Reference is made to the report of Special Agent FRANK P. WILLETTE dated January 27, 1953 at Boston, Massachusetts.

The Boston Office has maintained a mail cover on the Subject's sister and brother-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. HAROLD GILBOARD, 33 Ames Street, Lawrence, Massachusetts since August 10, 1950. On July 12, 1951 the Bureau advised it desired this mail cover to be continued for an additional period of time.

In view of its lack of productivity, it is again requested that consideration be given by the Bureau to discontinue this mail cover.

Re Boston letter 1-27-53, requesting the Bureau to consider the discontinuance of the mail cover being maintained on the sister and brother-in-law of subject, Mr. and Mrs. Harold Gilboard, 33 Ames Street, Lawrence, Massachusetts, because of the lack of productivity.

Inasmuch as the whereabouts of subject is unknown, it is desired that this mail cover be continued for an additional period of time. It is also desired that Mr. and Mrs. Gilboard be interviewed at this time in an effort to determine if they have any information concerning the subject.

The attention of the New York Office is directed to the report of Special Agent Frederick C. Bauckham, dated 10-16-50, at New York, in this case, which reflects that in March, 1947, Barr applied for a loan at the Chase National Bank in New York City and advised the bank that he had a \$5,000 life insurance policy with the Hartford Travelers. The New York Office should contact the Hartford Travelers to determine if there is any information available on subject which might assist in this investigation.

The New York Office should also interview Miss Helen Kalm, who, according to Agent Bauckham's report of 12-6-50 in this case, was living with subject's mother as a companion, unless information appears in its files making such an interview undesirable. Bufiles are negative on Kalm.

NOTE: Barr, known member of Rosenberg espionage network, left the U.S. in 1948. He was in Paris in June, 1950, and disappeared. Mrs. Gilboard was interviewed about two years ago in NYC. Although she did not furnish any substantial info re her brother, she was apparently cooperative.

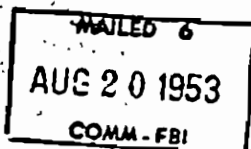

Rebulet 12/22/53, which referred to Philadelphia letter dated 12/1/53, setting forth the results of an interview conducted on 10/8/53, with DAVID GREENGLASS, inmate, United States Federal Penitentiary, Lewisburg, Pa.

Relet pointed out the information contained on page 2, paragraph 4, of Philadelphia letter, 12/1/53, concerning the comments of GREENGLASS regarding the participation of JOEL BARR in the ROSENBERG espionage network, is similar to information furnished by GREENGLASS in an affidavit to the McCarthy Committee. Relet indicated, however, GREENGLASS, as interviewed on 11/23 and 24/53, stated he did not know as fact what information BARR gave to ROSENBERG, but it was only his opinion that BARR gave information on electronics and the "thinking machine," because BARR worked at Fort Monmouth and Sperry Gyroscope Company. Philadelphia was instructed to review its files and obtain the correct version of information furnished by GREENGLASS when interviewed on 11/23 and 24/53, with relation to BARR.

DAVID GREENGLASS was interviewed on 11/23 and 24/53, at the United States Federal Penitentiary, Lewisburg, Pa., by SAS WAYNE G. HUNT and CHARLES P. SILVERTHORN, to determine what he actually told the McCarthy investigators on 10/29 and 11/22/53. It will be recalled GREENGLASS had been interviewed by McCarthy investigators on 10/29/53. The Warden of the Federal Penitentiary at Lewisburg, had submitted a report dated 10/31/53, regarding the interview on 10/29/53, which report was

based on information the warden could remember concerning the interview and what notes he was able to make also while the interview took place. As a result, the Bureau, in a telephone call on 11/5/53, instructed that certain information contained in the warden's report should be thoroughly explored and clarified during a reinterview of GREENGLASS. Bureau permission to reinterview GREENGLASS was given in a teletype dated 11/19/53.

As instructed in Bureau teletype dated 11/19/53, captioned DAVID GREENGLASS, certain specific points were discussed with GREENGLASS. These points, along with GREENGLASS' comments, were set out in Philadelphia airtels dated 11/23 and 24/53, which were captioned DAVID GREENGLASS. Concerning JOEL BARR, GREENGLASS was specifically questioned regarding what information ROSENBERG told him he had obtained from BARR.

As reported in Philadelphia letter dated 12/1/53, captioned "PAUL ELISHA WILLIAMS, SM-C," page 2, paragraph 4, GREENGLASS recalled that ROSENBERG advised him that BARR was a spy and had furnished him, ROSENBERG, with information on a "space platform" and on guided missiles for hitting airplanes in flight. GREENGLASS, when interviewed on 11/23/53 and 11/24/53, was asked to relate the sequence of events which led him to believe that BARR had furnished information to ROSENBERG on guided missiles and the information concerning the fact that BARR was a spy. In answer, GREENGLASS related the following:

In the early part of 1947, ROSENBERG mentioned to GREENGLASS that a friend of his (ROSENBERG's) was working for Sperry Gyroscope Company, New York, on a mechanical brain for guided missile control, which was referred to as a "thinking device." This was described by GREENGLASS as a gadget capable of predicting the course of an enemy missile and subsequently directing a counter-missile as an interceptor. While speaking about the "thinking device" or mechanical brain for guided missile control, ROSENBERG also mentioned to GREENGLASS a "space platform" or "space station." According to GREENGLASS, this is a platform suspended in space from which guided missiles can be launched to any place on earth.

