Kinoy resides at 266 West End Avenue, New York, New York and is employed by the law firm of Kuntsler and Kuntsler, 511 Fifth Avenue, New York, New York, He is also an Instructor at the Rutgers University Law School, Newark, New Jersey.

Kinoy is described as a white, male, American, 45 years old, 5'4", 125 pounds, black hair and brown eyes. He is married to Susan Knopf Kinoy.

The records of the Passport Office, Department of State, reflect that Kinoy was issued Passport Number G 632703 on June 3, 1966, for travel to England, Scotland, Italy and Greece for the purpose of pleasure and tourism. Kinoy indicated he planned on leaving the United States on June 17, 1966, for six weeks and planned on traveling by ship and plane.

A source advised on June 18, 1956, that Kinoy is currently the attorney for the Committee to Secure Justice-for Morton Sobel (CSJMS).

A characterization of the CSJMS appears in the Appendix Section.

A second source revealed on March 16, 1966, that Kinoy was the attorney for the W.E.B. Du Bois Clubs of America (DCA).

A characterization of the DCA appears in the Appendix Section.

A third source on August 5, 1964, revealed that Arthur Kinoy at that time was Vice President of the National Lawyers Guild (NLG).

Arthur Kinoy was one of the petitioners in an Amicus Curiae Brief filed on February 6, 1950, by a number of attorneys with the Court of Appeals, Second Circuit, in connection with the appeal of the attorneys who represented the Communist Party (CP) leaders in their trial in 1949.

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The above sources have all furnished reliable information in the past.


COMMITTEE TO SECURE JUSTICE FOR MORTON SOBELL

"Following the execution of atomic spies ETHEL and JULIUS ROSENBERG in June, 1953, the 'Communist campaign assumed a different emphasis. Its major effort centered upon MORTON SOBEL', the ROSENBERGS' codefendant. The National Committee to Secure Justice in the Resemberg Case - a Communist front which had been conducting the campaign in the United States - was reconstituted as the National Rosenberg - Sobell Committee at a conference in Chicago in October, 1953, and 'then the National Committee to Secure Justice for Morton Sobell in the Rosenberg Case'..."

The "Guide to Subversive Organizations and Publications," revised and published as of December 1, 1961, prepared and released by the Committee on Un-American Activities, United States House of Representatives, Washington, D.C., contains the following concerning the National Lawyers Guild:

- "1. Cited as a Communist front.

Cited as a Communist front which 'is the foremost legal bulwark of the Communist Party, its front organizations, and controlled unions' and which 'since its inception has never failed to rally to the legal defense of the Communist Party and individual members thereof, including known espionage agents.'

- "3. 'To defend the cases of Communist lawbreakers, fronts have been devised making special appeals in behalf of civil liberties and reaching out far beyond the confines of the Communist Party itself.

  Among these organizations are the \* \* National Lawyers Guild. When the Communist Party itself is under fire these offer a bulwark of protection.'

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




A second source has advised that the founding convention for the new youth organization was held from June 19-21, 1964, at 150 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, California, at which time the name W. E. B. DuBois Clubs of America (DCA) was adopted. Approximately 500 delegates from throughout the United States attended this convention. The aims of this organization, as set forth in the preamble to the constitution are, "It is our belief that this nation can best solve its problems in an atmosphere of peaceful coexistence, complete disarmament and true freedom for all peoples of the world, and that these solutions will be reached mainly through the united efforts of all democratic elements in our country, composed essentially of the working people allied in the unity of Negroes and other minorities with whites. We further fully recognize that \_the greatest threat to American democracy comes from the racist and right wing forces in coalition with the most reactionary sections of the economic power structure, using the tool of anti-Communism to divide and destroy the unified struggle of the working people."

Over the Labor Day weekend, 1965, the DCA held a conference in Chicago, Illinois, and a new slate of officers was elected to the National Executive Committee (NEC) of the DCA. Since Labor Day, 1965, identities of those serving on the NEC has varied; however, according to a third source as of May, 1966, thirteen of the fifteen members of the NEC were members of the CP in the San Francisco Bay area.

