During efforts to locate Barr, member of the Julius Rosenberg espionage network who was last seen in Paris, France in June, 1950, we learned that Milton A. By attached letter dated 4/7/55, Newark requested authority to interview Milton Lipton, engineer, Coles Signal Laboratory, Ft. Monmouth, New Jersey. During investigation previously conducted, it was learned that Lipton allegedly was acquainted with the subject while both were employed by the Army Signal Corps in the early 1940's. In 1942 Lipton roomed with Alfred Sarant, member of the Rosenberg espionage network. Lipton attended Cooper Union Institute of Technology, New York City, from 1934 to 1939, and began employment at Coles Signal Laboratory as a Junior Electronic Engineer 7/1/40. He has been employed continuously at that installation and is now an Electronic Engineer. Lipton was the subject of an SGE investigation which was closed favorably by the Secretary of the Army and his letter of clearance was dated 2/25/55. (140-3158) No derogatory information other than the above was developed. It is felt Lipton should be interviewed as he is in a position to furnish information about Barr and Sarant and their activities and acquaintances. Investigation has reflected both Barr and Sarant were involved in the Julius Rosenberg espionage network, both have fled the U. S. and their present location is not known. *J*

In the course of conducting a review of Bufiles on Milton Lipton in connection with the request for this interview, it was determined the report of SA Frederick C. Bauckham, dated 2/2/54 at New York, contained on pages 5 and 6 documentation of Lipton. It was determined this documentation refers to another man by the name of Milton Lipton who was the subject of an LGE case (121-20454). This Lipton is an economist and his file reflects he had never worked at Ft. Monmouth, which information was available to the NY office when the report was prepared.

ERROR NOTED

Referenced Bulet reflects that pages 5 and 6 of referenced report set forth a documentation of MILTON LIPTON, a former associate of subject. This documentation is in fact a documentation of a different MILTON LIPTON than the one who was an associate of the subject JOEL BARR.

EXPLANATION

SA Frederick C. Bauckham, in his memorandum, 4/27/55, attached hereto, explains that the documentation on MILTON LIPTON, as obtained from a Loyalty investigation, NY file 121-8344, pertained to a different MILTON LIPTON than the one who was the associate of JOEL BARR. It was included in the report in the belief that the MILTON LIPTON documented was possibly identical with BARR's associate, ~~MILTON LIPTON~~. SA Bauckham admits that he did not qualify the documentation to show that it "might possibly" pertain to a different individual than the associate of JOEL BARR.

RECOMMENDATIONS AND CONCLUSIONS

The referenced report of SA Bauckham, dated 2/2/54, was approved for submission to the Bureau by Relief Supervisor FRANCIS W. ZANGLE. Inasmuch as it was impossible for SA Zangle to know that the documentation of the MILTON LIP-
TON appearing in the report was incorrect, no memorandum of explanation has been requested of Supervisor Zangle. To hold otherwise would be to require a Field Supervisor to review all references in files other than the pertinent case file, which an Agent is required to review in preparing a report for submission to the Bureau. Therefore, NYO recommends no administrative action insofar as SA Zangle is concerned. With reference to SA Bauckham, it is recommended that the Bureau address a letter of censure to him for documenting the wrong individual in his report of 2/2/54. It is noted SA Bauckham concedes that he documented the wrong MILTON LIPTON.

A documentation of Milton Lipton, an associate of the subject, was set out in the report of SA Frederick C. Bauckham made at New York 2-2-54, however, the documentation pertained to a different person with the same name.

SA Bauckham in the attached explanation admits the documentation pertained to the wrong Milton Lipton and states it was included in the belief that he was possibly identical with the subject's associate. SA Bauckham admits failing to include such a qualification when he set forth his documentation in the report.

The SAC, New York advises in attached letter no explanation was asked of Relief Supervisor Francis W. Zangle who approved the report since he had no way of knowing the documentation was in error and to hold otherwise would require a field supervisor to review all references on Lipton contained in files other than the case files. The SAC, New York, recommends no action in so far as SA Zangle is concerned.

