On [redacted] Confidential Informant [redacted] obtained confidentially [redacted] a copy of a mimeographed letter addressed to the membership of the ASSOCIATION OF CAMBRIDGE SCIENTISTS as of April 1, 1950. It should not be disclosed in a report, [redacted]

[redacted] membership list of the Association of Cambridge Scientists. The letter solicited the recipient to join the AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF SCIENTIFIC WORKERS in view of the inactivity of the ACS. The membership list of the ACS for April 1, 1950, as provided by [redacted] reflected that the following named individual, at the address indicated, was a member of the ASSOCIATION OF CALBRIDGE SCIENTISTS - FAS, as of April 1, 1950; and due information is being set out for the completion of the Bureau files in this case.

Enclosed herewith is a copy of a committee loyalty form
concerning the mentioned individual.

On October 1957 another government agency engaged in
conducting personnel and security investigations advised the FBI
that George Gordon Mitchell, an associate of Harvard University,
was on the list of the House Committee on Un-American
Activities. Mitchell was reportedly not only a member of
loyalty checks in an article appearing in the New York Times
of March 29, 1950. This Bureau was further advised by the govern-
ment agency that in 1939 the Daily Worker reported that Mitch-
ell was one of 250 hundred professors and one thousand students
at Harvard University who signed petitions calling on President
Roosevelt to lift the embargo on loyalist Spain. The Daily
Worker is an east coast Communist Party newspaper. (66-14100-9)

It is noted that the applicant was investigated by
this Bureau in August, 1947, in an applicant-type investigation.
During the course of the investigation, persons interviewed stated
that the applicant is a white Russian, and hisough with no white
