"QUESTION--How did you get your book published?


"SCHNEIR---It took about a year. He was advised that he would do better in England as it would be too controversial for USA publishers. He finally took it to Double-Day where he knew someone. The two people he knew were in a position to make (or direct) policy. He told them that it was a hot subject and if they thought the subject too controversial, don't bother with it. They called him back and said to come on over.

"QUESTION---What motivated them to publish the book? Was it the anticipation of profit or did they think it was a good cause?

"SCHNEIR--statement not well remembered but is believed he thought it was both for profit and a good idea."

A banquet to honor the authors of An Invitation to An Inquest took place at the Hotel Sheraton Atlantic on the evening of Saturday, November 20, 1965, in the Crystal Room. There were approximately 270 people attending the banquet which started at 6:30 p.m.

The dais composed of the following people, Mr. UPJOHN, TOM O'CONNOR (Vindication of Sacco and Vanzetti), MIRIAM SCHNEIR, WILLIAM KUNSTLER, ROSE SOBELL, HELEN SOBELL, JOHN FAULK, CARLETON BEAL, Mrs. KUNSTLER, WALTER SCHNEIR, ROBERT NEMIROFF, RONNIE GILBERT and a male guitarist.

JOHN FAULK was the chairman. CARLETON BEAL the first speaker, based his theme on the unfairness of the trial. ROSE SOBELL addressed the group with the theme that her son was innocent and that MORTON mentioned to her the only reason he remained alive was because people on the outside cared. HELEN made a brief talk and then asked for contributions (contributions which were announced totaled over \$3,000). ROBERT NEMIROFF recited from the ETHEL and JULIUS ROSENBERG's lone letters. WALTER read various newspaper reviews. WILLIAM KUNSTLER was the last speaker.

RONNIE GILBERT entertained the group.

"Mr. SCHNEIR told us that having lived in Cleveland, he has a lot of his friends he is well represented tonight his parents, other relatives. The interview at radio station and at Hollenden House was harrassed by the FBI, in fact the entire case shows very strong participation by FBI and EDGAR HOOVER had a lot to do with jailing of SOBELL and sending ROSENBERGs to the chair. Harrassment of all that had anything to do with the case, and many answers rest with HOOVER. He went on to say about the way FBI were involved in the case - and how the case was built up against the ROSENBERGs, SOBELL how the FBI introduced the cloak and dagger atmosphere. The jello-box, the can of films, etc - introduction of evidence without verification etc. The sensational headlines in time of national stress - war in Korea. The credibility of various copies of photostatic evidence was not questioned by Defense Judge KAUFMAN had no right to specify or remark that SOBELL should never be granted a parole. Government using discredited witnesses - like GREENGLASS and GOULD or GOLD.

"This GOLD changes his story oftener than his sox. The hotel registry in Albuquerque does not match the events as stated in the case. If this case took place today these people would not have been found guilty - but it was war and any sensational story received a lot of support from the people and that was a shot in the arm to our people, especially when the war was not going too well for U.S.

Government saw a chance to blame somebody and it did, publicizing the case, linking people and events at the height of the cold war hysteria - Pres. TRUMAN and some of the liberals partly responsible for the situation. FUCHS appearance in the spy scare, added fuel to the fire. In face of these ridiculous charges, the defendants were committed. SOBELL for 30 years and ROSENBERGs to death - and eventhough European heads of states and important people pleaded for ROSENBERGs - among them pres. of France and the Opoe ROSENBERGs were executed.

"Invitation to an inquest has some important evidence concerning the case which we will present to the court in next few weeks to free SOBELL. The ROSENBERGs, Mr. SCHEIR added. 'were guilty ----- of something.

"Mrs. SOBELL said that present era is similar to the period of her husband's trial, when hysteria reigned and public were looking for communists under every stone. Her husband was selected as the victim, as somebody had to be. Only her love for her husband, and dedication to see him free gave her courage and strength to carry on the fight. I'll never give up until my husband is free, and absolved from this terrible miscarriage of injustice. Now we see students demonstrating because they don't want to go to war, they don't want to die, to be part of a war that has daily box-score of dead soldiers, but much of the results are not published, we have few casualties - but the others their casualties are much greater, our reports hardly consider them as

"even being humans. It is terrible. It is inhuman. The book she said is full of information about SOBELL's case, it has everything in it. Everyone should have it, read it and pass it on to his friends. Public opinion helped to take SOBELL from Alcatraz. It will be helpful today. DON reminisced about marches, demonstrations in Washington to save the ROSENBERGs there were large crowds and well organized and disciplined, even the Chief of Police of Washington congratuated DON about fine, well organized demonstrations. It was during this period that he met Sen. LANGER, who was impressed with DON's summary of the case, and read a book that DON gave him - on the case. Sen. LANGER was won over and assisted getting help to DON.

"The transcript of the case showed that the ROSENBERGs were being railroaded to the death-chair. Reprieve did not come (from President) and they were electrocuted. Cold war DON stated will end when the ROSENBERG trial will be reopened and the people involved in the case - cleared of any wrong doing --- and there is enough people asking for clarity. DON said he was asked to make an appeal for funds to carry on this work. We have 48 copies of Invitation to an Inquest, they are 5.95 a copy. Additional copies could be ordered with money in advance, a fine present for Xmas, money also accepted.