The SAC, New York recommends a letter of censure be directed to SA Bauckham for documenting the wrong person, since he should have made absolutely sure the documentation set forth pertained to the person he was attempting to document.

The Domestic Intelligence Division concurs with the recommendation of the SAC, New York.

between the subject and ALFRED SARANT with whom LIPTON stated he lived for a short period of time in 1941.

Newark T-1, a person who has supplied reliable information in the past and a person in whom JULIUS ROSENBERG confided, stated that ALFRED SARANT was identified to him by JULIUS ROSENBERG as being a member of ROSENBERG's group. Newark T-1 had interpreted that statement as meaning that ALFRED SARANT was a Soviet agent.

It should be noted that JULIUS ROSENBERG was electrocuted at Sing Sing Prison, Ossining, New York, in June, 1953 after having been found guilty in United States Federal District Court, Southern District of New York, on charges of conspiracy to commit espionage against the United States.

LIPTON went on to say that he had only one contact with the subject outside of Fort Monmouth. He stated that he does not recall the exact date but that it was sometime in the Fall of 1941. LIPTON stated that at this period he had been sent to Washington, D. C. by the Signal Corps on a special assignment. While in Washington, D. C., LIPTON had occasion to recommend a particular piece of work to Fort Monmouth for their approval. He stated that it apparently fell to JOEL BARR to approve or disapprove his, LIPTON's, recommendation concerning this piece of work. Because of this, BARR called LIPTON in Washington, D. C. and a long discussion concerning the particular job ensued. After this conversation, BARR approved the job as submitted by LIPTON. LIPTON stated that this was the normal way the thing would have been done at that time.

LIPTON further stated that he had always felt that BARR was interested in the Communist philosophy because of things he had heard around Fort Monmouth. LIPTON stated, however, that he never discussed anything of this nature with the subject and does not know for a fact whether BARR was interested in the COMMUNIST PARTY.

The COMMUNIST PARTY has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

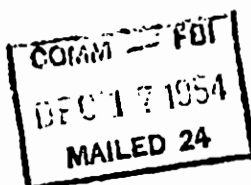

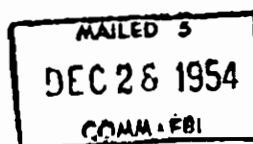

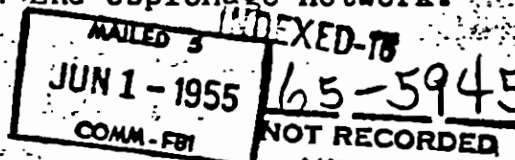

SUCCINCT RESUME OF CASE

Subject was born 1/1/16, Brooklyn, NY.

Subject left NY for Europe in January 1948 and his present whereabouts is unknown.

DAVID GREENGLASS, convicted Soviet espionage agent now in a Federal Penitentiary, has stated in interview on July 17, 1950 that JULIUS ROSENBERG, executed Soviet agent, told him, GREENGLASS, in May 1950, to leave the country and also told him that more important people than GREENGLASS had left the country already, such as JOEL BARR, who was doing work for the Russians overseas.

GREENGLASS also advised that JULIUS ROSENBERG told him that he had given money to JOEL BARR to assist BARR in making his trip to Europe in 1948. GREENGLASS had no knowledge as to the amount of money or when this money was given.

GREENGLASS also stated that JULIUS ROSENBERG, sometime around 1947, told him BARR was active in the espionage net work.

[REDACTED] who has furnished reliable information in the past, but who has a questionable background, advised that he had been told by JULIUS ROSENBERG that JOEL BARR is a courier for the Russians and is in Europe and probably Russia.

Several interviews with subject's relatives have reflected they have no knowledge of subject's whereabouts.

The announcement stated that Action Books, Room 2800, 165 Broadway, had announced for fall publication "The Atom Spy Myth-from Hiroshima to the ROSENBERGS", by WILLIAM A. RUEBEN. It was stated that this is the book in which RUEBEN, who wrote the original "Guardian" articles for the ROSENBERG case in 1951, "had been working on for two years". It described the book as an examination of all the "Atom Spy Cases", "in light of parallel Washington cold war moves". It was stated that "the Atom bomb spy hunt is the greatest hoax in history".

