The supplemental contains a list of Amtorg employees, among which is listed THOMAS SWAN, Translator, address unknown.

Report of SA CHARLES F. BULLARD, dated December 5, 1944, at Washington, D. C., "SGPC. IS--R," on page 55, contains information received from C-369, reflecting that T. SMAN was in Room 220, extension 181, Industrial Installations Department, of the SGPC, 3355 16th Street, Northwest. (It is to be noted that T. SWAN left Washington, D. C., in September, 1944, according to the records of the Kaywood Gardens apartments.)

Mr. SACHS, records indicated the SWANS came from 2017 Park Road, Northwest, and prior thereto lived at 3025 15th Street, Northwest. References were given as Woodward and Lothrop, Department Store, and Mr. and Mrs. I. SHULMAN, Rupont 3521. The bank was listed as Riggs National Bank, and no forwarding address was given by the SWANS when theyleft. According to Mr. SACHS, IRVING O. STROMPH, Apartment 2, 4308 Russell Avenue, was the only individual living there at the time of the SWANS, residence.

Inquiry at the Mt. Rainier Post Office revealed a change of address card reflecting 41-15 45th Street, Sunnyside, Long Island, New York, as the SWANS! forwarding address.

The T. SHULMAN, reference given by the SWANS, has been identified as IRVING ISADCR SHULMAN, typographical engineer, Geological Survey, Department of the Interior, and one whose name was on a list of persons alleged to have transferred to the Communist Party Underground from the Communist Party, in Washington, D. C.

The background information concerning the SWAMS has been set forth in this letter for the benefit of the Boston Office.

This investigation is pending in this office and is receiving continuous and preferred attention.







She stated that she does not know where he was employed while he was in Chicago, but does recall that during the greater part of the time he leased the apartment he was in the armed Services of the United States. 74

MISS GERTRUDE FRIEDMAN, Provus Brothers, 815 South Wabash, Chicago, advised that she has never seen a photograph of ROBBINS. She stated that ROBBINS, while residing in Chicago was employed with relatives in the building trades in the vicinity of Gary, Indiana. She said that he had no employment during this period of time in Chicago.

MISS FRIEDMAN added she had no information as to where a photograph of ROBBINS might be obtained.
