





This is related to the MORTON SOBELL family, and is a Marxist". This unknown women was also described as having considerable interest in the Peace Movement.

It is noted that physical observation of the Apartment at 41 - 44 48th St., reveal that this is a three-story apartment building. JEANETTE TURNER resides on the third floor, and directly under her is the residence of MORRIS and FLORENCE PASTERNAK. It is further noted that the PASTERNAKS formerly resided at 46 - 19 Skillman Ave., and recently moved to the 48th St. address.

On 4/3/62, CARLOS MELARDEZ, ~~INTERVIEWER~~, who is a superintendent of the building at 41 - 44 48th St., advised that JEANETTE TURNER resides in the third floor apartment at 41 - 44 48th St., and MORRIS and FLORENCE PASTERNAK reside on the second floor directly beneath TURNER'S residence. In addition, he ~~said~~ that the PASTERNAKS had recently moved to this address and were "only new tenants in this apartment building.

It is further noted that appropriate review of the PASTERNAK file reveal that they are related to the SOBELL family.

It is recommended that the file # 100-148159, be consolidated into the file of FLORENCE PASTERNAK, which is 100-55306.





We are now engaged in a legislative campaign to alleviate the great hardships suffered by foreign born who are under attack by the Walter-McCarren Act.

On May 9th of this year, Sen. Wayne Morse, Oregon, introduced two bills, the second one, S. 1501, with the co-sponsorship of Sen. Philip A. Hart, of Michigan, which if enacted would prevent the deportation of long-time residents of this country for any reason, after these foreign born have entered this country for permanent residence and have lived here for ten consecutive years.

We must now conduct an intensive publicity and educational campaign to acquaint Americans of these two "statute of limitations" bills, S. 1500 and 1501. 