Regarding the "National Guardian", the 1949 report of the California Committee on Un-American Activities cited the "National Guardian" as a publication launched in New York in 1948, aiming at national circulation which they found to be from its inception notoriously Stalinist in its staff, writers, management, and content. (1949 report of the California Senate Fact Finding Committee on Un-American Activities, page 394.)

Barr resided at 65 Morton St., New York, N.Y. (formerly occupied by Alfred Sarant) which was used as conspiratorial headquarters for photographing material in connection with operations of the Rosenberg group (1946-47).

Barr left the U.S. 1/21/48 for France, Greenglass stating that according to Rosenberg he was to carry on espionage work in Europe for the Russians. Subsequently he is known to have visited Holland and Finland, another source (of known reliability) stating that Rosenberg had informed him that Barr was to serve as a Soviet courier.

Subject born Brooklyn, New York, 1-1-16 and graduated College of the City of New York 1938 as an electrical engineer. He was a fellow classmate of Julius Rosenberg, executed Soviet agent, and Morton Sobell, convicted Soviet agent, and William Perl, member of the Rosenberg network. Barr was employed United States Signal Corps, Ft. Monmouth until 1942 when he became employed with Western Electric Corporation until 1946 when he became employed at Sperry Gyroscope Company. Barr left the United States 1-21-48 and resided in Holland, Finland and Paris, France. On 6-16-50 he disappeared from his Paris residence and his present whereabouts is unknown. (6-16-50 was the date of the arrest of David Greenglass, admitted Soviet agent.)

Barr resided at and paid rent for the apartment of Alfred Sarant at 65 Morton Street, New York City, which apartment has been identified as the conspiratorial headquarters for the Rosenberg espionage ring. Greenglass advised Rosenberg told him in 1950 that Barr was one of his espionage contacts in the United States and he left to carry on espionage work for the Soviets in Europe.

All logical leads have been covered. New York has been maintaining contact with one of Barr's brothers in New York City and has not been able to develop any information concerning his whereabouts. Barr is on the Security Index and his case will be reanalyzed on a semiannual basis. All stops will be maintained in order that the Bureau will be notified in the event of Barr's return to the United States.

All C references have been reviewed.

 Sperry Gyroscope Corp., Lake Success, New York, advised on 10/25/57 that at 12:05 P.M. this date he received a telephone call from BEN MANDELL, Research Director for the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee. MANDELL advised [REDACTED] that he wanted information concerning JOEL BARR, who was a former employee at Sperry and, in particular, he wished to ascertain if BARR while employed at Sperry had done any work on space platforms or rockets. MANDELL pointed out to [REDACTED] that DAVID GREENGLASS had advised that BARR had had access to such information. [REDACTED] advised MANDELL that he would have to make a check of his records to determine exactly what BARR'S status had been. [REDACTED] advised the NYO that BARR'S personnel folder at Sperry's indicated that he had been employed 10/28/46 and had been terminated 10/16/47. His job title was as project engineer and his employment had been terminated by discharge inasmuch as no clearance could be secured for BARR. [REDACTED] further advised that he intended to make additional inquiries among current employees at Sperry who might have knowledge of BARR'S exact duties during his employment. When such information had been secured, [REDACTED] said, he would furnish it to MANDELL. He would also advise the NYO of any information he developed. 67d

The report of SA THOMAS E. BRYANT made at Los Angeles 8/30/51 in captioned matter sets forth interview with JOHN MELVILLE, former fellow employee of BARR at Sperry. Rerep sets forth that, according to MELVILLE, BARR was employed at Sperry on "an advanced and highly confidential radar project."

4. Barr was an average engineer. His work consisted of determining how ball room would detect and pick up certain missile shapes which was unclassified work. This Company has never been engaged in space platform work as such.