As of May, 1966, the headquarters of the DCA was located at 1830 Fell Street, San Francisco, California.

Sobell, born July 30, 1894, in Russia, listed her permanent residence as 142 Laurel Hill Terrace, New York, New York. Her occupation was given as housewife. She listed her parents as Michael Pasternak and Ida Chanam, both of whom were born in Russia. Neither of her parents are United States citizens.

While in conference on other investigative matters with Mr. ASHLEY J. NICHOLAS, of the Fraud Section of the Passport Division of the Department of State, the latter furnished Special Agent LOUIS LOEBL with the following information which is believed will be of interest to the Bureau in connection with its Key Figure program inasmich as it relates to members of the Communist Party whose transportation to Russia in 1935 and thereabouts was handled by the World Tourists agency in New York City and charged to accounts of the Communist Party:

During the winter of 1939-40, in connection with the investigation of passport frauds committed by EARLIBROWDER and other leading Communists, the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York at New York City, at the request of the State Department, subpoensed the records of the World Tourists, Inc., a travel agency which had been established about 1927-under Communist auspices. At the time the records of the World Tourists, Inc., were thus obtained JOSEPH ERODSKY was the president of the corporation, CHILIBIL WARSZOWER, alias WILLIAM WEINER, alias A. PLAKE, was vice-president, and JACCERRAISIN, alias J. N. POLOS, was general manager. In questioning witnesses for the grand jury it was ascertained that the accounts of the World Tourists' books in the name A. BLAKE, PRIMOFF, PRIMOFF STUDENTS and TRADE UNION UNITY LEAGUE DELEGATES were actually the occupants of the Communist Party.

DELEGATES ACCOUNT (73 names), together with brief summaries of the information reflected in the Passport files of most of the individuals referred to in the accounts. Mr. NICHOLAS also advised that the Passport Division has in its files photostatic copies of the travel orders and of the ledgers covering the account relating to each person, as well as negatives of the photographs of the persons mentioned in the various accounts, all of which information and material can be made available to the Bureau for perusal.

In connection with the above information there are transmitted herewith two copies of each of the above-mentioned accounts for any disposition the Bureau desires to make with respect thereto. The Washington Field Division did not keep copies of these accounts.

Besides PRINOFF and WARSZOWER the principal contact man of the Communist Party with the World Tourists, Inc., was WAX KITZES, the auditor of the Communist Party who used the alias A. BENSON. "Following the execution of atomic spies Ethel and Julius Rosenberg, in June, 1953, the 'Communist campaign assumed a different emphasis. Its major effort centered upon Morton Sobell, the Rosenbergs' codefendant. The National Committee to Secure Justice in the Rosenberg-Case-a Communist front which had been conducting the campaign in the United States - was reconstituted as the National Rosenberg - Sobell Committee at a conference in Chicago in October, 1953, and then the National Committee to Secure Justice for Morton Sobell in the Rosenberg Case'..."

In September, 1954, the name "National Committee to Secure Justice for Morton Sobell" appeared on literature issued by the Committee. In March, 1955, the current name, "Committee to Secure Justice for Morton Sobell" first appeared on literature issued by the Committee.

# NATIONAL COMMITTEE TO ABOLISH THE HOUSE UN-AMERICAN ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE

The "Guide to Subversive Organizations and Publications" issued December 1, 1961, by the House Committee on Un-American Activities, page 115, contains the following citation regarding the National Committee to Abolish the Un-American Activities Committee (NCAUAC).

"Cited as a 'new organization' set up in the Summer of 1960 to lead and direct the Communist Party's 'Operation Abolition' campaign. Seven of the national leaders of this group have been identified as Communists".

A source has advised that the NCAUAC changed its name to include the word "House" in its name, thereby becoming known as the National Committee to Abolish the House Un-American Activities Committee (NCAHUAC).

