADVISE THAT HIS BROTHER, JONAS, IS PRESENTLY IN END PAGE THREE

THE PROCESS OF MOVING FROM BALTIMORE TO SOME LOCATION IN NEW YORK AND THAT JONAS IS A CANTOR IN A JEWISH SYNAGOGUE AND CAN BE LOCATED THROUGH HIS MOTHER AT FIVE NINE ZERO FORT WASHINGTON AVE., WASHINGTON HEIGHTS, NY. STEPHEN JAVNA ADVISED THAT HE FIRST KNEW JULIUS ROSENBERG CASUALLY WHEN BOTH WERE IN SCHOOL AT CCNY IN NINETEEN THIRTYEIGHT AND THIRTYNINE. HE STATED THAT FROM NOVEMBER, NINETEEN FORTYONE TO SEPTEMBER NINETEEN FORTYFOUR, HE WAS EMPLOYED AS ASSISTANT PROJECT ENGINEER CURTISS WRIGHT CORPORATION, CALDWELL, NJ. AFTER WHICH TIME, HE STARTED HIS OWN COMPANY, THE MAGNETIC DEVICES COMPANY, WHICH WAS LATER INCORPORATED IN NINETEEN FORTYFIVE IN NEW YORK. THE COMPANY WAS FORMED TO DESIGN SOLONOIDS FOR PITCH CONTROL OF PROPELLERS ON AVIATION ENGINES. JAVNA STATED THAT HE DESIGNED SOLONOIDS AT CURTISS WRIGHT AND BECIDED TO MANUFACTURE THEM HIMSELF IN NINETEEN FORTYSIX. HE OBTAINED A SUBCONTRACT FROM CURTISS WRIGHT FOR THE MANUFACTURE OF THE SOLONOID, BUT HE NEEDED TO SUBCONTRACT SOME OF THE PARTS OF THE SOLONOID AND IT WAS AT THIS TIME IN ABOUT FALL OF NINETEEN FORTYSIX WHEN HE AGAIN MET JULIUS ROSENBERG. THE METHOD OF MEETING WAS RATHER HAZY IN HIS MIND. HE ADVISED THAT HE BELIEVED VIVIAN GLASSMAN BROUGHT JULIUS ROSENBERG TO THE APARTMENT AT ONE THREE ONE EAST SEVENTH STREET OR THAT HE ACCIDENTALLY MET ROSENBERG SOME PLACE IN MANHATTAN AND AT THAT TIME RECOGNIZED HIM AS A FORMER COLLEGE CLASSMATE. ROSENBERG TOLD HIM THAT HE HAD THE G AND R END PAGE FOUR

ENGINEERING COMPANY AND AFTER DECIDING THAT THE G AND R ENGINEERING COMPANY COULD HANDLE THE WORK WHIH JAVNA WANTED DONE, JAVNA GAVE THE G AND R ENGINEERING COMPANY A SUBCONTRACT TO MANUFACTURE THE CAPS AND THE CORES OF THE ELECTRIC SOLONOID. JAVNA STATED THAT IN THIS CONNECTION THE G AND R ENGINEERING COMPANY DID VERY POOR WORK AND HE HAD NOTHING BUT HEADACHES UNTIL THE JOB WAS EVENTUALLY COMPLETED IN APPROXIMATELY FEBRUARY NINETEEN FORTYEIGHT. JAVNA ALSO ADVISED THAT HE FIRST MET DAVID GREENGLASS THROUGH ROSENBERG AND REMEMBERS THAT TO IMPRESS JAVNA WITH THE ABILITY OF GREENGLASS AS A MACHINIST, ROSENBERG TOLD HIM THAT GREENGLASS HAD "WORKED WITH OPPENHEIMER DURING THE WAR". JAVNA STATED THAT HE ASUMED THIS WORK WAS CONDUCTED AT OAK RIDGE. JAVNA ALSO STATED THAT THE G AND R ENGINEERING COMPANY WAS NOT WELL OFF FINANCIALLY AND HE HAD TO CONTINUALLY PAY MONEY TO THE G AND R ENGINEERING COMPANY TO KEEP THEM GOING AND IN THIS CONNECTION, HE PRODUCED CHECK STUBS WHICH REFLECTED THAT THE CHECK FOR ONE THOUSAND DLLARS AND EIGHTFIVE CENTS, AS MENTIONED IN REFERENCED TELETYPE, WAS ONE OF THE CCHECKS INCLUDED AS BEING PAID TO G AND R ENGINEERING COMPANY. OTHER CHECKS AMOUNTING TO A TOTAL OF APPROXIMATELY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND EXTENDING FROM LATE NINETEEN FORTYSIX TO EARLY NINETEEN FORTYEIGHT WERE REFLECTED IN CHECK STUBS AND WILL BE SET OUT IN SUBSEQUENT REPORT. STEPHEN JAVNA ALSO FAILED TO RECOGNIZE ANY OF THE PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE SUSPECTS IN THIS CASE END PAGE FIVE CORR-PAGE 5 LINE 16 WDS 5&6 SHLD BE "ONE OF" WILL THEN READ WAS ONE OF THE ETC

