Mrs. JAME AYLWARD, wife of Captain THEODORE AYLWARD, United States Navy, quartered at the United States Naval Base, Philadelphia, and former wife of CARTER HOODIESS, was interviewed at the Philadelphia Office by Special Agents WILLIAM B. WELTE and FRED C. BIRKBY on July 31, 1947. after appointment was previously arranged telephonically. والمنافئ أرحاني أوفأ وبالبيان المنافقة المام وحاله الموجورية

Mrs. AYLWARD Atated that the names JACOB GOLOS, JOHN GOLOSE, ABRAHAN BROTHAN and HARRY GOLD were entirely onfamiliar to her. She had no knowledge of any connection between CARTER HOODINGSS and any of these individuals. Photographs of GOLOS, BROTHMAN and GOLD were exhibited to her and Mrs. AYLWAND stated that to the best of her knowledge, she had never seen any of these individuals. Mrs. AYLWARD stated that she had little knowledge of CARTER

HOODLESS affairs.

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Mrs. AYLWARD stated that while HOODLESS was employed as a chemist, he had a small amount of chemical education. He had no particular interest in his work and as far as she knew was not interested in any chemical societies. She stated that HOCDLESS' interests were primarily social and that he had an unusually wide and diversified list of acquaintances. She stated that he knew all sorts of people and was prone to take up with new acquaintmes at the numerous social gatherings which he attended. She stated that she never knew him to have any contact with anyone connected with a foreign government. 

Mrs. AYLWARD was unable to furnish any information which might lead to development of HOODLESS' contacts with GOLOS. 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
