





On 10/23/59 EDWARD JAMES WEINSTEIN was interviewed by SAs DOUGLAS L. BURAU and WILLIAM E. FOLKNER.

WEINSTEIN stated he joined the Labor Youth League (LYL) in approximately 1950, "while in New York", and at one time held the position of Organizational Secretary of the New York County LYL. WEINSTEIN stated he could not recall the date this office was held.

WEINSTEIN advised he joined the CP in approximately 1953 and attended club meetings on the Lower East Side on practically a monthly basis. He could not recall any offices he held in the CP.

WEINSTEIN further advised the overthrow of the US government by force was not advocated by the CP organization; however, there were some individuals who did. He further stated the CP, USA never advocated dominance by the USSR, but in his opinion in practice, the CP, USA was controlled by the USSR.

WEINSTEIN stated he withdrew from the CP and LYL activity in approximately 1956. He stated he never took any formal steps in withdrawing, but he just became inactive. He gave as the reason for his withdrawal, "political disagreement". WEINSTEIN stated he considers the CP a defunct organization.

WEINSTEIN stated he had never subscribed to the "Daily Worker"; however, he had subscribed to "The Worker" as late as 1954.

According to [REDACTED] WEINSTEIN thereafter continued his studies in History (presumably toward a Ph.D degree). The records reflect his studies in History at Columbia stopped in January, 1959. His wife was listed as JACLYN WEINSTEIN. Additional information concerning EDWARD JAMES WEINSTEIN and JACLYN WEINSTEIN was forwarded to Milwaukee by letter dated 3/2/60. It is noted the title of WEINSTEIN's thesis for his AM degree was "Anti War Sentiment and the Socialist Vote in the Municipal Elections of 1917". As of 6/30/60, WEINSTEIN continued to reside at 771 West End Ave., NYC, and self-employed - conducts boat renting agency.

WEINSTEIN, also known as Mrs. JOSEPH WEINSTEIN, 211 Central Park West, NYC, was one of the children of SAMUEL KAUFMAN, who died a few years ago and left an estate [REDACTED] estimated to be valued from 40 to 50 million dollars. He stated the WEINSTEINS and KAUFMANS own considerable real estate in Midtown Manhattan and JOSEPH WEINSTEIN is actually the landlord of the Industrial Bank of Commerce where some of the WEINSTEIN accounts are located. [REDACTED] stated JOSEPH WEINSTEIN maintained a friendly and personal relationship with the bank personnel and that any inquiry at the bank regarding the WEINSTEINS should be handled with extreme caution in order not to embarrass all parties concerned and should be only handled through [REDACTED] voluntarily stated the KAUFMANS were a "fine family."

The New York indices contained the following information:

With regard to JAMES WEINSTEIN

EDWARD JAMES WEINSTEIN, more commonly known as JAMES WEINSTEIN, was the subject of investigation in the NYO in 1951 in a case captioned, "EDWARD JAMES WEINSTEIN, wa; ESPIONAGE-R, PERJURY, INTERNAL SECURITY ACT OF 1950", NY file 65-15773, Bufile 65-60359.

The basis of this investigation was information that WEINSTEIN loaned his 1949 Buick convertible to a roommate to drive JULIUS ROSENBERG to Ithaca, New York, where he picked up espionage material from one ALFRED SARANT.

In 1954, WEINSTEIN was again the subject of a "Fraud Against the Government" investigation for failure to list organizations on a Personnel Security Questionnaire. The United States Department of Justice declined prosecution in this matter.

advised on 11/10/54, that JAMES WEINSTEIN was a current member of the LYL and contributed substantial financial support to both the LYL and CP.

The LYL is cited by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

On 10/23/59, JAMES WEINSTEIN was interviewed by SA~~D~~ DOUGLAS L. BURAU and WILLIAM E. FOLKNER. He appeared to be cooperative to a limited extent. He agreed to discuss his activities but was adamant in his decision to refuse to discuss the activities of others.

WEINSTEIN was very vague in discussing his activities with regard to dates and places and club names, apparently fearful he would disclose the identities of his associates.

