FLOYD ELWYN, SR., SUPERINTENDENT, SIX FIVE MORTON ST., NYC, NINETEEN TWENTY SIX TO OCTOBER, FORTY EIGHT, ADVISED FIRST CONTACT WITH ALFRED SARANT IN WINTER, FORTY FOUR, AFTER ELWYN RE-MOVED WIRE SOMEONE HAD RUN FROM WINDOW OF APT. FIVE-I TO WINDOW OF SARANT-S APT. SIX-I. THIS WIRE CARRIED AC CURRENT, WHICH IS NOT PROVIDED TO APTS EXCEPT ON SPECIAL REQUEST. WHEN ELWYN ENTERED SIX-I TO REMOVE WIRE, HE SAW VERY LITTLE FURNITURE, BUT RECALLS BEDROOM CONTAINED THREE SINGLE IRON COTS, LIVING ROOM CONTAINED WORK BENCH, PLENTY OF TOOLS OF TYPE ELECTRICIAN WOULD USE, AND THE CLOSET HELD SEVERAL BLACK METAL TOOL BOXES AND CHASSIS OF WHAT APPEARED TO BE TWO RADIOS. THERE WERE SMALL CLOCKS ON WORK BENCH, ONE BEING CONNECTED TO THE AC ELECTRIC LINE, SO THAT MOVING THE HANDS CAUSED AN ARC TO FLASH IN ANOTHER PART OF THE ROOM. BEFORE MARRIAGE SARANT WAS VERY FRIENDLY WITH DAUGHTER OF GUSTAV GOLDNER. APT SIX-S, EIGHT FIVE BARROW ST., AN ADJOINING APT. HOUSE. THIS WOMAN NOW A RESIDENT OF BROOKLYN, BUT HER FATHER IS AT OLD ADDRESS. MISS GOLDNER DESCRIBED AS MEMBER OF SAME GROUP AS SARANT AND HIS FRIENDS, WHO ELWYN BELIEVES CONSTITUTED A YOUNG COMMUNIST ORGANIZATION. ELWYN COULD NOT REMEMBER WILLIAM PERL. WA.. WILLIAM MUTTERPERL HAVING A WIFE, OR THE LENGTH OF PERL-S OCCUPANCY. BOTH FLOYD ELWYN, SR., AND FLOYD ELWYN, JR., THE PRESENT BLDG. SUPERINTENDENT, DESCRIBED THEIR BOSS, THE MAN IN CHARGE OF RENTALS AT SIX FIVE MORTON ST., AS A QUOTE PINK, RED UNQUOTE OR PRO-SOVIET. THIS INDIVIDUAL, ROBERT/GARLOCK, IS PRESIDENT AND PART OWNER OF SIX FIVE MORTON ST. CORP, OFFICES AT THREE ONE NAUGHT EAST FIVE FIVE ST., NYC. THE ELWYNS SAY HE HAS PUT A NUMBER OF THE SAME TYPE PERSONS AS SARANT IN AS TENANTS. BUT MAY NOT LIKE SARANT. AS THEY HAD DISAGREEMENT OVER SARANT-S REQUEST TO SUBLEASE. ELWYN. SR.. REMEMBERS THE PREVIOUS TENANT-AT APT. SIX-I, NAMED ESLEY, BUT DOES NOT THINK ANY CONNECTION BETWEEN VESLEY AND SARANT. END PAGE TWO

