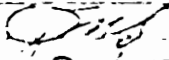

Mr. PAUL ELSSION, reference, Supervisor, Personnel Department, Du Pont Company, Wilmington, Delaware, advised that DAVID BLOOM's services with the Du Pont Company were terminated on April 30, 1947, as a result of a reduction in force. The subject was employed as a designer in the Engineering Department of the Du Pont Company.

II. COMMUNIST AFFILIATIONS AND ACTIVITIES:

Confidential Informant T-2 on November 21, 1944, furnished applications for membership in the Daily Worker Press Club, obtained from the Tom Paine Bookshop, Communist Political Association Headquarters in Wilmington, Delaware. Among the applications was noted the following:

"HILARIO BLOOM, Arden, R.F.D. 4, Wilmington, Del."

Confidential Informant T-3 advised that it was his belief that the Political Action Committee of Arden, Delaware, was synonymous with the Arden Club of the Communist Party, inasmuch as the subject, DAVID, was considered an active member in both organizations. (2/20/46)

The same informant on January 30, 1947, reported that the subject, DAVID, attended a meeting of the Communist Party Executive Committee, Wilmington, Delaware, held at the home of EDWARD MURKIN, 514 B. 10th Street, Wilmington, Del., on January 27, 1947. According to the informant, the subject at the meeting nominated EDWARD MURKIN for the post of Educational Director.

Confidential Informant T-4 advised that DAVID BLOOM was Executive Secretary of the Progressive Citizens of America of Wilmington, Del., and active in the Political Action Committee. The informant stated that he believed the subject was a Communist, although he had no proof.

It was ascertained from Confidential Informant T-5 that DAVID BLOOM had collected P.C.A. plays given at Arden, Delaware, and attended what the informant believed were Communist Party meetings at the home of EDWARD MURKIN, Arden, Delaware. The informant also advised that DAVID BLOOM had returned to Arden during the Fall of 1948.

On February 19, 1947, Confidential Informant T-12 reported that DAVID BLOOM had expressed himself in favor of establishing a White Collar Section of the Communist Party in the Wilmington area.

III. MISCELLANEOUS:

An article appearing in the WILMINGTON DELAWARE NEWS, on March 14, 1946, reflected that DAVID BLOOM had presided as Chairman at a meeting of the Arden Citizens' P.W.C., on the previous evening. The meeting adopted resolutions concerning the then recent speech of WILSON CHURCHILL at Fulton, Missouri, and President Truman's participation in the program with CHURCHILL. The meeting also recommended full support of continuance of O.P.A. for the ensuing year.

Stop notices have been placed by the El Paso Office with the USINS at El Paso as well as U. S. Customs Service at El Paso. Stops were also placed with the five airline concerns in El Paso.

It was pointed out by the officials of the Immigration Service that persons departing from the United States are not processed by the USINS; however, various airline concerns at the time a person purchases a ticket for abroad will usually ascertain if the person is in possession of the proper travel documents.

The Quarterly Report of Subversive Activities in the United States dated November 15, 1940, Vol. II, page 489 and 490, reflects that the name of one JOHN MURRAY was among a list of officers of the National Maritime Union listed by WILLIAM C. McCUISTON, a Dies Committee witness, as Communists or "Fellow Travelers." This occurred during November, 1939, when he testified before that Committee relative to Communist control of the National Maritime Union. It is not known whether or not this person is identical with the subject.

On November 2, 1949, a letter was received from one HAL SPRAGUE, Sprague's Tractor Service, Palmoxas, Texas, in which he enclosed a newspaper clipping advertisement of the Jake Aronov Auto Parts and Tire Company, Department R, 101 Bell Street, Montgomery, Alabama. It was indicated that SPRAGUE had ordered tires from the firm and had not heard from them. No action taken concerning the matter by the El Paso Office and the clipping was returned to SPRAGUE. The name of JAKE ARONOV is similar to the employer of the subject JACOB ARONOW. No other information appears in the files.

In view of the above, this matter is being considered Referred Upon Completion.

On February 13, 1951, de SVESHNIKOFF was located at his present residence, 1607 17th Street, N.W. He declined to be interviewed or examine any photographs. He alleged that he had lost his job because of the FBI and, therefore, did not desire to have any other contact with the FBI. de SVESHNIKOFF stated that in the event the government desired any information from him, he expected to be paid the same fee as given an expert consultant. He also reported he intended to discuss the matter with his attorney.

