



GERHART FRIEDIANDER (Bufile 116-14967) was an acquaintance of the subject at Los Alamos, New Mexico. He was employed in the Research Laboratory, General Electric Company, Schenectady, New York, from March 4, 1946 to January 14, 1948. On the occasions of the subject's visit to the General Electric Research Laboratory on November 18 and 19, 1947, the subject personally contacted FRIEDIANDER. Bureau files reflect that when attending the University of California from 1937 to 1942, FRIEDLANDER was investigated

by the Berkeley, California, Police Department because of alleged Communistic tendencies. He was found to be a member of the "Campus Committee for Peace Mobilization" and "Committee to Fight Conscription". Bureau files also indicate that during 1943, FRIEDIANDER and MORRIS LEONARD PERIMAN were the sources of "discontent rumors" to the effect that persons employed on the Manhattan Project could not visit foreign countries. Bureau files also indicate that FRIEDIANDER and PERIMAN had on one occasion discussed TGNACY WITCZAK in such a manner as to indicate personal acquaintance with him.

MORRIS LEONARD PERIMAN (Bureau file 116-33189) was an acquaintance of the subject at Los Alamos. He was employed in the Research Laboratory, General Electric Company, Schenectady, New York, from February 25, 1946 to August 31, 1948. Upon the occasion of subject's visit to the Research Laboratory, General Electric Company on November 18 and 19, 1947, the subject contacted PERIMAN personally. Bureau files reflect that PERIMAN was a member of the Temporary Executive Committee of the Association of Los Alamos Scientists, and that Dortor IN PERIMAN, 527 Colusa Avenue, Berkeley, California, was a member of the Executive Committee of the San Francisco Federation of American Scientists, both of which were reportedly Communist infiltrated at that time. While a resident of Los Alamos, New Mexico in 1943, PERIMAN received circulars from "Free World", 8 West Fortleth Street, New York, New York. Additional information concerning PERIMAN has been set out underneath GERHART FRIEDIANDER, above.

JOHN PAUL BLEWETT (Bureau file 116-337). is mentioned in report of SA ERENTON S. GORDON dated 2-22-50 at Boston, in which Albany is requested to provide information on BIEWETT in view of the fact that one JOHN/DIEWITT and wife, HILDRED, 28 Sunnyside Road, Scotia, New York, employed at the General Electric Company, Schenectady, New York, was listed in the personal notebook of ISRAELANAPERIN, a subject in CORBY case. BLEWETT was considered a possible suspect as the unknown Schenectady scientist.

BLENETT and HALPERIN were roommates at the University of Toronto and later at Princeton University, being closely associated from 1928 to 1936. BLEWETT studied at Cambridge University, England, 1936-37, and was employed as a physicist in the Research Laboratory, General Electric Company, Schenectady, from 1937 to 1946. BLEWETT resided at 22 Sunnyside Road. Scotia, New York, from 1939 to 1942. BLEWETT was terminated by the General Electric Company in December, 1946, when the Manhattan District Engineers refused clearance for security reasons. BLEWETT has not resided in Schenectady since the summer of 1947. He has been reported working at the Brookhaven National Laboratory, Patchogue, New York, since that time.

SECURITY MATTER Bireau File 100-295389 Reference is made to Bureau letter to Newark dated February 13, 1950, in which this office was instructed to consider the removal of Subject's Security Index Card if there is no current proof of membership in or adherence to the principles of the Communist Party on his part. or another in the FOOCASE. Until such time as HIMINEISS is definitely eliminated as being identical with property of this case will remain in a pending status in this office. Although noinformation of Communist Party activity on the part of the Subject has come to the attention of this office since report of Special Agent PHILIP J. CARROLL dated 9/6/46, no recommendation for cancellation of Subject's Security Index Card is being made until he is definitely eliminated as a suspect in the above-mentioned matter. 



He gives impression of being definitely opposed to the Russian Revolution and the present regime in Russia. He intimates that his views and his fortune required that he leave Russia. He has never spoken of his German or Chinese background. The same informant suggested that if this office desired any additional information on VON GROSSE, JAMES DONNELLY, hi? Grove Road, Narberth, Pa., should be entacted. The informant described

DONNELLY as the one who directs the Research Institute at Temple from an administrative and personnel standpoint. DONNELLY is an ex regular Navy Captain.

The same person advised that the Research Institute at Temple University operates on a commercial basis and does not handle research projects for the school. This commercial work is done for industry and the Government on fee or cost-plus basis. Thirty-five to forty people are regularly employed by this Institute, and quite a few part-time employees are hired as special projects demand.

The Bureau and offices receiving this letter are requested to examine these photographs and determine if these photographs are sufficient. Unless advised to the contrary, Philadelphia will make no further efforts to secure other photographs.





Columbia University Branch of the Communist Party in 1933 and 1934 and who also admitted that he engaged in anti-Nazi espionage work in 1935 and 1936 with JULIET STUART POINTZ, a Russian espionage agent, advised that he believes that EDWARD EVERETT AVER was at the Columbia University Branch of the Communist Party in 1934. AVER attended some of the Communist Party meetings between September 1933 and the summer of 1934 with GRAUBARD. A photograph of EDWARD EVERETT AVER, the subject in this case, was exhibited to GRAUBARD, and he identified this person as the one who was in the Communist Party in 1934.

GRAUBARD advised that he introduced EDWARD EVERETT AVER to JULIET STUART POYNTZ, Russian espionage agent in about 1935; AVER told him at a later date that he did nothing for POYNTZ in the way of espionage work.