ADVISED APT. SIX-I VACANT SHORT WHILE AFTER VESLEY MOVED OUT. ELWYN, JR., DESCRIBES PRESENT TENANT SIX-I, THOMAS F. DONAVAN, AS ARDENT CATHOLIC, WHOM HE BELIEVES IS RELIABLE. DONAVAN PROBABLY GOT APARTMENT THROUGH HIS SISTER A MRS. MCGILL, A TENANT AT EIGHT FIVE BARROW ST., ANOTHER ADJOINING APT. HOUSE. ELWYN, JR., RECALLED THAT WHEN HE ENTERED SARANT-S APT IN DECEMBER, FORTY NINE OR JANUARY FIFTY, AND OBSERVED KITCHEN TABLE WITH REFLECTOR TYPE PHOTO FLOOD BULB OR SIMILAR TYPE BULB ON WALL OVER TABLE--THAT THERE WERE AT LEAST A DOZEN FOUNTAIN PENS AND A FEW COLORED PENCILS ON THE TABLE. HE ALSO RECALLS THAT AN EASEL OR DRAWING BOARD APPROXIM-ATELY TWENTY FOUR TO THIRY INCHES LONG, EIGHTEEN TO TWENTY INCHES WIDE, WITH FOUR, THREE-FOOT LEGS, WAS FOUND IN THE APT CLOSET BY APT PORTER, T. HE SAID PHOTO OF JOEL BARR COULD BE MAN NAMED KELDMAN, WHO VISITED TWO SINGLE GIRLS, NAMES NOT RECALLED, IN APT SIX-C EIGHT FIVE BARROW ST., NINETEEN THIRTY EIGHT TO FORTY TWO. THESE GIRLS ALLEGEDLY HAVE BEEN INVESTIGATED BY THE BUREAU. FELDMAN WAS POSSIBLE CONTACT OF ARTHUR GRAVES, APT ONE-O, THAT ADDRESS, WHO ADMITTED TO ELEYN IN THIRTY EIGHT THAT HE WAS QUOTE RED UNQUOTE. XDAYTON POSSIBLY IDENTICAL WITH MAN WHO WAS IN APT SIX-I IN JANUARY FIFTY, WITH MAN WHO CLAIMED TO BE PERL. THEY COULD NOT IDENTIFY AVAILABLE PHOTO OF PERL, ALTHOUGH MRS. ELWYN THINKS IT LOOKS LIKE MAN THEY KNEW AS PERL. THEY DID NOT RECOGNIZE PHOTO OF JOEL BARR, MAX OR HELENE ELITCHER, ETHEL OR JULIUS ROSENBERG OR SILVERSTEIN. BOTH MR. AND MRS. 





There is being transmitted herewith brown manila wrapping paper (with rubber band attached) for processing by the Laboratory for possible latent fingerprints of subject who has PRI \$449-9464.

RUTH and DAVED GREENGLASS have advised that, about the end of May, 1950, or the beginning of June, 1950, JULIUS ROSENBERG gave DAVID GREENGLASS a package which JULIUS said contained \$4,000.00. The package was wrapped in brown manila paper and was secured with brown gummed paper and heavy brown twine. The package was oblong in shape, about the width of a dollar bill, and of a length a little longer than a dollar bill, and about one inch or a little more in thickness.

DAVID GREENGLASS did not open the package but hid it in the flue of his chimney, securing it to the wall of the flue with Texcel tape. Later, DAVID GREENGIASS removed the package from the chimney flue and took off the "Texcel" tape. On that same day, he turned the package over to one LOUIS ABEL for safekeep-

LOUIS ABEL hid the package in a hassock in his apartment. Subsequently, RUTH GREENGLASS asked ABEL to give her \$100.00. ABEL then untied the twine, broke the gummed paper seal, and opened the package. He removed \$100.00 from the package and gave that sum to RUTE CREENGIASS. When rewrapping the package, ABEL tore off the ends of the wrapping paper (which he believed had the gummed paper attached) because he felt there was too much wrapping paper. ABEL then sealed the package with Scotch tape and bound it with one or more rubber bands. ABEL believes he threw away the twine.

On June 16, 1950, ABEL turned the package over to Mr. HERBERT FABRICANT, an attorney in the law offices of Mr. O. JOHN ROGGE. FARRICANT opened the package in ABEL'S presence. Then ABEL departed. Mr. FABRICANT and Mrs. HELEN TX PAGANO of Mr. ROGGE'S office counted the money. Both believe it contained \$3,000.00 in \$20.00 bills and \$900.00 in \$10.00 bills. Mrs. PAGANO put the wrapper in her office file. Mr. ROGGE believed he might have handled the wrapper also.