WEINSTEIN stated he joined the LYL in approximately 1950 "while in New York" and at one time held the position of Organizational Secretary of New York County LYL.

WEINSTEIN advised he joined the CP in approximately 1953 and attended club meetings on the Lower East Side on practically a monthly basis.

WEINSTEIN stated he withdrew from CP and LYL activity in approximately 1956. He stated he never took any formal steps in withdrawing, but just became inactive. He admitted subscribing to "The Worker" as late as 1954.

"The Worker" is an East Coast Communist weekly newspaper.

With regard to BOBBIE K. WEINSTEIN

Mrs. JOSEPH WEINSTEIN, also known as BOBBIE K. WEINSTEIN, was indicted 3/31/47, for contempt of Congress to wit: failing to produce the records of the Joint Anti-Fascist Refugee Committee before the House Committee on Un-American Activities in April, 1946. She was convicted in the United States District Court, Washington, D.C., 6/27/47, and on 4/24/48, received a \$500 fine and a 3 months suspended sentence.

The Joint Anti-Fascist Refugee Committee is cited by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

With regard to JACLYN WEINSTEIN

With regard to JOSEPH WEINSTEIN

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] advised that JOSEPH WEINSTEIN, 211 Central Park West, NYC, was a member of the Board of Trustees of the Jefferson School of Social Science in March, 1944. b7d

The Jefferson School of Social Science has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

For the information of the Milwaukee Office, the only information appearing in the New York indices regarding CARL DORIAN WEINER is a letter to Milwaukee dated 6/17/59, forwarding background information and a photograph after Milwaukee had requested a check of the Columbia University records.

A copy of this letter is designated for the Fund For Social Analysis (FFSA) file so that the FFSA investigation will be alert to and report any financial assistance to the SOTL by the FFSA.

In the event the office of origin considers further inquiries regarding JAMES WEINSTEIN's activities or finances, it is suggested they be directed to the JAMES WEINSTEIN file, NY 65-15773, inasmuch as he is currently on the Security Index and the full scope of his activities can be more accurately determined in that file.

New York is in the process of contacting various sources of information familiar with CP activities for any information regarding "Studies On The Left" and any financial assistance from the CP or CP members in this area. The results of these contacts will be submitted when completed.

Milwaukee set forth leads containing bank checks in the referenced report and requested New York to submit results in report form.

UACB, the above information is set forth in a letter because the investigation regarding the bank checks was not positive and also the above letter contains considerable administrative and background information for the benefit of the Milwaukee Office in any future investigations of JAMES WEINSTEIN.

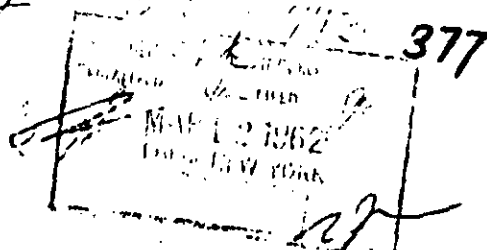

STUDIES ON THE LEFT (SOTL)

The "Wisconsin State Journal," a daily newspaper published at Madison, Wisconsin, on November 26, 1959 announced that a new scholarly magazine, "Studies on the Left," a historical review dedicated to the leftist point of view, edited by present and former graduate students at the University of Wisconsin (UW), but having no connection with the UW itself, would begin publication soon.

Records of the Wisconsin Secretary of State reflect SOTL was incorporated under laws of Wisconsin July 16, 1959 as a non-stock, non-profit corporation with headquarters P.O. Box 2121, Madison, Wisconsin. The first issue contained a policy statement from the editors stating SOTL was primarily a magazine for national circulation designed to give younger men with radical views a place to voice their opinions. About two issues a year are published, the most recent in May, 1962.

Publicly listed members of SOTL's Editorial Board SAUL LANDAU, JOAN BROMBERG, STEPHEN SCHEINBERG, MARTIN J. SKLAR and JAMES WEINSTEIN have been identified by sources previously as having participated in the activities of the Labor Youth League (LYL); while Editorial Board members DAVID EAKINS and MATTHEW CHAPPERON have been identified as active members of the Communist Party (CP). Another source has identified SKLAR and WEINSTEIN as handling the finance and business affairs of SOTL.

