





"She was about middle height, light brown hair, parted in the middle and hanging about shoulder-length. Salloo complexion. Age about 35, wears glasses.

"She stated that the meeting was to remember the ROSENBERGS execution and to reiterate again the innocence of MORTON SOBELL. She introduced a man by name of DANIEL MARSHALL.

"MR. MARSHALL said this was the 14th year of a 30 year sentence for MR. SOBELL. He said that he was not going into the history of the execution of the ROSENBERGS, that the people in attendance knew the details of it already. He mentioned that Senator FULBRIGHT had given out a good idea when he stated that it was now all right to think unthinkable thoughts. 'that which we have done for a long time'. We are the originators of thinking unthinkable toughts'. He gave a loud oratory about thinking unthinkable thoughts and all banding together to free the innocent SOBELL.

"A Negress, HELEN BOWMAN, soprano, accompanied by WALDEMAR HILLE, sang 'ART THOU TROUBLED', a Negro spiritual called 'Get On Board Little Children' and an original song for SOBELL written by MR. HILLE - the words of which are the poem by HELEN SOBELL 'In Anger'.

"GRACE NEWMAN, for many years head of L.A. Chapter for MORTON SOBELL gave the usual pitch for money. They collected about \$200.00 she later stated.

"A letter from A. L. WIEREN was written expressing his regret at not being able to attend to speak. He is ill.

"The M.C. mentioned that they had petitions signed of 2,000 names, but that they needed more. A free admittance to the meeting was offered to all people who brought a filled-in petition. Expense the sught them. A pitch was given for people to take petitions and get them filled.

"HUGH DE LACEY was the concluding speaker. He stated that the trial of the ROSENBERGS was a dirty rotten frame-up against them. He mentioned that he had read recently where

"BERTRAN RUSSELL did not check the evidence at the time but he was almost certain that the ROSENBERGS were innocent. MR. DE LACEY said that the only reason to keep SOBELL in jail is to cover up the miscarriage of justice in the ROSENBERG's case. He said that after many years of fighting for a cause a kind of callousness develops among the people because they get discouraged. He encouraged all to join in a larger battle, putting a good foot forward leading to eventual state of affairs where nobody lacks for justice.

"He said that the government becomes powerful because we the people did not use the power we had to hold the government's hand, but if we couldn't do it then we can try now.

"He concluded by again encouraging everyone to take the petitions and have them signed.

"Several signs were up around the hall:

"U.S. Supreme Court Justice HUGO BLACK: 'The United States Supreme Court has never reviewed this record and has never affirmed the fairness of the trial'.

"CARLETON BEALS

"'I know of no more brazen denial of elementary human rights than exists in the SOBELL Case'.

"REV. PETER MC CORMACK - former Protestant Chaplain of Alcatraz.

"'MORTON SOBELL is Innocent'.

"Mention was made that there were 88 paid admissions and 18 free (because of filled-in petitions) which makes the attendance about 106."

COMMITTEE TO SECURE JUSTICE FOR MORTON SOBELL

A source advised on August 19, 1963, that the Los Angeles Sobell Committee is the Los Angeles, California, affiliate of captioned organization.

Following the execution of atomic spies ETHEL and JULIUS ROSENBERG in June, 1953, the "Communist campaign assumed a different emphasis. Its major effort centered upon MORTON SOBELL," the ROSENBERGS' codefendant. The National Committee to Secure Justice in the Roseberg case - a Communist front which had been conducting the campaign in the United States - was reconstituted as the National Rosenberg-Sobell Committee at a conference in Chicago in October, 1953 and "then as the National Committee to Secure Justice for Morton Sobell in the Rosenberg Case."

("Guide to Subversive Organizations and Publications" dated December 1, 1961, issued by the House Committee on Un-American Activities, page 116.)

In September, 1954, the name "National Committee to Secure Justice for Morton Sobell" appeared on literature issued by the Committee. In March, 1955, the current name, "Committee to Secure Justice for Morton Sobell," first appeared on literature issued by the Committee.

The Address Telephone Directory for the Eorough of Manhattan, New York City, as published by the New York Telephone Company on April 16, 1963, lists the "Committee to Secure Justice for Morton Sobell" as being located at 940 Broadway. New York. New York.

