Dear Mr. Sobell:

This will acknowledge the recent letters from you and your wife which were received on March 25th. This letter will respond only to the portions of your requests which concern records of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Copies of your requests were furnished to the Office of the Deputy Attorney General, Department of Justice, on April 3rd. You will receive a separate reply from the Department. With regard to your request for records of other Government agencies and bureaus, you should correspond directly with those agencies concerning those records.

As you may be aware, the FBI presently has under consideration requests from other individuals for access to our files concerning the investigation of Ethel and Julius Rosenberg and others who were involved in this and related investigations. A review of the voluminous records concerning these cases was initiated in response to earlier requests. We have encountered many complex and troublesome problems in attempting to resolve questions of invasion of the personal privacy of other individuals who were the subjects of our investigation, as well as the numerous persons who cooperated with this Bureau and with the Department of Justice in the investigation and prosecution of these cases. Additionally, some portions of our investigation consist of information furnished by individuals with express assurances of confidentiality or under circumstances where such assurances may reasonably be inferred.

The recently amended Freedom of Information Act, Title 5, United States Code, Section 552, specifically exempts from required disclosure information from investigatory records which, if disclosed, would constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of an individual or disclose the identity of, or information furnished by, a confidential source.

In order to ascertain if any records contained in our files could be disclosed consistent with the other applicable exemptions of the Freedom of Information Act, we will initiate a review of our files along the lines of your requests.

As you can imagine, our records concerning this case and the related investigations are voluminous. A page-by-page review is necessary before a release of documents can be made. Because of the large number of records involved, our present backlog of other requests, and the legal and factual difficulties in applying the exemptions of the Act, it is anticipated a considerable length of time will be required to accomplish this review. We will undertake this project in the near future and will keep you advised of our progress on a regular basis. You may be assured that your request is being processed as expeditiously as possible under the circumstances.

In regard to the allegations in your letters of illegal activities by the FBI, I wish to assure you that this Bureau has not in the past nor does it now engage in the activities alluded to in your letters, and has no control over ordinary treatment accorded prisoners incarcerated in Federal penal institutions.

NOTE: Morton Sobell, who was charged and convicted in connection with the Rosenberg investigation, has requested all records concerning him and his wife contained in our files. Mr. Sobell's wife also joined in the request. This response is consistent with our response to the Meeropol children, sons of the Rosenbergs. This matter is being closely coordinated with the handling of the request by Professor Allen Weinstein for the Rosenberg files, which is presently in litigation, in order to insure any release of documents does not prejudice the pending litigation.
