Don Wheeldin acted as Master of Ceremonies and introduced all the speakers. Margaret Burnham, who is an attorney with the Angela Defense Committee gave a very long tsike about the Angela Davis case. There some other speakers and then Frank Wilkinson gave a very long impassioned speech to plead for money for the Peoples World. Women were stacioned in all parts of the room to collect money and pledges. Don Wheeldin took over and announced the large amounts of money first along with the names of the donors. The lesser amounts and the donors were then announced. This took forty five minutes or longer.

Norton Sobell was the last to speak and received a standing ovation. He gave a very talk about his experiences in different prisons and made some very pointed comments but all in a very low key, and very interesting.

When the meeting was adjourned, Don Wheeldin announced that the pitch had brought in \$8000.00 and he thanked everyone.

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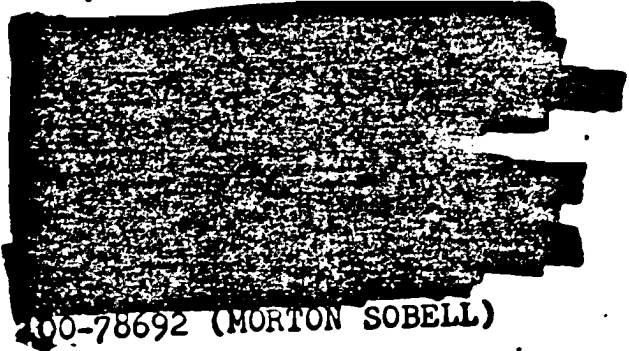

**PEOPLE'S PETITION DEMANDING BAIL FOR ANGELA DAVIS**

To: the Honorable Judges of the Appellate Courts for the State of California, the Federal Courts and for World Opinion.

**WE, THE PEOPLE, DO HEREBY DEMAND THE FREEDOM OF ANGELA Y. DAVIS ON REASONABLE BAIL PENDING TRIAL.**

Angela Davis was refused bail on June 15, 1971, by Judge Richard Arnason, Contra Costa Superior Court Judge.

We, the people, feel that the denial of bail to Angela Y. Davis is a further example of the increasing refusal of the judicial system to grant Miss Davis a fair trial.

The Court's excuse for not granting bail was "purely legal", according to Judge Arnason. Yet today Lt. William Colley walks in virtual freedom after being convicted of murdering 22 Vietnamese civilians. Stan Duke, Black sportscaster for CBS-TV, was released on \$50,000 while awaiting trial in Los Angeles on the capital charge of murder.

The people demand to know why it is against the law for Angela Davis to be granted bail? Is it because she is a black woman, a member of the Communist Party, a consistent fighter for the freedom of all Political Prisoners?

We submit, finally, that it is the grossest kind of denial of equal protection and due process for Miss Davis to be held in punitive detention while awaiting trial.

**WE, THE PEOPLE, THEREFORE DEMAND THE IMMEDIATE FREEDOM OF ANGELA Y. DAVIS ON REASONABLE BAIL.**