Roy Cohn Was Caught In His Own Trap by HELEN SOBELL

(The trial of the McCarthy-prosecutor, who directed the inquisition against the Rosenbergs and Morton Sobell).

On April 5th, 1951, Judge Irving Kaufman, in a court room in New York, sentenced Ethel and Julius Rosenberg to death, and my husband, Morton Sobell - to 30 years in jail.

I sat in that court-room the entire time of that sadly-renowned trial, and I observed how the three innocent people were being sacrificed because of the continuing fear and the tenseness of the Korean War, because of the fabrication of atomic secrets, and because of the general climate of anti-communist hysteria. Using the charge "conspiracy to commit espionage", the licentious prosecutors, including Roy Cohn, prepared and carried out that which the "Columbia Iaw Review" called "The outstanding political trial of our generation".

13 Years Later

Thirteen years later - April, 1964 - I sat in the same courtroom and followed the trial of Roy Cohn, who is charged with perjury and with obstructing justice.

Cohn had guit his job as Federal Prosecuter many, years previous. He had served as the right hand of the deceased Senator McCarthy. After McCarthy's political defeat, Cohn entered the business world. From \$100,000.00 in 1956, Roy Cohn's wealth grew to over \$2 million in 1963 (as reported in the "Wall Street Journal". February 28, 1963). He operated in various fields - the "Lionel Corporation", which produces toy trains; the "Tower Acceptance Corporation", a small loan company; the "Fifth Avenue Coach Lines", a New York bus company; and the promotion of boxing matches.

Although his business affairs led to legal financial bouts, involving the State of New York and the Federal government, it was his association with the "United Die And Chemical Company" that led to this indictment and trial.

In 1959 a Grand Jury investigated the "United Die And Chemical Company" and failed to indict four people Who were connected with purchasing, selling and manipulating the stocks of this company. Later, in 1961, these four people: 2 Garfield and Pasternak, oil dealers, Roen, owner of "The Desert Inn" in Las Vegas; and Swan, a lawyer from the middle west, were indicted and they pleaded guilty at their trial. Cohn and his co-defendant, Murray Gottesman, a New York lawyer, were indicted in September, 1963, on the charge that they committed a conspiracy not to permit the above four people of the "United Die Company" to be indicted for their manipulations by the 1959 Grand Jury.

Just as though history were trying to teach its own lesson, at the Roy Cohn trial, this famous prosecutor is indicted with the same outrageous tactics as he used in the trial of the Rosenbergs and Sobell. In 1951 Cohn worked

with David Greenglass to prepare Greenglass' testimony. He questioned him on the witness-stand, holding over Greenglass' head the fact that he had confessed to committing espionage, while he was employed as a machinist at Los Alamos. At that time Greenglass had not yet been sentenced, nor his wife Ruth Greenglass, who also confessed that she committed espionage. Originally, they had both insisted strenuously that they were innocent. Later "a deal" was worked out and, in exchange for their testimony, Ruth Greenglass was never arrested, although she confessed to a great deal more than Ethel Rosenberg was charged with. David Greenglass, who testified that he pieced-together the "secret" of the atom-bomb - by eavesdropping on conversation in the corridors at Los Alamos. He has been free for more than three and a half years.

What The Trial Uncovered

Neither the fact that he had no more than a high school education, nor his lies (about which there is now documentary proof) - could send his sister to her death - these did not stop him in those days of war-heat and political hysteria.

At Cohn's trial his lawyer spoke of his client's four associates, who pleaded guilty, but who were not sentenced yet. In words similar to those which the Rosenberg lawyer, Emanuel Bloch, used, Cohn's lawyer said: "If they don't sing the right song, their sentences might be harder".

During the course of the trial it was brought out that the Department of Justice placed a "mail stop" on all letters to Roy Cohn and his lawyer. This is a practice which is strongly reminiscent of McCarthyism. This might cause a longing in the heart of Roy Cohn, but not enough to silence his angry protests. To his own misfortune, Roy Cohn discovered that when those in power violate justice, - it is a sword with two edges.