The Labor Youth League has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

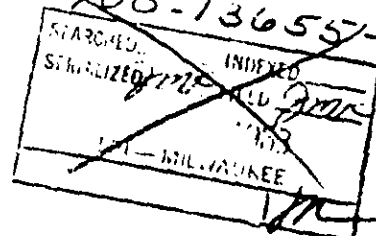

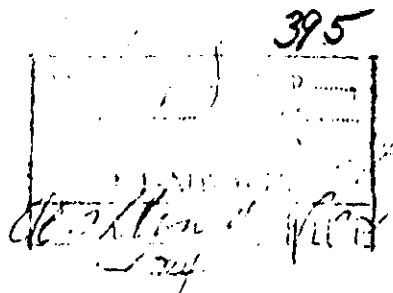

The following specific factors in addition to the ones set forth in Section 87D of the Manual of Instructions are set forth for consideration in arriving at a determination as to whether a security subject falls within the Security Index criteria, represents a potential danger in time of an emergency and thus should be included in the Security Index.

1. Contacts with Sino-Soviet-bloc establishments (including Cuba) where purpose of contact cannot be determined or contact indicates Communist sympathies.
2. Contacts with Sino-Soviet-bloc, Cuban or Yugoslav intelligence agents where purpose of contact cannot be determined or contact indicates Communist sympathies.

6. A history of emotional instability or irrational behavior on the part of an individual with a subversive background whose prior acts depict a propensity for violence and hatred against organized government.

The above factors, including the various factors presently set forth in Section 87D of the Manual of Instructions, are not all inclusive but are set forth for the purpose of providing a more detailed guideline and all must be considered in evaluating the facts developed during the course of the investigation.

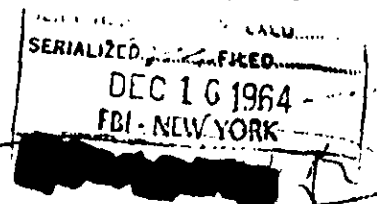

Draft Statement for the Committee for Independent

Political Action

Most Americans have been cut off and excluded from the process of making the basic decisions that affect their lives. Partisan politics in the United States operates to sustain and extend the immediate and long-range interests of a relative handful of giant corporations and their institutional supporters. But the material and strategic interests and commitments of these corporations and their leaders, and the social values that flow from these interests, differ essentially from those of the poor, the workers, and most middle class Americans. In the determination of both domestic and foreign policy concern with the protection and extension of private property and profits takes priority over the personal and social needs of ordinary people. Domination of American politics by giant corporations has brought the United States to international crisis and to the organization of our lives around the ideological, political and material necessities of the Cold War. The vast majority of the American people have no real interest in the continuation of the domestic and foreign policies and programs that have been imposed upon them by a political machinery they do not control.

American foreign policy is based on the assumption that changes in social systems that challenge the existing power relationships between classes (and between the socialist and capitalist blocs) are impermissible. This policy of denying to other peoples the right to choose their own economic and political paths has created an ever-present danger of war and has forced all of us to accept as "normal" a state of mobilization or semi-mobilization for war. This has meant not only an economy that relies on armament production, but also has limited the framework of "legitimate" political debate. The atmosphere of the Cold War and its periodic Vietnams, acts as a control mechanism over the entire range of domestic policies affecting social welfare, Negro rights, education and civil liberties. Even for liberals and reformers, the Cold War has defined the ideological space within which traditional American politics can operate. The presence of American troops in Vietnam, and the equally blatant intervention of the United States in the internal affairs of the Dominican Republic are the immediate manifestations of American commitment to oppose popular revolution anywhere in the world. Yet no major party politician or relevant political organization has opposed these policies or the assumptions underlying them.