A second source advised on June 28, 1965, that as of that date the NCAHUAC continued to function with headquarters at 555 North Western Avenue, Los Angeles, California.



The file contained a memorandum dated March 4, 1938 which reflected that subject was issued passport number 186472 on March 13, 1920 upon an application in which he stated he was born at Kremnitz, Russia on February 18, 1896 and that he desired to travel to Cuba on commercial business.

Subject's occupation at the time of his 1920 application was shown as chemist and it was further reflected that he was under consideration for employment by the Cubano-Guano Corporation, Woolworth Building, New York City. The memorandum further reflected that the identifying witness on the subject's 1929 passport application MAX XITZES had figured in a number of fraudulent passports of Communist origin. It was recommended in the memorandum that any future application for passport made by the subject be investigated before the issuance of the passport and accordingly a refusal notice was placed in the subject's file on March 23, 1938.

The 1920 application for passport was reviewed and disclosed that the subject emigrated to the United States from Hamburg, Germany in December of 1906; resided in this country at 458 East 179th Street, New York City; and that he intended sailing from Key West, Florida, March 20, 1920. The usual affidavit of identifying witness was supplied for the 1920 passport application by BENJAMIN J. ROBIN, attorney, 332 East 17th Street, New York City, who stated that he had known the subject 10 years.



NICHOLAS - advised that to the best of his recollection, no investigation was conducted concerning JOSET - BYAT, TLIAS SHAFIRD, or SOCIA DOBES.

The file on IITVACKOFF contained the following information concerning those individuals:

JOSEPH HIAT was the identifying witness on the passport application filed under the name of NATHAN ROSENHERG and dated May 10, 1937. This up liketion shows HIAT's address as 19 hast 16th St., New York City. In executing this application, ROSENHERG requested the State Department to smill the passport to him, care of SHAFIRO, 186 Ft. Washington Ave., New York City.

Concerning JOLEPH HIAT, a report dated November 6, 1939 reflects that a State Department Investigator conducted an investigation at 19 East 16th St., New York City in an effort to locate HIAT. However, persons at that address reported that no such person ever lived there and such a person was not known at that undress. Inquiry at the post office was also made of without success. This was apparently the extent of the investigation conducted to locate the identifying witness to the passport application.

Three photostatic copies of the passport application of MATRA ROSELFER dated May 10, 1937, on which the name of JOSEFH PIAT appears as the identifying witness, are being enclosed for the Bureau and the May York Division in accordance with instructions in reflet.

With regard to ELIAS SHAPIRO, the above-mentioned file contains the following information:

In a passport application dated July 1, 1938, SEAPIRO advised that he was been July 2, 1810 in Kartuz-Berezer, Gredno, Russia, and he emigrated to the United States July 9, 1901. He was naturalized in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York on Nevember 16, 1909. He gave his residence as 266 Ft. Washington Ave., New York City. This application reflects that his father, SCHACHNO YOSSEL SHAFIRO, was born in Russia and resided at Kartuz-Rerezer, Russia, (now Poland). SHAFIRO applied for a passport to go to France, England, and Poland for a vacation. The identifying witness on this application was PELEN STAWSKY, 1603 Macombs Road, Bronx, New York. SHAFIRO was described as five feet, five inches; brown bair-graying; blue eyes; occupation— dentist. Passport No. 565675 was issued to SHAFIRO on July 7, 1935.

Mr. NICHOIAS! records reflect that SHAPIRO's proposed trip was handled by World Tourists Inc., 175 5th Ave., New York City. One itinerary prepared by World Tourists shows that SHAPIRO was to leave itinerary prepared by World Tourists shows that SHAPIRO was to leave New York on the SS Aquitania on August 3, 1935 and go to Cherbourg, in France. From there he was to go to Warsaw, Poland. He was to leave Edymia, Poland September 7, 1938 and return to New York City via Southampton, England. The return trip was to be on the SS Aquitania also. Another itinerary prepared by World Tourists, Inc., reflects that SHAPIRO was to leave New York City August 3, 1936 on the SS Aquitania and proceed to Moscow via Southampton, London, Copenhagen, Stockholm, Helsingfors, and Leningrad. He was to spend August 15 and 16 in Leningrad and from August 17 to August 21 in Moscow. He was to go then to Poland where he would remain from August 22 to September 2 thereafter returning to New York City via Paris and Cherbourg, France.