A few days after ROSENBERG's conversation concerning the "thinking device" and "space station," ROSENBERG insisted that "one of the boys" had obtained and furnished to him the whole theory of guided missile control. ROSENBERG also mentioned that the theory of the "thinking device" or

mechanical brain, and the theory of the "space station" had been furnished by him to Russia. ROSENBERG did not name the person to GREENGLASS who furnished him the information. GREENGLASS states, however, that later on in 1947, JOEL BARR, in conversation with GREENGLASS, mentioned he was Project Engineer at Sperry Gyroscope. GREENGLASS believed at this time that BARR was the one who furnished the information to ROSENBERG, but he was not absolutely sure since it was not until 1950 that GREENGLASS found out from ROSENBERG that BARR had worked for him (ROSENBERG).

The information that BARR was a member of ROSENBERG's ring was given to GREENGLASS as a result of ROSENBERG's suggestion that GREENGLASS leave the country in 1950, because of what he knew. GREENGLASS continued that ROSENBERG thought GREENGLASS should apply to the State Department for a passport and leave the Port of New York for Paris, France, by boat. GREENGLASS objected to this method of travel, stating that he would be under the eyes of the State Department and the FBI. ROSENBERG then told GREENGLASS, "More important people than you have left by this route." GREENGLASS inquired as to the identity of these people and ROSENBERG said, "JOEL BARR for one." ROSENBERG then stated to GREENGLASS that BARR was a member of his spy ring for a long time, even before GREENGLASS. GREENGLASS was of the opinion that this would have been prior to 1944, inasmuch as he, GREENGLASS, first engaged in espionage activity for ROSENBERG in 1944.

From the above, GREENGLASS states he is of the opinion that JOEL BARR gave ROSENBERG the information on the "thinking machine" and the "space station," since ROSENBERG mentioned a friend of his was working at Sperry Gyroscope on the mechanical brain, and GREENGLASS subsequently was able to determine that BARR was a Project Engineer at Sperry Gyroscope and a member of ROSENBERG's spy ring. GREENGLASS added that ROSENBERG did not specifically name the person who gave him the information on the "thinking machine" and the "space station," but it is logical, according to GREENGLASS, that BARR was the one.

GREENGLASS also stated that he has no definite information indicating that BARR gave information to ROSENBERG while BARR was employed at Fort Monmouth, N. J. The only basis

for GREENGLASS' belief that BARR gave information to ROSENBERG while BARR was still at Fort Monmouth was the statement from ROSENBERG in 1950, that BARR was a member of his spy ring long before GREENGLASS. As mentioned above, this would have been before 1944 and BARR, according to GREENGLASS, was not discharged from Fort Monmouth, N. J., until 1946.

GREENGLASS stated in conclusion that JOEL BARR never admitted to him (GREENGLASS) that he (BARR) was involved in espionage. BARR, according to GREENGLASS, did admit Communist sympathies and believed that Russia "was showing the way." GREENGLASS also stated the only reason for his belief that BARR was involved in espionage was the statements made to him by ROSENBERG as mentioned above.

Inasmuch as the investigation concerning subject PAUL ELISHA WILLIAMS, Security Matter - C, has been completed in this office, this matter is being considered RUC'd.

GREENGLASS further recalled that later on in 1947 JOEL BARR in a conversation with him mentioned he was a project engineer at Sperry Gyroscope, and that was the reason why GREENGLASS believed BARR was the one who furnished the information concerning the "thinking device" and "space station" to ROSENBERG. GREENGLASS did not know if BARR gave any information to ROSENBERG while he, BARR, worked at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey; furthermore, BARR never admitted that he was involved in espionage. One more thing that GREENGLASS recalled was that ROSENBERG told him BARR was a member of a spy ring before GREENGLASS ever came into the group.

Mr. FRANK PHILBIN was contacted February 19, 1954 at the Personnel Office, Sperry Gyroscope Company, and PHILBIN advised that BARR had nothing to do with guided missiles or "space stations," and that his duties were very menial.

On February 23, 1954 Mr. ERIC ISBISTER, formerly in charge of the department in which BARR worked, stated that BARR had no connection with the guided missile program, and that as far as he knew there was no project going on at the time BARR was employed with regard to "space platforms." Mr. ISBISTER also stated that at the time BARR was employed there he did not believe that the Sperry corporation was doing any work on "brain thinking" machines or digital electronic machines as he knew them to be.

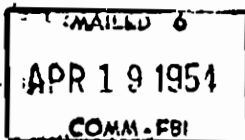