Even in domestic affairs no liberal or reform politician has come forward with a consistent set of criticisms or an alternative program. Contrary to their professed intentions, existing poverty, housing and school programs have served to perpetuate the conditions of the poor and to lull people into inactivity by giving them a false sense of hope, while actually strengthening

the political machines and serving powerful local real estate interests and other entrenched financial, bureaucratic and social groups. Urban renewal has worsened the living conditions of those it supposedly helps, yet it has vastly increased the value of local property. It has dehumanized low income workers and families by forcing them out of their homes with little or no consideration for their individual or group needs. The process of dehumanization continues in the schools where basic educational needs are often ignored and the quality of education has lagged further and further behind what is needed and possible. Despite some integration in previously all-white schools, the overall pattern of segregation is increasing. Poverty programs are the most blatant form of manipulation. They do little more than serve as new sources of political patronage or social control over insurgency in the ghetto. These problems are linked to the Cold War not only because massive arms spending limits the public funds available for social programs, but also because the Cold War framework stifles serious opposition in what is called the "national interest". This atmosphere makes it impossible for liberal politicians, whose political lives depend ultimately on the sufferance of the Johnson Administration, to enter coalitions with radicals who publicly reject the assumptions of Cold War mythology, or to propose alternative programs of a "socialist" character.

In recent years some radicals have worked within the reform movement of the Democratic party, while others have rejected major party politics and attempted to build monolithic socialist parties. Those within the reform movement have operated on the theory that once people are involved in action they will be brought to a generalized understanding of the nature of the Cold War and its concomitant policies. In order to function within the reform movement they have submerged their private beliefs in the interests of united action. Accepting activity entirely within the framework of ideas and assumptions of Cold War liberalism; they have often served simply as activists for their ideological opponents. In no reform club has a constituency been built which consciously rejects the assumptions and values of the Cold War. On the other hand, radicals in the various socialist parties have been unable to break out of their narrow disputes, or to find a way to make their activity relevant to large numbers of people. They have provided a means of registering protest, but they have been unable to relate program to educating and organizing a constituency.

We believe that if radicals are to be more than gadflies, if they are serious about challenging the political status quo and the policies and programs of the Administration, their main strategic concern must be to work toward the development of an independent, self-conscious popular movement in the community -- no matter how long or difficult this process may be. And they must develop specific, workable alternatives to the institutions and agencies that are responsible for domestic and foreign policy. We must begin building a mass movement based

on a radical perception of American society -- one that develops a vision of a future society whose priorities are determined by popular need, rather than by corporate interest. This makes popular education a primary task, along with the need to create alternative programs based on a new set of power relationships. We feel that this can be done only by combining consistent action on immediate issues with a radical critique of American society and an opportunity to consider alternative views of the way in which it might be organized. We do not reject the concept of coalition politics, but we feel this is secondary to the building of a radical constituency.

As a first step in attempting to do this, we have formed an independent radical political association on the West Side of Manhattan, within the Nineteenth Congressional District. We see this as part of a process of building a national radical political movement, but we do not believe a national organization will be meaningful until (or unless) a number of local movements have been successfully established.

The immediate objectives of our association are (1) to lay the basis for an electoral campaign within the Nineteenth Congressional District in 1966. We are prepared to run candidates in the Democratic primaries, or as independents. We consider the question of electoral forum to be tactical and secondary to the process of building a stable constituency. (2) To conduct community organizing work on the questions of American neo-colonialism (peace), housing, schools and other community issues, on a year-round basis. (3) To participate in and organize direct action -- demonstrations, rent strikes, others. (4) To engage in educational work in the community around forums, popular discussion and the development of our own literature. (5) To bring together professional people in discussion and research projects to develop alternative programs.

We see activity in opposition to the war in Vietnam as one of our major activities in the next several months.

The association will be open to all individuals who agree with its aims and the broad outline of its strategy. No exclusion will be made on the basis of prior political affiliation.