Also contained in these records was what appeared to be a copy of an application for a noviet visa for METAS took IRO. This application as gives his date and place of birth as September 29, 1879 at Kartuz-Bereza, Crodno Gub, Poland. The father's name is shown as SHAKHMO TOSEL SHAPIRO.

SHAPIRO was described as a United States citizen whose occupation was that of a dentist. In this application, it was stated that SEAPIRO desired to make a pleasure trip to Russia; that it would be a seven-day tour-third class; and that he would srend the seven days in Leningrad and Mescow. This application also reflects that SPAFIRO was never a citizen of the USSR; that he left Kartur-Bereza as a student in 1901; that when he left he had a traist pass; ort enabling him to go to an aunt in America; and that he had relatives in the USSR, but their location was unknown. His point of entrance into the USSR was to be Leningrad and the point of exit was to be Negorelec. It was noted that by letter cated June 1h, 1930 addressed to SEAPIRC, he was advised by World Tourists, Inc., that he had been refused a Soviet visa and that there was nothing more World Tourists could do. This letter was signed by S. J. DOBB.

In the above-mentioned State Department Investigator's report dated November 6, 1939, there is contained the results of investigation conducted at 286 Ft. Washington Ave., New York City, in an effort to identify NATHAUSKOSTHEERG. During this investigation, it was ascertained that Dr. LIAS SMAPIRO, dentist, had been a tenant at that address for the tenant at that address for the tenant at six years and had been located in the neighborhood for 15 years. He was to be interviewed and recalled that about two years prior to the time the investigation was conducted, a man believed to be ROSEN FERG made, a short and unexplained visit to SHAPIRO. SMAPIRO was shown photographs of RCSENEERG and LITVACKOFF, and he stated he believed this was the man who visited him. He could not recall just what name the caller had used, but thought he used the name ROSEMBERG. This man told SHAPIRO he had come to New York City from Philadelphia where he was living; also that he originally came from a Kartuz-Bereua, Grodno, Poland, the place SHAPIRO came from. He said he and SHAPIRO had attended school together in Poland. ### Dr. ELIAS SHAPIRO

Reference is made to Bureau letter dated December 15, 1950, and Washington Field letter dated February 23, 1951, in the case entitled, "JOSEPHOKATZ, was., ESPIONAGE-R", in which there is set forth information pertaining to Dr. ELIAS SHAPIRO who lived at 286 Fort Washington Avenue, New York City. Information set out in these letters reflects that SHAPIRO was the designated addressee of a passport issued to ISAIAHOITVACKOFF under the name NATHAN ROSENBERG in 1937. LITVACKOFF's witness on this passport was JOSEFH HIAT, this name being an alias for JOSEPH KATZ who has been ascertained by investigation to be identical with ELIZAPETH BENTLEY's espionage principal, Jack".

Subsequent to his obtaining this passport, LITVACKOFF was convicted and served a prison sentence for passport fraud. Investigation conducted by the State Department brought out the fact that LITVACKOFF's transportation had been obtained through World Tourist, this having been the organization of which JACOB GOLOS was the head. The State Department file on LITVACKOFF contains the following information with regard to ELIAS SHAPIRO:

In a passport application dated July 1, 1938, SHAPIRO advised he was born July 29, 1830, in Kartuz-Berezer, Grodno, Russia. He emigrated to the United States July 9, 1901



and was naturalized in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York on November 16, 1909. SHAPIRO'S address was given as 286 Ft. Washington Avenue, New York City. In his passport application, SHAPIRO stated he wanted to go to France, England and Poland for a vacation. The identifying witness was HELEN STAWSKY, 1603 Macombs Road, Bronx, New York. SHAPIRO was described as follows:

Eyes: Blue
Occupation: Dentist

The State Department records further reflect that SHAPIRO's proposed trip was handled by World Tourist, Inc., New York City. One itinerary prepared by World Tourist showed that he was to leave the United States on the S.S. "Aquitania" on August 3, 1938, and go to Cherbourg, France, and then to Warsaw, Poland. He was to leave Gdynia, Poland, on September 7, 1938, and return to New York via Southampton. England, aboard the S.S. "Aquitania". Another itinerary prepared by World Tourist reflects he was to leave New York City on August 3, 1938, on the S.S. "Aquitania" and proceed to Moscow via Southampton, London, Copenhagen, Stockholm, Helsingfors, and Leningrad. He was to spend August 15th, 16th, in Leningrad and from August 17 to 21,1938 in Moscow. He was then to go to Poland where he would remain August 22nd to September 2nd, 1930, returning to New York City via Paris and Cherbourg, France.

A State Department Investigator's report dated November 6, 1939, reflects investigation conducted at 286 Ft. Washington Avenue, New York City. INVING MAYER, a postal clerk, residing at Apartment 2F, 286 Ft. Washington Avenue, New York City, stated that Dr. ELIAS SHAPIRO had formerly been a tenant at that address but now resided at another address on Ft. Washington Avenue, New York City He stated that SHAPIRO is a member of a group which meets in Washington Park of which he, MAYER, had been a member although the was not particularly well acquainted with SHAPIRO.

The "Daily Worker", an east coast Communist daily newspaper, for May 2, 1946, April 27, 1947, and May 1, 1949, carried May Day greetings from Dr. STAMLER, Bronx.

Mosholu Parkway, North, Bronx, New York, advised that Dr. ISAAC STAMLER had resided in Apartment D at that address for approximately 6 years. He stated that STAMLER's first wife is deceased and that he is remarried.

The name of STAMLER's present wife is unknown to VAN BEUGHAN. He also advised that STANLER's daughter, NITAL resides at this address. On a number of occasions, VAN BEUGHAN has observed that meetings were held in the STAMLER apartment which he, VAN BEUGHAN, believed to be Communist in nature. He also advised that he had observed various Communist publications in trash which had been removed from the STAMLER apartment.

Mr. V/N REUGHAN stated STAMLER usually leaves the building at about 9:00 A.M. each morning to go to his effice which is located elsewhere in the Bronx. He has resided at 175 Riverside Drive since 1935, in Apartment 11-L. His wife, FLORENCE M. COPELMAN, is a teacher employed by the New York City Board of Education at the Central High School of Needle Trades, New York City. SOBELMAN has been at 1440 Broadway since a dentist for over thirty years and has been at 1440 Broadway since 1927. He does his banking at the Corn Exchange Bank, 91st Street and Broadway, New York City.

With regard to SOBELMAN's occupancy of an office at 1440 Broadway, it may be of significance that an office at this address was occupied in the early 1930's by Dr. PHILIP ROSENBLIETT ROSENBLIETT was a known Soviet espionage agent who is presently in Russia.

Mr. P. RAIDLOV, Superintendent, 175 Riverside Drive, New York City, advised that he has been employed at this address since May, 1940, and that during this period of time NATHAN SOBELMAN has continuously resided at that address. He was questioned rather closely as to whether or not SOBELMAN had ever, during RANDLOV's acquaintance with him, had any illness which would necessitate an operation. RANDLOV stated he was unable to recall any such illness on SOBELMAN's part. He described SOBELMAN as follows:

HANS BENSSEN, Doorman and Elevator Operator at 175

In view of the above information, it is considered rather doubtful that SOBELMAN is identical with the unknown subject in this case; however, because of the fact that he was known to have been closely associated with members of the Russian official family in New York City and because of the possible

Reference is made to Bureau letter dated December 15, 1950, and Washington Field letter dated February 23, 1951, in the case entitled, "JOSEPH KATZ, was., ESPIONAGE-R", in which there is set forth information pertaining to Dr. KLIAS SHAPIRO who lived at 266 Fort Mashington Avenue, New York City. Information set out in these letters reflects that SHAPIRO was the designated addressee of a passport issued to ISAIAH LITYACKOFF under the name MATHAN ROSENBERG in 1937. LITYACKOFF's witness on this passport was JOSEPH HIAT, this name being an alias for JOSEPH KATZ who has been ascertained by investigation to be identical with ELIZABETH BENTLEY's espionage principal, "Jack".

