On Oct 6, 1950 the Bureau & N.Y. were advised that the indices of this office contained no info on Sidney Powell other than contained in the loyalty form submitted by SARAH SHIRLEY POWELL.

pg 5 On 10-23-50, Max Elitcher furnished a signed to SAS
Rex Shroder + V.J. Cahill, incorporating all of the info. he
could recall concerning his associations with Sobell
and Julius Rosenberg. The signed statement follows:

pg 30 "Elitcher stated that while residing at the address on 7th St. N.W.
Washington DC., there were approximately five Communist Party
meetings held in his and Sobell's apartment. He stated
that he and Sobell were present at each meeting. Elitcher
stated that the only person whom he could recall by
name, who was a member of their cell at that time
was one SARAH SILVERMAN - - - - -"

pg 31 With reference to SARAH SILVERMAN, Elitcher states
that in 1939 she was about 25 yrs old and was employed
by the Civil Service Commission in Washington. He stated
(Cwio)

that she either left Washington or dropped out of the party a short time later and he had not seen or heard of her since that time. - - - - -

The files of this office reflect that a loyalty investigation was conducted on a SARAH SHIRLEY POWELL also known as SARAH S. SILVERMAN. The files reflect that SILVERMAN was 27 years old in 1939 and was employed by Civil Service Commission in Washington D.C. from Nov. 1939 to April 1942. She was subject of a Hatch Act Investigation by the Washington Field Office, at which time she was reported active in the American Peace Mobilization. SARAH SILVERMAN is reportedly residing at 1002 Foster Avenue, Brooklyn, New York. With her husband, Sidney Powell.

By teletype dated 10-27-50 Bureau authorization was requested by the New York Office to interview SARAH SILVERMAN regarding her knowledge of Sobell's Communist Party activities.

"Mrs. Cron stated she vaguely recalled that Sobell received phone calls from an individual named Joel. She did not know his last name. She also advised that Sobell frequently entertained a girl by the name of SARAH SILVERMAN. She stated that SARAH SILVERMAN originally came from Baltimore, Maryland, and that she apparently resided in the neighborhood inasmuch as Sobell would walk her home after she had visited him, and that he would always return in a very short time. It is believed that this SARAH SILVERMAN is identical with SARAH SHIRLEY POWELL concerning whom info. was furnished to the Bureau and the NY Division by teletype on Sept 27, 1950.