FREE SCHOOL OF NEW YORK

The New York Times, a daily newspaper published in New York City, contained an article in its July 11, 1965, issue entitled, "Radicals Set Up Own University". The article indicated that this school, called the Free University of New York (FUNY) opened on the previous Tuesday in an old loft building at 20 East 14th Street, New York City, and reportedly had 210 students registered. The article also indicated that the funds for establishing the FUNY and funds for its operation were supplied in part by non-salaried faculty members most of whom contributed \$30 each and also by the students who pay \$24 for each eight week course.

The May 28, 1965, issue of Newsday, a daily Long Island, New York, newspaper, contained an article entitled, "Krebs To Open His Own School". This article related that ALLEN KREBS, a former Adelphi University professor, who claimed he was fired from Adelphi University for his avowed Marxist views, was planning to open a university of his own in a rented Manhattan, New York, loft.

The New York Times, in its issue dated December 12, 1965, contained an article entitled, "Students Of Left Set Up Colleges". This article indicated that a number of "Counter Universities" or "Anti-Universities" have been established in various cities throughout the United States like the FUNY. The article mentioned that these institutions vary in many ways. Some are operated under the auspices of a specific organization belonging to the so-called New Left however, others like the FUNY say they are independent of any organization and try to offer courses of a broader cultural orientation.

A source advised on March 14, 1966, that ALLEN KREBS, an expelled former secret member of the Progressive Labor Party (PLP), is the Director of the FUNY.

The same source advised on February 23, 1966, that

the FUNY was originally meant to be a loose arm of the PLP (even though all individuals from pacifists to Trotskyites were allowed to teach) but the PLP members in control of the FUNY have removed it as such. The source indicated that during January, 1966, KREBS removed permission for a PLP high school group to meet at the FUNY, causing rumblings that he was breaching party discipline.

The Fall, 1966, Catalog from the FUNY reveals on the cover that the name of the school has been changed to the Free School of New York with an explanation that 'New York State law forbids the use of the term 'University' without proof of \$500,000.00 in assets .

The above catalog contains a list of 30 courses ranging from discussions of various radical movements, classes on Marxism, labor movements, racial prejudices, the draft, to classes on Vietnam and MAO TSE TUNG.

Records of the Secretary of State Corporation Department, State of Delaware, as made available on March 30, 1961, reflect that a Certificate of Incorporation was filed on August 24, 1944, for the Louis M. Rabinowitz Foundation, and the nature of business was - to undertake, promote, develop and carry on religious, charitable, scientific, literary and/or educational work. VICTOR RABINOWITZ was recorded as President of this foundation.

A source advised on May 18, 1965, that VICTOR RABINOWITZ is President of the foundation, and the address of the foundation is 30 East 42nd Street, New York 17, New York.

In early, 1962, a second source advised that GUS HALL, General Secretary of the Communist Party, United States of America (CP, USA) and others in the CP, USA leadership, complained about VICTOR RABINOWITZ because of information indicating that he had been donating money to and was listening to the "left faction" which included a number of people who were expelled from the CP, USA.

On April 2, 1965, a third source advised that the foundation forwarded \$6,000.00 to HERBERT APTHEKER to further the work of APTHEKER in preparing a bibliography of the public writings of Doctor W. E. B. DU BOIS.

A fourth source advised that HERBERT APTHEKER was elected to the National Committee of the CP, USA, at the 17th National Convention of the CP, USA held in December, 1959.

It is publicly known that W. E. B. DU BOIS died on August 28, 1963. At that time he had been residing in Ghana, having become a citizen of that country. He was the guest of President KWAME NKRUMAH, and he had become Director of the Encyclopedia Africana, which was sponsored by the Government of Ghana. In the fall of 1961, at the age of 93, he joined the CP.

- "1. 'established by the American Labor Party in 1947 as a "progressive" weekly * * *. Although it denies having any affiliation with the Communist Party, it has manifested itself from the beginning as a virtual official propaganda arm of Soviet Russia.' (Committee on Un-American Activities, Report, Trial by Treason: The National Committee to Secure Justice for the ROSENBERGs and MORTON SOBELL, August 25, 1956, p. 12.)"

