Re Albuquerque teletype dated 6-9-50 to Burea, St. Louis and WFO.

Attached herewith are photostatic copies of Army Pay Vouchers for a period from April, 1943, to February, 1946, and prepared by the General Accounting Office, Army Audit Branch, St. Louis, Missouri, together with GAO cover letter dated 6-16-50.

These vouchers reflect pay roll payment made to GREENGLASS, among others, during his period of Army service. Where the pay roll payment was made in cash the pay roll reflects the signatures of the individuals soldiers. Where the payment was made by check the check number appears on the pay roll in the place of the soldier's signatures.

Attention is directed to GAO cover letter, supra, page 2, paragraphs 2 and 3, with reference to the November, 1944 voucher number 12979, having been "redlined". It appears that GREENGLASS signed the pay roll but was not present when the actual payment was made and hence his signature was "redlined".

It is further noted that voucher #12979 was paid on December 29, 1944. Prior investigation in this case has determined that the Army records, reflect CREENGLASS was on furlough from December 30, 1944, to January 1945, and from the above it appears that he may have actually left one; day early inasmuch as he apparently was not present to receive his part on 12-29-44.

No further action is contemplated by the St. Louis Division with reference to this matter of pay roll records pending further instruction.