WHICH WERE SHOWN TO HIM WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ROSENBERG, GREENGLASS AND VIVIAN GLASSMAN, WHOM HE STATED HE HAD SEEN BEFORE BECAUSE HE WAS AC-QUAINTED WITH THEM. HE ALSO FAILED TO RECOGNIZE THE NAMES OF ANY OF THE PERSONS AND SAID THAT NONE OF THEM TO HIS KNOWLEDGE HAD EVER BEEN TO ONE THREE ONE EAST SEVENTH STREET, NYC, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ROSEN-BERG AS MENTIONED ABOVE, AND WHO HE IS NOT SURE EVER CAME THERE. DURING THE TIME THAT JAVNA WAS CHECKING HIS RECORDS OF PAYMENT TO THE G AND R. ENGINEERING COMANY, HE CAME ACROSS A LETTER WRITTMEN BY HIM TO MISS VIVIAN GLASSMAN, ONE THREE ONE EAST SEVENTH STREET AND DATED MARCH THREE NINETEEN FORTYEIGT, IN WHICH HE STATED TO GLASSMAN THAT HE WAS ARRANG-ING TO DISCONTINUE UTILITY SERVICES IN HIS NAME WHICH WOULD BE EFFECTIVE APRIL ONE NINETEEN FORTYEIGHT AND THAT LETTER WAS TO ADVISE VIVIAN GLASSMAN THAT SHE WOULD HAVE TIME TO HAVE THE ACCOUNTS TRANSFERRED TO IN THIS COMNECTION, JAVNA ALSO STATED, THAT THERE HAD BEEN HER OWN NAME. ILL FEELINGS CREATED BY GLASSMAN OVER THE PAYMENT OF THE UTILITIES WHICH HAD BEEN LEFT IN JAVNA-S NAME. PHOTOGRAPHS OF CARLA SMALL JAVNA AND STEPHEN L. JAVNA WERE OBTAINED AND WILL BE FURNISHED TO NEW YORK.



It was noted at that time that Mr. and Mrs. TUSKY, superintendents, 131 East Seventh Street, NYC, positively identified photographs of JULIUS ROSENBERG as the person who occupied apartment 4A at the above address in 1946.

Subsequent investigation by the New York Office reflected that the TUSKYS had thought that CARIA JAVNA and her husband STEPHEN were, in fact, JULIUS ROSENBERG and his wife. They were shown photographs of ROSENBERG and his wife and they identified the ROSENBERGS as the occupants in this apartment in 1946. However, when photographs of CARIA and STEPHEN JAVNA were shown to them, they stated that these persons were the couple who had been previously identified as ROSENBERG and his wife.

When the JAVNAS were interviewed they readily admitted an association with VIVIAN GLASSMAN which dated from 1943 when GLASSMAN was a co-worker of GARLA JAVNA at the Brooklyn State Hospital, Brooklyn, New York. They also readily admitted that GLASSMAN rented their apartment, apartment 44, 131 East Seventh Street, some time in 1947.

STEPHEN JAVNA readily admitted having been acquainted with JULIUS ROSENBERG when they were both classmates at CCNY.