Shortly thereafter Greenglass was arrested by the FBI.

The gravity of Rosenberg's offense, Mr. Hoover stated, is accentuated by the fact that through his implication in the espionage ring as a native born American citizen he aggressively sought ways and means to secretly conspire with the Soviet government to the detriment of his own country.

Julius Rosenberg was born May 12, 1918, at New York City and was graduated from the College of the City of New York with a B.S. Degree in Electrical Engineering in February, 1939. Following employment with various Manhattan and Brooklyn electrical engineering firms, he was employed as a junior engineer in the Signal Service, War Department, Supply Office, New York General Depot, Brooklyn, on September 3, 1940. Thereafter he was transferred to the Signal Corps, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, as an Assistant Engineering Inspector working in the Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and New Jersey areas. He

was promoted to Associate Engineering Inspector on February 16, 1943, and continued in this position until his employment was suspended on February 9, 1945, when he was removed by the Secretary of the War Department acting on the recommendation of Rosenberg's commanding officer on the basis of information indicating Communist Party membership. Rosenberg made numerous unsuccessful attempts to be reinstated. Subsequent to leaving the Signal Corps, he purchased and operated the Pitt Engine Products, Incorporated, 370 East Houston Street, New York City. Rosenberg, married, father of two children, resided at 10 Monroe Street, New York City.



Attorney Saypol had contacted him to see if there is any objection to separating David Greenglass and Julius Rosenberg, who are presently at the Federal House of Detention with the object of not allowing them to get together and discuss their cases. Rosenberg has been in solitary confinement. However, it is not possible to keep him in solitary and, therefor unless one of these individuals is removed to the Tombs (New York City Prison they will be able to talk together. Mr. Whelan advised that the other prisoners in the Federal House of Detention apparently don't like spies because Greenglass has been unfavorably commented on by the other prisoners. Mr. Saypol thought that Greenglass might be moved to the Eleventh Floor of the Tombs, where the New York Police Departme houses its "song birds." They are given more than usual consideration and inasmuch as Greenglass is cooperative, it was his thought that Greenglass shoul go up there rather than Rosenberg. I advised Mr. Whelan that it would be desirable that these two not be brought together, particularly as Greenglass does not want to talk to Rosenberg. However, the mechanics of handling these prisoners is up to the United States Marshal and Mr. Saypol. Another Spy Arrest

The latest figure in the great atomic spiring case is that of Julius Rosenberg, ar rested the other day in New York by agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation Rosenberg is an engineer who was for time in the employ of the United States Army Signal Corps but was removed from his job when his superiors were informed of his alleged Communist associations. He is now said to have been part of an espionage apparatus, which operated under the direction of Anatoli A Vakovley, Soviet vice consul in New York City, and which included Harry Gold, a biochemist of Philaincluded Harry delphia, and Divid Greenglass of New York,
a former Army sergeant attached to the laboratories of the atomic bomb at Los Alamos, N. Mex.

Evidently there was for a time a fairly close connection between this group and . Klaus Fuchs, the self-controlled schize pirene now serving a 14-year sentence in gland for the betrayal of atomic secrets to the Russians. The part of Gold in the conspiracy was that of a messenger or courier. He has pleaded guilty to having received formulas and other information from Fuchs in claudestine meetings at New York, Cambridge, Mass., and Santa Fe, N. Mex. His confession in open court appears also to cover the receipt of other information concerning the work at Los Alamos from Greenglass at a meeting in Albuquerque arranged by Rosenberg.