It is to be noted that on September 14, 1950, de SVESHNIKOFF was permitted to resign his position as a Chemist at the Engineering Research and Development Laboratory, Fort Belvoir, Virginia, after the military had determined that he was a security risk.

de SVESHNIKOFF, a Security Index subject in this office, exhibited an uncooperative, belligerent and antagonistic attitude. He was advised that he was not obligated to enter into any discussion with representatives of the FBI.

On February 14, 1951, de SVESHNIKOFF telephonically contacted this office and advised that he had been ill the preceding day and that he was willing to be interviewed providing the interview took place in the office of his attorney, one FRANK KELLY, who has an office in the Investment Building, Washington, D. C. Subsequently, de SVESHNIKOFF advised that he would prefer to be interviewed at the University Club at 1165 16th Street, N.W.

II. AFFILIATION WITH THE COMMUNIST MOVEMENT

A. Communist Party Membership

The following signed statement was obtained by SA VIC. OF IDEN from [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] make this statement voluntarily of my own free will to Victor Iuryn, who identified himself and is known to me as a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. 1-2, of known reliability, stated [redacted] that he believed the subject to be a member of the Queens County Communist Party at that time.

[REDACTED] submitted to the New York FBI Office an unclaimed suitcase which he advised had been left in his store on or about September 1, 1949. Contained in this suitcase was a list of the petition canvassers for the Election Campaign Committee of the Communist Party in 1949 campaign for the re-election of BENJAMIN J. DAVIS, Jr., Communist candidate for councilman, City of New York. This list of canvassers contained the following: "CLAUDE VAGO, 6607 99th Street, organization - CP Club."

B. Communist Party Sympathies

[REDACTED] contacted the New York Office of the FBI and stated that she had information regarding possible Communist infiltration of the Parent-Teacher Association of Public School 157, Queens, New York.

[REDACTED] for several months prior to her appearance at the FBI Office there had been a certain amount of dissension among the members and they had split into two factions. She added that this dissension had been instigated by a "leftist" group in the association.

The first real evidence of this trouble occurred during the Spring of 1950 at which time a mimeographed sheet of paper urging the defeat of the Mundt-Nixon Bill was circulated at a meeting. This paper contained, in part, the following:

".....there is Mundt-Nixon hysteria in our community. If the Mundt-Nixon Bill becomes law you can say goodbye to the Bill of Rights
.....this leaflet written by three Rego Park mothers and printed under the auspices of the American Labor Party of Rego Park, 63-62 Saunders Street."

[REDACTED] a nominating committee was designated in March, 1950, consisting of seven members, four of whom were of the "leftist" section. One of these four was a CLAUDE VAUGH who, she added, was of Hungarian extraction and whose husband was the distributor for the "Daily Worker" in the Forest Hills-Rego Park Section of Queens, New York.

The nominating committee nominated four officers and eight executive board members and then furnished the association members with a mimeographed sheet containing their selections and, in part, the following statements:

".....unfortunately the tensions and conflicts of party partisan, smears 'McCarthyism' has invaded without cause our PTA....."

[REDACTED] because of the aforementioned incidents she suspected CLAUDE VAUGH to be of Communist affiliation or sympathy.

The American Labor Party is "among those organizations that are victims of Communist domination." (California Committee on Un-American Activities, Report 1948, pages 40 and 41.)

The records of the Queens County Board of Elections as checked by ST WILLIAM F. SWENNEY on August 31, 1953, disclosed that the subject and her husband while at 6607 99th Street registered American Labor Party from 1941 through 1949 inclusive and in 1951. In 1950 there was no record for either and in 1952 there was no record for her husband but the subject again registered American Labor Party that year.

On February 25, 1952, 1-4, of known reliability, stated that the subject was receiving "The Worker" as of January, 1950.

"The Worker" is the Sunday edition of the "Daily Worker", an East Coast Communist newspaper.

1-3, of known reliability, supplied the information that Mrs. CLARE VACC, 6607 99th Street, Rego Park, Queens, New York, sent a communication to Federal Judge HAROLD R. MELLON, Southern District of New York, United States Court House, Foley Square, New York, protesting the trial of the 11 Communist leaders in New York in 1949.

These 11 Communist leaders were convicted in Federal District Court, Southern District of New York under the Smith Act of 1940 in that they advocated the violent overthrow of the government of the United States.