The "Wisconsin State Journal," a daily newspaper published at Madison, Wisconsin, on November 26, 1959, announced that a new scholarly magazine, "Studies on the Left," (SOTL) a historical review dedicated to the leftist point of view, edited by present and former graduate students at the University of Wisconsin (UW), but having no connection with the UW itself, would begin publication soon.

Records of the Wisconsin Secretary of State reflect SOTL was incorporated under law of Wisconsin July 16, 1959, as a non-stock, non-profit corporation with headquarters P.O. Box 2121, Madison, Wisconsin. The first issue contained a policy statement from the editors stating SOTL was primarily a magazine for national circulation designed to give younger men with radical views a place to voice their opinions.

Volume #3, Number 2 issue of SOTL, published in February, 1963, contained an announcement that effective March 1, 1963, the new mailing address of SOTL would be "Studies on the Left," Box 33, Planetarium Station, New York 24, New York.

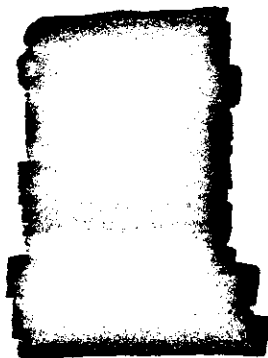

FREE SCHOOL OF NEW YORK

The New York Times, a daily newspaper published in New York City, contained an article in its July 11, 1965, issue entitled, "Radicals Set Up Own University". The article indicated that this school, called the Free University of New York (FUNY) opened on the previous Tuesday in an old loft building at 20 East 14th Street, New York City, and reportedly had 210 students registered. The article also indicated that the funds for establishing the FUNY and funds for its operation were supplied in part by non-salaried faculty members most of whom contributed \$30 each and also by the students who pay \$24 for each eight week course.

The May 28, 1965, issue of Newsday, a daily Long Island, New York, newspaper, contained an article entitled, Krebs To Open his Own School. This article related that ALLEN KREBS, a former Adelphi University professor, who claimed he was fired from Adelphi University for his avowed Marxist views, was planning to open a university of his own in a rented Manhattan, New York, loft.

The New York Times, in its issue dated December 12, 1965, contained an article entitled, "Students Of Left Set Up Colleges". This article indicated that a number of Counter Universities or Anti-Universities have been established in various cities throughout the United States like the FUNY. The article mentioned that these institutions vary in many ways. Some are operated under the auspices of a specific organization belonging to the so-called New Left however, others like the FUNY say they are independent of any organization and try to offer courses of a broader cultural orientation.

A source advised on March 14, 1966, that ALLEN KREBS, an expelled former secret member of the Progressive Labor Party (PLP), is the Director of the FUNY.

the FUNY was originally meant to be a loose arm of the PLP (even though all individuals from pacifists to Trotskyites were allowed to teach), but the PLP members in control of the FUNY have removed it as such. The source indicated that during January, 1966, KREBS removed permission for a PLP high school group to meet at the FUNY, causing rumblings that he was breaching party discipline.

The Fall, 1966, Catalog from the FUNY reveals on the cover that the name of the school has been changed to the Free School of New York with an explanation that "New York State law forbids the use of the term 'University' without proof of \$500,000.00 in assets .

The above catalog contains a list of 30 courses ranging from discussions of various radical movements, classes on Marxism, labor movements, racial prejudices, the draft, to classes on Vietnam and MAO TSE TUNG.

On April 2, 1965, a third source advised that the foundation forwarded \$6,000.00 to HERBERT APTHEKER to further the work of APTHEKER in preparing a bibliography of the public writings of Doctor W. E. B. DU BOIS.

A fourth source advised that HERBERT APTHEKER was elected to the National Committee of the CP, USA, at the 17th National Convention of the CP, USA held in December, 1959.

It is publicly known that W. E. B. DU BOIS died on August 28, 1963. At that time he had been residing in Ghana, having become a citizen of that country. He was the guest of President KWAME NKRUMAH, and he had become Director of the Encyclopedia Africana, which was sponsored by the Government of Ghana. In the fall of 1961, at the age of 93, he joined the CP.