It would appear, then, that the arrests of Gold, Greenglass and Rosenberg were the result of information given by Fuchs to the representatives of the FRI who were per mitted by the British authorities is juter rogate him. According to one report. approximately 14 names were mentioned by Fuchs as those of persons whom he knew or supposed to be involved in the conspiracy Further arrests are, therefore, so be anticipated. MY RELATION WITH ROSENBERG CEASED AS OF THAT TIME. SOMETIME IN NINTEEN FORTY FIVE I MET SOBELL PROBABLY IN NEW YORK. WAS THE FIRST TIME I HAD SEEN HIM SINCE THE INTERVIEWS I HAD WITH ROSENBERG AT WASH. D. C. I MENTIONED TO HIM THAT I HAD SEEN JULIUS ROSENBERG, AND THAT ROSENBERG HAD MENTIONED HIS NAME -SOBELL-S NAME-AS A PERSON WHO WAS COOPERATING WITH HIM IN THE WORK ROSENBERG WAS DOING OR SOME SIMILAR PHRASE. SOBELL BECAME ANGRY AND DISTURBED AT THIS, AND SAID ROSENBERG SHOULD NOT HAVE MENTIONED HIS NAME. I TOLD SOBELL THAT WITH REGARD TO ROSENBERG-S PROPOSITION I WOULD SEE WHAT I COULD DO, OR SOME SUCH PHRASE. VINCENT J. CAHILL FBI NYC- " IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE INFORMATION ELITCHER STATED THAT SOBELL OBTAINED EMPLOYMENT WITH THE GENERAL ELECTRIC CO. IN SCHENECTADY N. Y. AROUND SEPT. NINETEEN FORTY TWO, DOING ENGINEERING WORK. SOBELL WORKED AT GENERAL ELECTRIC UNTIL THE EARLY PART OF NINETEEN FORTY SEVEN WHEN HE CAME TO NEW YORK PURCHASED A HOME IN FLUSHING, NY AND STARTED TO WORK AT REEVES INSTRUMENT CORPORATION. ELITCHER STATED THAT DURING THE PERIOD OF NINETEEN FORTY TWO TO NINETEEN FORTY SEVEN. HIS RELATIONSHIP WITH SOBELL WAS LIMITED TO OCCASIONAL CORRESPONDENCE, INFREQUENT VISITS TO WASHINGTON BY SOBELL ON BUSINESS FOR GE. ELITCHER FURTHER ADVISED THAT ABOUT JANUARY NINETEEN FORTY SIX, HE WAS GIVEN A CHANGE OF POSITION AT THE BUREAU OF ORDNANCE NAVY DEPT. WHICH END OF PAGE FOUR

NECESSITATED OCCASIONAL TRAVEL BY HIM TO SCHENECTADY N. Y. ON AT LEAST ONE SUCH TRIP, ELITCHER SAW SOBELL, AND STAYED AT HIS HOME. 



In connection with provious information furnished to you in this matter and in the case entitled "David Greenglass, Espionage - 2," This Furness has been in touch with the Atomic Energy Commission relative to the classified mature of information provided by Greenglass to fold and Rosenberg. Two problems arise in connection with this matter.

There is the problem of making public at a trial the data of a restricted mature which Groungless admits furnishing, much of which is still classified. There is also the problem of the testimony of the Atomic Energy Commission witnesses as to what can be disclosed at the trial. It is felt that these are problems which should be the subject of discussion between the Atomic Energy Commission representatives and you or the appropriate United States Atterneys. With respect to the signed statement of Greenglass dated July 17, 1850, which is set out in the summary report of Special Agent John H. Lewis, dated July 22, 1950, at New York in this case, starting on Page 11, and continuing on the following page, there appears information concerning the "Haval type stom bomb." The Atomic Energy Commission has advised as follows: "The Hireshima type bomb was never officially designated as the "Haval Type" bomb. However it may have been given such an informal name among those who worked with it since paff of the work in connection with its development was carried out by the Havy This bomb was not completed as of January 1945. All of the information concerning this bumb was considered classified in January 1945 and much of it is still not considered declassifiable.

