INTRODUCTION

The functions of the Attorney General's office, including the offices of the various United States attorneys and their assistants, as well as the various bureaus in the Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Investigation, are to carry out the laws of our nation. These officials are charged with the responsibility not only of prosecuting those persons accused of crimes but also of protecting impartially the constitutional and legal rights of all citizens. It has been said that "The United States Attorney is the representative not of an ordinary party to a controversy but of a sovereignty whose obligation to govern impartially is as compelling as its obligation to govern at all and whose interest therefore in a criminal prosecution is not that it shall win a case but that justice shall be done". (See Appendix 1)

We believe that in the case of Julius and Ethel Rosenberg and Morton Sobell the Attorney General's office and the subordinate United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York failed to carry out their responsibilities with respect to achieving justice for all citizens regardless of political persuasion, and used every means at their command, lawful and unlawful, to send the Rosenbergs to their death and Morton Sobell to Alcatras.

Wander 11 - 14/10

Mr. Sobell is alive today. He is appealing his conviction and sentence. The Attorney General's office continues to oppose these efforts. The Attorney General's office, in our view, is obstructing justice, exercising coercive pressures on Mr. Sobell, and generally is guilty of practices wholly alien to American concepts of fairness and decency.

We therefore turn to the Judiciary Committee of the Senate of the United States, as elected officials of the people and of the Senate, and ask that the Committee examine the improper conduct of the Attorney General's office in the Rosenberg-Sobell case.

This request for an investigation is based on the following facts:

- I. The Attorney General's office knowingly used and encouraged perjured testimony against the Rosenbergs and against Morton Sobell.
- II. The Attorney General's office promised rewards and in fact did give such rewards to several chief witnesses in the Rosenberg-Sobell case.
- III. The Attorney General's office deliberately engaged in an unlawful campaign of misrepresentation of facts through press releases prior to the trial and thus falsified essential aspects of the case, influencing public opinion to prejudge the defendants.
- IV. The Attorney General's office attempted and still attempts to keep from the courts documents that reveal the perjuries and the role the Attorney General's office played in obtaining these perjuries.
- V. The Attorney General's office engaged in the use of mental torture against the Rosenbergs and mental torture, as well as physical violence against Morton Sobell.
- VI. The Attorney General's office, by deception and misrepresentation, interfered with the courts' handling of the case.
- VII. The Attorney General's office, by withholding information, by deception, and by outright falsehoods, misled two Presidents of the United States, who had before them appeals for clemency.

The L. A. cormittoe was born of discussions among a small group of friends who would get together socially ence a wook. All were progressives and talk usually wound up with politics. The Resemberg Case was discussed many times, usually with pained dismay ever the absence of any activity to save these two victims. Firmlly, we decided to stir up some interest in Les Angeles. We wrote to the New York Committee for material and then began to make the rounds - IPP - JPFO - IND - FW - CRC - the Freiheit - it was a bitter, disappointing experience. Ultra conservatives could not have acted weres - the Resemberg Case was the managementable issues.

The result that we agreed that if anything was to be done, it would have to be done by people like ourselves - so we constituted ourselves a semmittee and began to meet Menday nights - T of us. The Entional Report consisted of a resume of the setivities of the Entional Committee from its inneption, as well as touching on the work of a number of non-Midwest Committees. The report began with a brief history of the National Committee, its organisation early in 1952, and its adoption of a position of "Grave doubt" on the Resemberg-Sobell case, leading to a call for a new trial. The report recounted the first round of advortising conducted by the Entional Committee, the pamphlets it issued, and the secres of committees 2 helped organize around the country.

The report moted: that the Mational Committee had issued some 400,000 pieces of literature since its inception, the everyhelming bulk of which it had distributed. The following is a breakdown of the 400,000 figure:

This figure does not include sciarate publications issued by local Committees such as the los Angeles Conmittee which has issued its own four page fact sheet, a pumphlot on the political and Jowish asposts on the case as well as other material.

The roport roteds that a fairly comprehensive trial analysis and a sedomo-dust short were still in the works.

The report noted: that the Mational Office had in its possession no more than approximatcly 35,000 signatures to the Auleus Brief, although the list of prominent signors was very good. The report resusanted that the Midwest Conference assure the Pagenti Lility Tor acquiring 40,000 additional algorithms through the month of Astaber.

(The Batiomal Office believes that regardless of deadlines, the impact of a very inge master of signatures will sake itself folt, if groper tochniques are used)

The report moted: that since Povember approximately \$50,000, \$8,000 of which was in the form of loans and which has all been paid back, was waised by the Estional Office. Of this execut, approximately \$10,000 was select at his public scetings, \$5,000 from small smottings and house parties, 45,000 from literature cales, and \$30,000 through the smile. The Committee has only received two \$500 contributions from indiduals, and mone over that account.