Subsequent to his obtaining this passport, LITVACKOFF was convicted and served a prison sentence for passport fraud.

Investigation conducted by the State Department brought out the fact that LITVACKOFF's transportation had been obtained through World Tourist, this having been the organization of which JACOB GOLOS was the head. The State Department file on LITVACKOFF contains the following information with regard to ELIAS SHAPIRON

In a passport application dated July 1, 1938, SHAPIRO advised he was born July 29, 1880, in Eartus-Bereser, Grodno, Russia. He enigrated to the United States July 9, 1901,

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and was naturalized in the U. S. District Court for the Southern District of New York on November 16, 1909. SHAPIRO's address was given as 286 Pt. Washington Avenue, New York City. In his passport application, SHAPIRO stated he wanted to go to France, England and Poland for a vacation. The identifying witness was HELEN STAYSKY, 1603 Macombs Hoad, Bronx, New York. SHAPIRO was described as follows:

Height: 5'5"
Hair: Brown, graying
Ryes: Blue
Occupation: Dentist

The State Department records further reflect that SHAPIRO's proposed trip was handled by World Tourist, Inc., New York City. One itinerary prepared by World Tourist showed that he was to leave the United States on the S.S. "Aquitania" en August 3, 1938, and go to Cherbourg, France, and then to Warsaw, Poland. He was to leave Gdynia, Poland, on September 7, 1938, and return to New York via Southampton, England, aboard the S.S. "Aquitania". Another itinerary prepared by World Tourist reflects he was to leave New York City on August 3, 1938, on the S.S. "Aquitania" and proceed to Moscow via Southampton, London, Copenhagen, Stockholm, Helsingfors, and Leningrad. He was to spend August 15th, 16th, in Leningrad and from August 17 to 21, 1938, in Moscow. He was then to go to Poland where he would remain August 22nd to September 2nd, 1938, returning to New York City via Paris and Cherbourg, France.

Other information in the file indicates SHAPIRO applied for a Soviet visa but that he was advised by World Tourist that he had been refused such a visa.

A State Department Investigator's report dated Movember 6, 1939, reflects investigation conducted at 286 Pt. Washington Avenue, New York City. During this investigation, it was ascertained that Dr. BLIAS SHAPIRO had been a tenant at that address for six years and had been located in the neighborhood for approximately 15 years.

IRVING MAYER, a postal elerk, residing at Apartment 2F, 286 Ft. Washington Avenue, New York City, stated that Dr. RLIAS SHAPIRO had formerly been a tenant at that address but new resided at another address on Ft. Washington Avenue, New York City. He stated that SHAPIRO is a member of a group which meets in Washington Park of which he, MAYER, had been a member although he was not particularly well acquainted with SHAPIRO.

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The New York Telephone directory reflects that ELIAS SHAPIRO, Dentist, now resides at 536 Ft. Washington Avenue, New York City.