Naturally, the question here is not Cohn's guilt, or innocence, but the conduct of the trial. Garfield, Swan, Pasternak and Roen, testified about threats, graft and an



attempt on the part of Roy Cohn to have them hinder the course of justice - by misleading the Grand Jury, as well as by the perjury by Roy Cohn to the Grand Jury. Their testimony was backed by witnesses who had no particular motives. Newspaper reports reveal that if a mistrial had not been declared, because of the death of the father of one of the jurors, Roy Cohn would undoubtedly have been found guilty on several of the points in the indictment, which could have led to a sentence of 40 years in jail and a fine of \$50,000.00. He is now being retried.

Inquisition Against Morton Sobell

This is the same Cohn, only now he is sitting on the defendant's chair. He ranted against my husband Morton Sobell and threatened him - in an effort to have him commit an obstruction to justice - by giving false testimony against the Rosenbergs, and by confessing to a crime which he never committed. When Morton refused "to work" with Cohn, he was told: "You will fry and the same goes for the Rosenbergs".

Together with the other prosecutors, Cohn presented one single witness against my husband. This witness (about whom the Judge had said: "If you do not believe the testimony of Max Elitcher regarding Morten Sobell, the Defendant Morton Sobell should be found innocent) - committed perjury before the trial and during the trial. Elitcher said, on the witness-stand, that he was "deathly-afraid". He said that "he hoped for the best" as a result of his testimony. After all, he was never arrested nor tried for his perjury for falsifying a loyalty-oath. Actually he was helped by the F.B.I. in getting a job, in accordance with his ability-as a reward for his testimony at the Rosenberg-Sobell trial.

It was Cohn, together with others, who arranged the brutal kidnapping of our whole family, while we were on vacation in Mexico. During that illegal act of terrorism my busband was beaten up severely. It was much later when we found friends and were able to have this matter investigated - when we obtained documentary proof from the Mexican government, which revealed that not only did the prosecution arrange the kidnapping but, purposely, engaged in a swindle by stating that the Mexican government deported Morton Sobell. The U.S. prosecutors never denied the proof which we submitted in this matter.

When a person held and misused the power and the prestige of the government for years' he sinks so low and, finally, is tried, - why shouldn't someone be interested in the quality of justice which is dispensed by such a person, who deserves disdain? Why should we be interested in this, particularly - we, who are trying to obtain justice in the Rosenberg-Sobell case, which led to the death of two innocent people and to the heartless stemming of the life of a third innocent victim, Morton Sobell, who has been in jail for 14 years? The answer is, that unless law and the conduct of the position of Federal Prosecutor is always under the watchful eye of society - then it is possible for anyone -in a high position, or on a low one, a weak person or a strong one - to fall victim to licentious and ambitious prosecutors. At such a time there is no protection of the fundamental rights of anyone.

If someone had told Roy Cohn 13 years ago that the day would come when he would need a just application of justice for his own protection - he would have burst into laughter, but the same tactics which he so licentiously developed into a fine art, are now being used against him. If a former Federal Prosecutor, a lawyer and manipulator of stocks, who has two million dollars - if he needs a just legal procedure for his protection - then it is painfully clear that the average citizen needs this even more.

Demaids by Bertrand Russell, Linus Pauling, and Others

So long as the shadow of the Rosenberg-Sobell case persecutes the conscience of the outstanding citizens of the world, there is still hope that the gruesome aspects of this trial will be revealed and innocent people will be saved from similar suffering.

Our courts are becoming, increasingly, battle-fields for civil rights, for the right to leave the country, for religion and even for peace. In order for all these rights to be protected honestly and conscientiously, the cancer of

the Rosenberg-Sobell case must be burned out - by the power of public action. Because of this Dr. Harold Urey, Dr. Linus Pauling, Pablo Cassals, Martin Buber, Gordiner Murphy, James T. Farrell, Robert Belt, Arnold Wexer, Bertmand Russell, Gunther Anders, and many others - found it necessary to state that they believe in the innocence of Morton Sobell. Because of this thousands of people have joined in the "Citizens Pull Fardon Campaign" and they are writing letters to the President, and are signing petitions, stating their belief in the innocence of Morton Sobell.

The injustice to Morton Sobell is an injustice to all Americans and is a perpetual reminder that, so long as one innocent person is being punished in an unjust manner, and is being kept in jail, none of us is actually free.