In the same signed statement, on Page 15 in the last directors there appears information which Grounglass said he passed to Hipschipf relative to the etom bomb. Geneeming this, the Atomic Racky Fermission has advised. With respect to the information which Growleins says he passed to guilds keepshorg in the full of 1945, information of this type was classified in the full of 1945 and is still not considered to be declassifiable."

On Page 13 in the signed statement Greenglass admits, "I furnished Julius Resemberg with an impealed develope containing the information I had been able to gather concerning the atom bomb, he well as a couple of sketches of the molds which make up the stam bomb." Concerning this the Atomic Hearry Commission has stated, "Sketches of the mold used in the atom bomb were classified at that the and are still 'restricted data."

On Page 18 in the statement, Grounglass admits, T also furnished Gold with information concerning the identity of a worldfamous scientist who was working at Loc Alance under an assumed name and also furnished information that Opponheimer and Eletiakowsky were working at Los Alemos." The Atomie Thorgy Commission has advised, "The Membetten District did attempt to 'play down' the identity of the employees of Los Alemos up through the period including Jone. 1945. particularly the identity of the key scientific staff, and did make an effort to assure that lists of such employees would not be published. It is felt, however, that it is somewhat doubtful that the fact that Dr. Opponhoimer and Dr. Kistiakowski were employed at los Alames was considered by itself to be classified information by the Manhattan District. Dr. Bohr's association with the Manhattan District as of June 1945 was considered as 'secret' information." For your information, it was Dr. Bohr who was referred to by Greenglass in this statement. The Atomic Emergy Commission Curnished three pieces of correspondence which bear out the conclusion that Dr. Bahr's presence at Los Alamos was "secret." Photostatic écpies of this correspondence are enclosed for your information. The Atomie Emergy Commission is attempting to locate additional documents with respect to this matter, 😞

On Page 13, with respect to the material furnished by Greenclass to Gold, Greenglass states, "I also gave him a sketch of a high explosive lens mold which was an experiment to study implosion effects on a stool tube to understand the effect it would have on uranium so that it could be determined how a critical mass could be arrived at which would not explode before detomation." With respect to this, the Atomic Energy Commission has edvised, "The particular sketch....appears, however, to be a description of an experimental setup rather than a description of a molds the sketch has been further described as to sketch of a Beski arrangement for a ferm of cylindrical implesion on a steel tabe, and is still elassified as 'secret.' It could possibly be described by a witness as a skotch of a high explosive lone, rather than a skotch of a high 🐇 explosive lens mold. are specifically inviting your attention to the above since we understand that Grounglass was charged in the indistment as having prepared and delivered a sketch of a 'high-explosive lens mold. "

There was also forwarded to the Atomic Energy Commission a locate disk which was found in Greenglass' spartment in New York City. Greenglass had admitted that he obtained this disk while working at Lee Alemos and had claimed that it was part of the atom bomb. The Atomic Emergy Commission has advised, "The lucite disk was part of an experimental model of a detomator which was being tested for use with the atom bomb. It was classified, as were all such parts. The security significance of this disk is extremely low unless it was accompanied by a detailed account of the function it fulfilled within the detomator. The disk would not now warrant any classification."

We also ferwarded to the Atomie Buergy Commission the following items: One list of promotions of emlisted men, dated March 27, 1945; one mineegraphed letter, dated August 8, 1945, to all members of the laboratory, from J. R. Oppenheimer; one undated, mineographed form marked "Restricted" and signed by J. R. Oppenheimer; one letter dated August 6, 1945, to all military and civilian personnel, Manhattan Matriet, from E. D. Michole, Colonel, Manhattan District, Cak Ridge, Tennessee; and one copy of the cover page of the "Ordnance Soldier's Guide, marked "Restricted," and issued by Ordnance Replacement Training Center, Aberdeen Proving Grounds, Maryland. The Atomic Energy Commission has advised that it would not be a vielation of the Atomio Energy Security Regulations for Greenglass to have any of the above mentioned documents in his possession. The Atomic Reorgy Commission also advised that in their opinion Grounglass' retention of those documents upon coparation from corvine would not have violated Manhattan Matrict security regulations.