Mrs. ALEERTA KENDIO, 540 Pt. Washington Avenue, New York City, Superintendent, 536 Pt. Washington Avenue advised she is acquainted with Dr. SHAPIRO who resides and has an effice at the latter address. He advised that SHAPIRO's daughter resides with him at that address. Mrs. KENDIG states she had beard rumors to the effect that SHAPIRO is a Communist and she has observed that he buys various Communist publications the names of which were unknown to her at the time of the interview. She described SHAPIRO as follows:

Height: Approximately 5° 6° Weight: About 175
Hair: Gray, partially bald
Ryes: Blue or gray, wears glasses
Complexion: Sallow
Build: "Chubby"

HERBERT I. PALEY, 54 Audubon Avenue, New York City advised he is the president of a Men's Civic Club which meets on Sundays at Pt. Washington Park. He stated he has been acquainted with Dr. RLIAS SHAPIRO, who is also a member of the club, since he, PALEY, joined the club about 8 years ago. He stated that to the best of his recollection SHAPIRO has never during that period had any illnesses which would necessitate an operation, nor has he heard any mention of SHAPIRO ever having had such an illness prior to the time he, PALEY, became acquainted with him.

The records of the Credit Bureau of Greater New York were checked with negative results regarding SHAPIRO by SA CORDON C. LURD.

The records of Confidential Informant 7-1, of known reliability, have been checked but to date no record of SHAPIRO has been located.

A photograph of Dr. ELIAS SHAPIRO was extained from State Department files and will be displayed to ELIXABETH BEHTLEY.





# Dr. ISAAC STIMLER

Confidential Informant T-2, of known reliability, furnished information that ISAAC STAMLER, born 1884, was a member of IWO Lodge #337 as of August, 1949. It was noted that his Lodge meets at the Hunt's Point Palace, Southern Boulevard and 163rd Street, Bronx, New York, according to information furnished by Confidential Informant T-2.

ISAAC STANLER, 851 East 181st Street, Bronx, New York, was listed as having enrolled for the Communist Party in/1936 Primaries, according to information obtained from the New York City Board of Elections.

The 1934 City directory lists ISAAC STANLER, dentist, at 851 East 181st Street, Bronx, New York.

Confidential Informant T-3, a reliable informant, furnished a copy of a file card which indicated that as of November 14, 1944, NINA STANLER, 391 Mosholu Parksay, Bronz, occupation, stenographer, was a member of the 4th A.D. Club of the Communist Political Association.

The "Daily Worker", an east coast Communist daily newspaper, for May 2, 1946, April 27, 1947, and May 1, 1949, carried May Day greetings from Dr. STAMLER, Bronz.

JOSEPH VAN REUGHEN, Superintendent, 391 East Nosholu Parkay, North, Bronz, New York, advised that Dr. ISAAC STANLER had resided in Apartment D at that address for approximately 6 years. He stated that STANLER's first wife is deceased and that he is remerried.

The name of STAMLER's present wife is unknown to VAN MEUGHAN. He also advised that STAMLER's daughter, NINA, resides at this address. On a number of occasions, VAN BEUGHAN has observed that meetings were held in the STAMLER apartment which he, VAN BEUGHAN, believed to be Communist in nature. He also advised that he had observed various Communist publications in trash which had been removed from the STAMLER apartment.

Mr. VAN BEUGHAN stated STANLER usually leaves the building at about 9:00 A.M. each morning to go to his office which is located elsewhere in the Bronz. He advised he would be on the alert for further information regarding STANLER and would advise the writer should information of interest to this Bureau come to his attention.





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Mr. VAN HRUCKAN described Dr. ISAAC STANIER as follows:

Age: about 60-65

Height: 5' 6" or 5' 7"

Weight: Approximately 170

Hair: Gray

Complexion: Wedium

Build: Stooped carriage

The records of the Credit Bureau of Greater New York reflect a report dated Pebruary 5, 1949, on ISAAC STANLER, dentist, wife, CLARA. This record reflects that STANLER is married, approximately 65 years of age, with grown children and that he does his banking at the Public National Bank, East 205th Street, Bronz, New York.

#### Dr. NATHAN BOBELMAN

A review of reports of Confidential Informants T-4 and T-5, both reliable informants, reflects that Dr. NATHAN SCHELMAN was a dentist frequently contacted by the members of the Astorg Trading Corporation and the Soviet Consulate in New York City for professional treatment during the period pertinent to this investigation.

