- When we say there is a crisis, this is not a tactic. Frankly, we need \$4,150.00 this week. Usually our expenses are \$3,500.00 a week. We need \$1200 for the payroll and we must give the printer \$8000. Our normal income is now \$1,000 a week, or a deficit of at least \$3500. We have certain sources where we usually borrow until the big income comes after January 1, but we have exhausted these sources. \$25,000 nationally, \$10,000 from NY, is needed immediately.
