This case is being reopened under the program of investigating all individuals included in the Communist Index in the NYO.

The following minimum investigative steps must be taken:

1. Review file and all pertinent references thoroughly.

2. Contact informants, sources and defected Communists who could be expected to know the subject. Contact for evidence of current activity and also for the sources' evaluation of potential dangerousness.

3. Determine residence and employment. Check against the key facilities and classified contractors lists to insure full and complete dissemination is made. Submit Form FD-128 if the subject has moved to a new field division.

4. If the subject has been a CP "drop" or ceased activity suddenly, develop information to show the reason. Many of these "drops" are purely on the basis of theoretical and intellectual differences. The convictions of the persons involved remain unchanged in their hard-core devotion to the principles of international Communism, waiting only for what they consider to be a more favorable climate within ruling Communist circles. It should also be borne in mind constantly that unexplained cessation of Communist activity by a subject may well be based upon a contemplated assignment in espionage or illegal underground activity.

Additional instructions relative to the handling of these cases will be immediately forthcoming. In the meantime the necessary investigative steps should be taken so that there will be no time lost in launching this program.

They walked to the Cozy Lafayette Restaurant, East Eighth Street and University Place. At 4:05 p.m. they departed this restaurant and then walked north on University Place to East Fourth Street, where they separated. RUTH DAVIS then proceeded west on Eighth Street and re-entered 50 Fifth Avenue.

Subject proceeded north on University Place to the IND Subway Station at 14th Street near Fourth Avenue. He paused near the change booth and looked about. He passed through the turnstiles, stopped, turned and waited for people to pass. At this time, one of the surveilling agents passed through the turnstile, passed subject, turned left, and did not further observe the subject. Subject then walked slowly through a long concourse, during which he was not surveilled. He was again observed descending a stairway to the 53rd Street - Astoria northbound platform. He stepped into a northbound express train and immediately backed off. At this time the remaining surveilling agent was not on the platform but was descending the stairway. Several minutes later subject crossed the platform and entered a northbound local train and then backed off. The surveilling agent had entered the next car of this train and did not leave the train since this would have resulted in subject and agent being alone on the platform and would have jeopardized the security of the surveillance. This occurred at 4:16 p.m. and subject was not further observed.

As the Bureau is aware, this surveillance has been conducted in a highly discreet manner and on a spot

basic. Since the surveillance was instituted on 1/6/59, there has not been any indication that subject or RUTH DAVIS are aware of the surveillance coverage. They have never been observed to be surveillance conscious nor evasive. Subject has never utilized a suitor while under surveillance except for the incident as set forth above.

It was the opinion of the agents who observed subject on 4/18/59, that he was not aware of any surveillance. It was apparent that he was cleaning himself, possibly before taking a boat. Under the circumstances set forth above, it was impossible for the agents to maintain the surveillance and remain unobserved by the subject. The incident indicated subject's continuing involvement in Soviet espionage.

This incident occurred on the third Saturday of the month and the NYO will remain alert to the significance of this fact and will take appropriate measures to cover subject on Saturdays. No unusual activity was observed on Saturday, April 25, 1959.







This Reserve Index case is being reopened to conduct the following investigation:

Forms will be available to recommend the inclusion of the individual's name in Section A of the Reserve Index. These forms will contain a succinct summary, setting forth the basis for recommendation. If no report accompanies the recommendation, a statement to that effect should appear on the page containing the succinct summary. Investigations of individuals listed in Section A are to be brought up to date annually and they are to be considered for Security Index status or retention in the Reserve Index. Changes in residence and employment will be submitted to the Bureau.

3. The individual, within the past five years, by his associations, writings, financial support or conduct in relation to and support of subversive organizations or the international communist movement is in a position to influence others at the time of a national emergency and no reliable evidence of defection.

4. Leadership or substantial activities in a major subversive front group over three years ago, together with some evidence of continuing activity, association or sympathy for the subversive cause within three years and no reliable evidence of defection.

5. Membership in a subversive front organization within the past three years and no reliable evidence of defection.



It is believed that in the event of a national emergency, GLORIA AGRIN JOSEPHSON would probably influence others against the national interest and render financial and material aid to subversive elements.