GRAUBARD stated that he last saw AUER in 1937 when GRAUBARD returned from a trip to Europe. At this time GRAUBARD told AUER that he should forget his activities and that he should not do anything for JULIET STUART POYNTZ or the Russian espionage ring. GRAUBARD stated he has not seen nor been in touch with AUER since about 1937 nor does he know anything concerning his present sympathies or activities.

By letter dated 2/16/50 the Bureau requested that Newark contact and interview AUEH. By teletype dated 2/24/50 Newark advised the Bureau that AUER is a current active member of a Communist Party club:

In view of this, the Bureau was requested to advise if the interview was still

desired.

In light of the above developments in connection with the FOOCASE, it is requested that the Bureau give further consideration to withholding the interview with AUER until such time as he is definitely eliminated as possibly being identical with

It is suggested that in view of the fact that AUER worked for approximately 3 years towards his PhD Degree in Chemical Engineering at Columbia University, that the New York Office, following Bureau permission, should attempt to determine if AUER has ever submitted a thesis in connection with his PhD work. 1/







It was not possible to interview Mrs. Ackerman for further information in this regard until February 12, 1950, at which time she was interviewed by Agent Whitson and writer in the presence of General Ackerman at their flat located at 11 - 12 Campden Hill Gate, Duchess of Bedford Walk, London, England. As already mentioned in General Ackerman's cable, Mrs. Ackerman attended the hearing of

Subject through arrangements previously made by Ronald Howe, Assistant Commissioner of New Scotland Yard. Feeling that the Hearing was progressing rather slowly and being in an unknown neighborhood, she passed a note to Lord Portal asking him to have lunch with her, to which he agreed by a smile of acceptance and nodding. She accordingly met Lord Portal in the hall of the Bow Street Magistrate's Court and they then both went to lunch at a restaurant in that neighborhood. During the course of the lunch they naturally discussed the case, at which time Lord Portal gave his views regarding the progress of the proceedings and made the remarks already contained in General Ackerman's cable.

During the course of the conversation which led up to the remarks concerning the FBI and contained in General Ackerman's cable, they discussed FUCHS' contact in Boston, Massachusetts, which was brought up during the hearing, and it was at this time that Lord Portal confidentially informed her that Subject FUCHS had visited his sister in Boston and that his sister is married to a member of the Communist Party. Lord Portal also confidentially informed her that, when Subject FUCHS was in Los Alamos, he went to Santa Fe to make contacts. (It is to be noted that Subject's contacts in Santa Fe and the fact that his sister is married to a member of the Communist Party were not brought out at the public hearing of Subject FUCHS on that day.)

Mrs. Ackerman further states that she then asked Lord Portal why the British did not watch men with such known backgrounds, which the Public Prosecutor explained at some length in the charge, and Lord Portal replied that the British have a system which is shared with America that they either recommend or do not recommend an employee and that, if this employee is later sent to America in connection with atomic energy work, he is accepted by America as being fully recommended. Mrs. Ackerman states that she was unable to understand this procedure and, consequently, was unable to further elaborate in this regard, or furnish any useful information from which some conclusion could be drawn.

Lord Portal also confidentially informed Mrs. Ackerman that there is a "terrific sex angle" in this case, involving a woman

this woman and Subject Fuchs were carrying on for some time together. Mrs. Ackerman was likewise unable to furnish any further information regarding this statement, particularly as to the possible identity of the woman to whom he referred. (It is considered likely that this may refer to

The conversation later turned to Subject FUCHS' possible contacts, both here (England) and in the United States and it was at this point that Lord Portal confidentially informed Mrs. Ackerman that Subject FUCHS has not been very helpful, as he has not furnished any names or identified any of his contacts, but that "they" (presumably meaning authorities, according to Mrs. Ackerman) would find more people here (England) and in America. It was after this that Lord Portal, according to Mrs. Ackerman, voluntarily and unsolicited by her made his comments regarding the FRI in stating that he "did not think the Faderal Bureau of Investigation is doing anything." Mrs. Ackerman states that she defended the FRI and when she asked him whether he meant that the FRI are not or just haven't produced any results yet, Lord Portal replied:
"There have been no results. We are all disappointed in them." In addition thereto, Lord Portal asked Mrs. Ackerman not to repeat these comments for fear that they might get back to the FBI.

Mrs. Ackerman states that this was the extent of their conversation regarding the FBI and she was of the impression that Lord Portal did not know that the FBI had representatives in this country. She also was of the impression that Lord Portal knew a lot about this case. She was unable to explain Lord Portal's criticism of the FBI but, as indicated above, apparently referred to the inability of the FBI in determining the identity of Subject FUCHS' contacts in America. She stated that she was again having lunch with Lord Portal on February 15, 1950, and at this time she would again discreetly question Lord Portal in this regard and advise writer.

On the following day, February 13, discreet and guarded inquiries were made of MI-5 and New Scotland Yard with the view to determining the extent of Lord Portal's knowledge of the facts in this case. Mr. Richard White, who is the head of the Security Investigative Division of MI-5, was questioned but he was reticent in making any comments or engaging in any conversation regarding Lord Portal or his knowledge of the case. He did indicate, however, that the investigative details of this case were not furnished other agencies in the British Government but that the necessary evidence was, of course, discussed with the Public Prosecutor. Mr. John Marriott, Chief of the Espionage Section of MI-5, was also discreetly and guardedly questioned by Agent Whitson and he like wise refrained from discussing Lord Portal. He did comment that sufficient