He also readily admitted having been in business with JULIUS ROSENBERG in connection with the latter's business, the G and R Engineering Company, and the Pitt Machine Froducts Company, both in NYC. JAVNA stated that this association in connection with these concerns was a result of a sub-contract which JAVNA let to ROSENBERG and his brother-in-law, DAVID Sub-contract which JAVNA let to ROSENBERG and his brother-in-law, DAVID CREENGLASS, to manufacture caps and cores for a solonoid which was to be used in the propellers of the B-36 type bomber.

In connection with this association with the G and R Engineering Company and the Pitt Machine Products Company, JAVNA furnished records and cancelled checks regarding this business association.

It is noted that it does not appear, as a result of investigation, that the JAVNAS are implicated in the JULIUS ROSENBERG espionage apparatus.

In view of the fact that all outstanding leads have been covered and also due to the fact that both the subject and her husband have been interviewed, this case is being closed unless advised to the contrary by the Bureau.



STEPHEN LOUIS JAVNA was telephonically contacted at the Magnetic Devices Company, Englewood, N.J., by SA DONALD G. HARRIS to arrange an appointment. JAVNA advised that he had a luncheon engagement and would be free for approximately one hour.

JAVNA appears to be extremely cooperative and during the interview repeated information concerning his association with JULIUS ROSENBERG, as has been previously reported. He claims that he has been/truthful and that he has nothing to be ashamed of concerning his association with ROSENBERG or the Communist Party.

JAVNA stated that he has always had a personal dislike for VIVIAN CLASSMAN and particularly resents what appears to have been an effort of GLASSMAN and ROSENBERG to "take him in".

JAVNA stated that ROSENBERG bluntly asked him the nature of his business at the Magnetic Devices Company. He further stated that he has always been glad that he had no secret work at his company because if he had then this relationship with ROSENBERG possibly would have gotten JAVNA "in bad with the F.B.I.".

This case is being placed in a Pending Inactive status until such time CARLA JAVNA is interviewed. If CARLA JAVNA does not furnish additional information which would warrant further investigation, this case, as captioned above, should be closed.

Determination as to whether STEPHEN LOUIS and CARLA JAVNA are to be included in the security index will be held in abeyance until such time as CARLA JAVNA is interviewed.

According to JAVNA, upon questioning this procedure, he was advised by a person he believes may have been JESSIE STONE that his membership in an organization which advocated the promotion of labor unions might cause him some difficulty in obtaining employment as an engineer. He then signed the application by using his given name STEPHEN LOUIS. He said that a Communist Party membership card was delivered to him by some unidentified courier, which, after some reflection, he destroyed realizing that he did not desire any affiliation with the Communist Party.

The Communist Party has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

JAVNA insists that he is not and never has been a Communist or a CP member with the exception of that which is related above. JAVNA advised that he never paid CP dues, attended meetings, nor subscribed to any CP publications.

Concerning his wife, CARLA JAVNA, he related that CARLA had come from a broken home. Through her attendance at the open CP meetings and her acquaintance with VIVIAN GLASSMAN, his wife probably joined the CP primarily because of her "loneliness". He advised that CARLA could probably reveal more concerning herself.

JAVNA volunteered that "a couple of months ago" he had appeared before a Federal Grand Jury in New York City. He stated that the Assistant United States Attorney advised him that he was considered a "friendly witness" and that he was subsequently questioned concerning his knowledge of WILLIAM PERL. JAVNA stated that he does not know PERL and that he knows of PERL only by what he reads in the New York Times.

JAVNA stated that he desires to cooperate with the F.B.I. in any way and that to the best of his knowledge he does not know any CP members either in New York or New Jersey. JAVNA further stated that he has never been approached by anyone to engage in Espionage and, other than stated above, has never been requested to join the CP.

JAVNA advised that his wife, CARLA, will cooperate with the F.B.I., however, she is vacationing at South Hampton, Long Island, and will be available for interview after 9/7/53.