The Atomic Energy Commission was also requested to advise as to whether there was any objection to the disclosure in a public trial of information regarding Greenglass' work on implosion experimentation and implosion research. The Atomic Energy Commission has pointed out that scientific and technical information of this general type is classified as "restricted data." They suggested that if the prosecution of the case required that some of this information be declassified the Commission would be glad to consider the matter further, but that they felt that it may be possible for a witness to testify to the general nature of Greenglass' work at los Alamos without disclosure of any information now classified as "restricted data."

For will see from the above that there are a number of problems in connection with the technical testimony that will have to be necessarily solved in connection with the procesution of Grounglass and Rosenberg. We are forwarding the information contained herein to our New York and Albuquerque Offices and are instructing them to discuss this natter with United States Attorneys Granthum and Saypel



He stated that he was born Receiber 28, 1927 at Winnipag, Canada, and is still a Canadian citizen.

The following signed statement was obtained from MANUEL SCHMARTZ:

*Chicago, Ill. August 6, 1950

"I, Manuel Schwarts, 1026 E. Hyde Park Elvd., Chicago, Ill. make the following statement to Mr. Jeromiah Z. Hurley and Mr. W. Eulon Paxman who have identified themselves to me as Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, United States Department of Justice. I make this statement freely and voluntarily and have been advised that I do not have to make such a statement.

Was formerly employed on the stonic energy project at Los Alamos, New Maxico and Chicago, Illinois. I was at Los Alamos from about July 1944 to about February 1946 and was on the project in Chicago, Ill. for about six months thereafter.

"My work was principally as a member of theoretical groups on the project except Dr. Greisen's group where I did computational work. As a result of this work and partly from lectures and motion pictures pertaining to the project, I gained some knowledge of the atomic bomb. My memory is now vague in this regard, but while on the project I believe I had knowledge of the following: Critical mass of the atomic bomb; velocities of the shock waves from the atomic bomb; size of the atomic bomb; detonating device of the atomic bomb, which I comprehended vaguely; the inside makeup of the atomic bomb; the slow and fast explosives used in the atomic bomb.

There is the latter part of 1944 or early part of 1945, I become acquainted with David Greenglass who was a soldier working in a machine shop on the atomic project in los Alamos. I was in a library at los alamos and David Greenglass struck up a conversation with me. Thereafter I was Greenglass sometimes for about one year. This was principally during 1945. Thereafter I did not see Greenglass often. During our acquaintance we went on hikes together. Greenglass was at my home a few times.

Mirconglass was working as something at the machine shop which in my opinion would give him knowledge of the outside proportions of the stories bomb. I believe he know that he was working on but he set sure. I had access to the part of the project where Greenglass worked and saw creenglass on the job on several occasions. It is my recallection that he pointed out to me what work he was doing, but I do not recall the exact mature of his discussion.

I have no specific recollection of beiling Greenglass of information in my possession pertaining to the stonic bamb as previously set out. It is entirely possible that I did impart this information to him, however, in our discussions. I do not recall that Greenglass ever asked me for such information. I also have no recollection that such information was Turnished Greenglass by me while having coffee in a cafeteria in Los llamos although I do becall that Greenglass and I have had coffee together on several pecasions while at los llamos.

The say belief that Greenglass would not have understood the physics of the information in my possession pertaining to the atomic bomb and this causes me to believe that I would not have discussed this information with Greenglass.

Thave not seen Greenglass since I left Los Alamos and the only correspondence has consisted of Christmas cards. I met Mrs. David Greenglass on one occasion. The name of Julius Rosenberg is not known to me,

I have read this statement consisting of aix pages and it is the truth to the best of my knowledge and present recollection. I have imitialled each page and each correction.