The expenditures of the Counittee have amounted to approximately \$59,000. The break down for this figure follows:

The rt noted: that activity in the unions con at a very slow page. With the recition of scattered union locals, there can no consistent approach to the unions and to their numberships. A special Amicus is now being prepared, directed to the unions. A national organizer with considerable trade union experience is a wital addition to the Committee, and awaits only sufficient funds to be realizable. The report recommended that every local Committee undertake to establish the closest possible relations with trade unions in their communities, to bring the facts of the ense to their membership and to get positive actions

The report noteds that from the very beginning of the campaign there has been substantial support from among leaders of the Hegre people. In spite of this, the Baticanl Committee and the local committees have not yet developed a realistic and fruitful approach to the Hegre communities in respect to this case. The report represented that in the process of working out an approach to the Hegre communities the Committees study the parallels between the Resemberg Cose, involving Jewish eitisens, and recent cases involving Negre citizens. For example, just as the death sentence is reserved for Begre citizens in many communities in the United States, so the death sentence was reserved for the Resemberg in this case. We must recognise that a parallel between the trials of Lt. Loon Gilbert and other Begre soldiers in Recommend the Resemberg Case because in both instances the people involved became a capegon to for reserves in foreign policy and on the bettle field. Likewise the threat by a Machington, D. C., judge to invoke the precedent set in the Resemberg Case against Miss Marie Richardson, a Hegre woman leader, must be explored.

The report notes: Int the Breenberg Case has begun to receive front-page treatment in Europe and in Asia. Rewapapers in France, England, Smitzerland, and Chim have begun to take a very active interest. Also a number of very imposent civil rights, trade union, and humanitaria a organizations abroad have begun to speak out on the case.

The report noted: that so-called scientific evidence in the case was so crude and unbelievable that it was both an insult and a danger to scientists, for it stempted to draw scientists into the trial by occurring the pseudo-scientific unterial with the ment is of true columns.

The report recommended that local committees sentmet scientists in their communities and compuses and get their thinking, advice, and help in expesing the allegedly scientific amterial introduced into the trial.

G. THE COLANITTEE REPORTS

During the Committee reports it became clear that cortain common difficulties faced these committees. Because of the general atmosphere, many people were afraid to join such committees. Another factor was the position taken by the major Jurish defense organisations like Brai Brith, A.D.L., A.J.C., etc. A third factor was the general impression of guilt which had been conveyed to the public by the newspapers.

In spite of these drawbacks, a 11 the Committees could report progress to ome degree or another. In general the Committees relied upon mailings to all sorts of lists, public meetings, and recasional small luncheous, or other get-togethers with important figures in their communities. Most of the reports, such as that of Milwackoo, indicated that the Resemberg Committee had become an issue in their local organizations, and hopes were held out for getting some of these local organizations to take a positive position on the case.

The Committoes ranged in number from four or five parsons as in St. Louis and Cincinneti, to 25 active people. H. WEN TRIAL AND CLEMENCY

The Conference discussed the question of a campaign for a new trial versus a compaign for elemency at this time. Very forceful arguments were presented on both sides. It was folt by some that a compaign to get the fermion morph to patition the fresheat for elemency would be more important than the campaign for a new trial on the grounds that it was first necessary to insure the lives of the Eosenbergs and then argue for a new trial. It was felt that because the country for which they had allegedly conspired to commit espionage bad been an ally and tensor has death sentences were in such sharp contract with the sentences given to fast spice and traitors, and on humand grounds, the support of many more people would be gotton for a cleanary compaign toom.

It was argued on the other hand that an appeal to President Freman before we had anhanced every appeal to the courts would, in effect, ungate efforts being under for a new trial; that President Trumm could reject the appeal for elements under the grounds that the metter is in the hands of the courts and it would be errors for the executive to interfere. It was also argued that every petition for a new it was in itself a pleafor cleanery if a new trial should not be granted.


The delegates agreed that an insufficient attempt had been made to bring the ease to the Megro communities. In addition to agreeing with the Secretary's report on an approach to the Megro communities, it was recommended that the Recemberg Committee be linked with local current cases in the various accumunities.

P. GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS.

The delegates recommended that greater efforts be made to bring the case into the non-lowish community; to impress upon the candidates of the Progressive Party, and where possible, other parties, to raise the Resemberg Case as part of their political committee; to impress the membership of the various local committees, and to draw into that membership gosmunity and or maintained leaders.

The Conference passed a motion commending and thinking the Chicago Committee Turthe housing and feeding accommodations they had arranged and for the highly official manner in which the Conference was run-