Individuals named by JAVNA are identified as follows:

WILLIAM PERL, a former Columbia University Physics Instructor, was sentenced to five years imprisonment for perjury in U.S. District Court, June 5, 1953. PERL was charged with lying when he told a Federal Grand Jury in New York that he did not know JULIUS ROSENBERG and MORTON SOBELL, who had previously been convicted for violation of U.S. Espionage laws.

VIVIAN GLASSMAN advised Special Agents of the F.B.I. on 8/3/50 that she had delivered two thousand dollars to WILLIAM PERL in Cleveland, Ohio, on 7/22/50, having received the money from an unidentified male stranger who allegedly instructed GLASSMAN to advise PERL to accept the money and flee to Fexico.

GLASSMAN also advised that she was a friend and associate of JULIUS and ETHEL ROSTNEERG who were executed on 6/19/53 after conviction for violation of U. S. Espionage laws.

He advised that he did not come from a Communist background and in fact recalls as a child having heard his father, who was born in Eussia, curse the Bolsheviks.

JAVNA recalls that he met his wife, CARLA, through someone possibly VIVIAN GLASSMAN, by his attendance at the aforementioned open Communist Party meetings. He stated that during his attendance at these meetings in 1945, he signed an application for Communist Party membership, which reflected a Communist Party member should uphold the constitution of the United States, promote the interest of labor unions and also promote good relations with the



She states that even while at this social she could feel herself losing interest in the CP because of the hostility expressed toward a CP leader who apparently was trying to do his best. CARLA also recalled that one JESSIE STONE was at the social and that STONE and MARGOLIN were apparently members of the CP. | She advised that she cannot recall any of the names of other persons there. CARLA advised that she was acquainted with VIVIAN GLASSMAN although she does not know that GLASSMAN was a Communist. She is certain that GLASSMAN is not responsible for her or her husband, STEPHEN LOUIS JAVNA, joining the CP. CARLA insists that although she paid one month's dues she is not a Communist and has had no association with Communism since that time. She stated that she talked her husband into joining the CP and that he literally talked her out of the CP. She advised that her interest in welfare work drew her to the CP; however, she realized quickly that she did not desire to continue an association with the CP. CARLA advised that she has not been contacted by the CP of New Jersey; that she has never engaged in espionage, nor has she been approached to do so. In conversations with JAVNA, he had told that he, JAVNA, had known JULIUS ROSENBERG, the executed espionage agent. wanted to bring these facts to the attention of the FBI and offered to cooperate. While the agent talked to exhibited several cancelled checks to the agent, one or which was made to "ROBERT DUBIN" in the amount of \$600.00, which check had cleared through a Detroit bank. This was a personal check made by STEPHEN JAVNA, who maintains an account in bank.

Boston has advised Detroit that DUBIN from 1949 to at least 1950 attended CP meetings in Boston; was a member of the LYL in Boston; was Secretary-Treasurer of Massachusetts Branch of YPA; and in 1950 Executive Director of Mass. Branch, YPA. Between June 1949 and February 1950 he attended CP classes, and in November 1949 he was a member of the Tom Paine Club, a Marxist club located in Boston.

DUBIN was described as born 6/17/30 at Roxbury, Mass.; male, white, 5.5", 155 lbs., and attended Boston University.

Mrs. ADUBIN advised on her application record that she was accepted as a freshman for the fall term, 1951, at University of Michigan and also Indiana University but went to Brendeis University instead.

Mrs. PERSONIOUS advised their records further reflect that NINA SMALL DUBIN attended Fieldston School, New York 71, New York, from September, 1945, to June, 1951, and received a high school diploma. Her father was listed as MARVIN SMALL, 544 East 86th Street, New York, New York. Her father's occupation was listed as author and advertising man. Mrs. PERSONIOUS advised the mother's name was reflected as BLANCHE SMALL (legal guardian), 34 West 9th Street, New York, Mer mother was listed as a citizen and occupation was listed as student.

NINA SMALL DUBIN advised of the following concerning the short story of her life: "I was born in 1933 into a middle class household composed of five other people, a sister eleven years my senior, two brothers seven and five years older than I, and my parents. We lived in a neighborhood of private houses in a suburb of New York, community of 60,000. My life was a typical upper-middle class one and during the summer of 1944, at the age of 11, my parents planned a divorce.