The current New York Telephone directory lists Dr. W. SCHELMAN, dentist, as having an office at 1440 Broadway, New York City. His residence is listed as 175 Riverside Drive, New York City.

Confidential Informant T-1 advised that as of April, 1942, MATHAN SCHELMAN was residing at 175 Riverside Drive, New York City, and was a practicing dentist at 1440 Broadway. The informant stated SCHELMAN had given SAMUEL LITT as a person who would know his whereabouts. SCHELMAN's description, as it appeared in the records of Confidential Informant T-1, was as follows:

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Information furnished by the Credit Bureau of Breater
New York reflects that SCHELMAN formerly resided at 180 Lenga
Road, Brooklyn, New York, and 1020 President Street, Brooklyn,
New York. He has resided at 175 Riverside Drive since 1935,
in Apartment 11-L. His wife, PLORENCE M. SCHELMAN, is a teacher
employed by the New York City Board of Education at the Central
High School of Needle Trades, New York City.—SCHELMAN-has been
a dentist for ever thirty years and has been at 1440 Broadway since
1927. He does his banking at the Corn Exchange Bank, 91st Street
and Broadway, New York City.

With regard to SORKIMAN's occupancy of an office at 1440 Broadway, it may be of significance that an office at this address was occupied in the early 1930's by Dr. PHILIP ROSENBLIETT. ROSENBLIETT was a known Soviet espionage agent who is presently in Russia.

Mr. P. RANDLOV, Superintendent, 175 Riverside Drive, New York City, advised that he has been employed at this address since May, 1940, and that during this period of time MATHAM SOMELMAN has continuously resided at that address. He was questioned rather closely as to whether or not SOMELMAN had ever, during RANDLOV's acquaintance with him, had any illness which would necessitate an operation. RANDLOV stated he was unable to recall any such illness on SOMELMAN's part. He described SOMELMAN as follows:

Height; Build: Weight: Hair; Complexion: 5' 6-1/2"

Approximately 165
Dark brown, quite gray
Sallow

HARS HENSER, Doorman and Klevator Operator at 175
Riverside Drive advised that he has been employed at that address
for ever ten years and has had almost daily contact with Dr.
NATHAN SCHRIMAN during that period. He stated he was unable to
recall any instances in which SCHEIMAN had had illnesses which
might necessitate an operation.

In view of the above information, it is considered rather doubtful that SCHELHAN is identical with the unknown subject in this case; however, because of the fact that he wis known to have been closely associated with members of the Russian official family in New York City and because of the possible

significance of his occupancy at 1440 Broadway, efforts will be made to obtain a photograph of SCHRIMAN in order that same may be displayed to KLIZABETH HENFLEY.

# Miscellaneous:

The reports of Confidential Informant T-1 and T-5 were reviewed in an effort to ascertain whether any mention had been made by these informants of any illnesses on the part of individuals connected with the Soviet establishments or with Amtorg Trading Corporation during the latter part of 1942 and early 1943. This review was negative inasmuch as these informants were inactive during the period December 4, 1942, to May 5, 1943.

Will attempt to obtain photographs of STANLER for display to ELIZABETH BENTLEY.

Will check the records of Immigration and Naturalization Service, New York City, for further information pertaining to Dr. NATHAN SCHEIMAH.

Hill endeavor to obtain photograph of SCENLMAN for display to ELIZABETH ERNTLEY.

Will make appropriate discreet investigation at 1440 Breadway, New York City, for further information regarding SCHIMAN.

The following information concerning subject's passport case may be of interest.

Dayton was denied passport facilities by the Passport Office on April 14, June 24 and October 12, 1954. An appeal was filed and Hearings were held on January 18 and March 29, 1955 before the Board of Passport Appeals at which subject appeared personally and was represented by counsel.

After a review of the entire record and on the basis of all the evidence, including that contained in confidential reports of investi- ' gation and that adduced at the Hearings, the Secretary of State disapproved the subject's request for passport facilities under Section 51.135 of the passport regulations. The subject was informed of this decision by letter dated September 7, 1955.