The Bureau of Special Services and Investigation records disclose that the subject signed a Communist Party Nominating Petition in 1943.

C. Miscellaneous Communist Party Activities

1-5, 1-6, 1-7, 1-8, 1-9 and 1-10, all of known reliability, advised that they could not supply any information regarding the subject.

III. FALSE STATEMENTS

When the subject and her husband registered for the American Labor Party in 1941 they both stated they had resided in the State of New York for 15 years, in the County of Queens for four years and in the election district for five months.

When they registered for the American Labor Party in 1951 they stated they had resided in the State of New York, City of New York and election district for ten years.

IV. MISCELLANEOUS

Bureau of Special Services and Investigation records reflect that there is no record for the subject at the New York State Bureau of Motor Vehicles nor is there any record in the New York City Police Department criminal files.

The records of the Credit Bureau of Greater New York as checked by ST. MICHAEL A. O'HARA on September 6, 1953, reflect that in a report prepared on November 25, 1947, the subject and her husband were then residing at 6607 99th Street, Queens, New York, and had formerly resided at 4117 North 4th Street, Arlington, Virginia, and 6325 Luzon Avenue, Northwest, Washington, D.C., dates not indicated. Her husband was then age 49 and they had a son age nine and a daughter age two. Her husband was employed as treasurer of A. Brothman and Associates, 2928 41st Avenue, Long Island City, New York.

These Credit Bureau files indicated that as of August, 1941 he was employed as a civil engineer with Felcheimer and Wagner, 155 East 42nd Street, New York City, and prior to that was employed with the Federal Works Agency in Washington, D.C.

A. Relatives

On September 20, 1950, the subject's husband appeared before a Grand Jury in the Southern District of New York in response to a subpoena. He testified that

he did not leave the United States until December 3, 1932, at which time he was accompanied by his wife. He returned to the United States on January 12, 1933. b3

On September 26, 1950, he was indicted for perjury concerning this testimony and was arrested by agents of this office on the same date. Rule 6E CFR

On June 20, 1952, he was found guilty by Federal Judge SYLVESTER J. RYAN, United States District Judge, who sentenced him to three years suspended sentence and placed him on probation for three years.

This case is being reopened under the program of investigating all individuals included in the Communist Index in the NYO.

The following minimum investigative steps must be taken:

1. Review file and all pertinent references thoroughly.
2. Contact informants, sources and defected Communists who could be expected to know the subject. Contact for evidence of current activity and also for the sources' evaluation of potential dangerousness.
3. Determine residence and employment. Check against the key facilities and classified contractors lists to insure full and complete dissemination is made. Submit Form FD-129 if the subject has moved to a new field division.
4. If the subject has been a CP drop or ceased activity suddenly, develop information to show the reason. Many of these drops are purely on the basis of theoretical and intellectual differences. The convictions of the persons involved remain unchanged in their hard-core devotion to the principles of international Communism, waiting only for what they consider to be a more favorable climate within ruling Communist circles. It should also be borne in mind constantly that unexplained cessation of Communist activity by a subject may well be based upon a contemplated assignment in espionage or illegal underground activity.
5. Consider interview or reinterview without regard to prior interview results. Bear in mind the Khrushchev revelations of terror under Stalin, anti-Semitism in the Soviet Union and the Hungarian revolt.
6. Secure a current description.

These cases must be given expeditious attention since it will be our responsibility to fully handle the approximately 4232 cases on individuals included in the Communist Index.

In the event reports are submitted in this case, the cover letter (or cover pages) should have the additional caption "Communist Index" after the title.

**CHICAGO COMMITTEE TO DEFEND DEMOCRATIC RIGHTS,
formerly known as the Chicago Joint Defense
Committee to Defeat the Smith Act**

A source advised on April 15, 1958, that the Chicago Joint Defense Committee to Defeat the Smith Act (CJDC) was formed by the Communist Party (CP) in March, 1956.

A second source advised on July 17, 1958, that at a working conference of the CJDC held on June 8, 1958, at Chicago, the name of the CJDC was changed to the Chicago Committee to Defend Democratic Rights (CCDDR). The purpose of the CCDDR, according to its "Statement of Principles and Organization", is to ". . . defend and extend the human rights embodied in the Bills of Rights. . . and to put an end to the political and racial persecutions which threaten American democracy today." Officers of the CCDDR elected at this conference were Chairman, LEON KATZEN, and "paid Executive Secretary", RICHARD CRILEY, both of whom were officers of the CJDC. As of May, 1959, this organization continued to function within the framework of its stated principles. Working committees affiliated with the CCDDR in 1958 and 1959, in accordance with the CCDDR's Statement of Principles and Organization, included a welfare committee for the families of Smith Act victims and a committee to work for Taft-Hartley defendants.

LEON KATZEN was identified by a third source as a member of the CP in March, 1959.

RICHARD CRILEY, according to a fourth source, as of March, 1959, was a member of the Illinois CP State Committee.

The CP, USA has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order #10450.

On 5/9/60 the 2nd source revealed information which indicated that the Chicago Smith Act Families Committee is an affiliate of the CCDDR

This Reserve Index case is being reopened to conduct the following investigation:

1. Verify residence and employment.
2. Conduct an indices search and file review to determine whether investigation is warranted at this time or whether an interview with the individual is deemed desirable.
3. If additional investigation is conducted or if there is unreported information of a subversive nature contained in the files, a report must be submitted.

Designate for Section A of the Reserve Index those individuals whose subversive activities do not bring them within the Security Index criteria but who, in a time of national emergency, are in a position to influence others against the national interest or are likely to furnish material financial aid to subversive elements due to their subversive associations and ideologies.

Included in Section A will be those individuals falling within the following categories:

1. Professors, teachers and educators.
2. Labor union organizers or leaders.
3. Writers, lecturers, newsmen, entertainers and others in the mass media field.
4. Lawyers, doctors and scientists.
5. Other potentially influential persons on a local or national level.
6. Individuals who could potentially furnish material financial aid.

Forms will be available to recommend the inclusion of the individual's name in Section A of the Reserve Index. These forms will contain a succinct summary, setting forth the basis for recommendation. If no report accompanies the recommendation, a statement to that effect should appear on the page containing the succinct summary. Investigations of individuals listed in Section A are to be brought up to date annually and they are to be considered for Security Index status or retention in the Reserve Index. Changes in residence and employment will be submitted to the Bureau.

The administrative handling of the reopening of these cases will be similar to that in the case of annual reports on SI subjects. Section B of the Reserve Index will be the names of the remaining individuals in the Reserve Index who are not in Section A.

The revised standards for inclusion of names in the Reserve Index are:

1. Membership in a basic revolutionary organization subsequent to January 1, 1949, together with some indication of sympathy or association with such an organization or a subversive front organization subsequent to the reported membership and no reliable evidence of defection.
2. Investigation has failed to substantiate allegations of membership in a revolutionary organization within the past five years, coupled with some evidence or information indicating activity, association or sympathy for the subversive cause within the same period, and no reliable evidence of defection.
3. The individual, within the past five years, by his associations, writings, financial support or conduct in relation to and support of subversive organizations or the international communist movement is in a position to influence others at the time of a national emergency and no reliable evidence of defection.
4. Leadership or substantial activities in a major subversive front group over three years ago, together with some evidence of continuing activity, association or sympathy for the subversive cause within three years and no reliable evidence of defection.
5. Membership in a subversive front organization within the past three years and no reliable evidence of defection..

In handling this case the Agent should insure that the description appearing on the Reserve Index card is correct and should complete a form NY 125. Every closing memo, letter or report should be routed to the SI Unit with NY 125 attached.

Subject's name & address appeared as a contributor of \$1.00 to "New World Review", 7/56; as a parent of a child whose name appeared on an undated questionnaire of Camp Kinderland-Lakeland; as a contributor of \$2.00 to Chicago Committee to Defend Democratic Rights. [REDACTED]

Subject's past association with GOLD and BROTHMAN has previously been reported in detail. SCHNEIR is writing a book on GOLD and desires to talk with all previous acquaintances of GOLD. The name VAGO appeared in notebook maintained by ROSE WEINSTOCK on 6/28/60. Whether it is identical with subject and the nature of listing is unknown. It is felt that above information does not warrant inclusion on RI and there is no pertinent, unreported, subversive information.

MISCELLANEOUS: No recommendation is being made to interview subject due to lack of recent CP activity and the fact that Bureau agents previously arrested subject in a perjury matter wherein he was convicted on 6/20/52 and sentenced to three years suspended sentence and placed on probation for same period. It is felt subject would not be inclined to cooperate with the FBI. [REDACTED]
