Remylet 8/6/51 and reports of SA RICHARD HRADSKY dated 5/10/51 and 7/25/51 at New York.

The synopsis of reference report date May 10, 1951 reflects that subject was visted on the night of 4/5/51 by ARTHUR CARL BOUDIN, which statement was based on the indentity of the individual of whom the automobile into which the subject was seen entering, was registered, as obtained from the NY Bureau of Motor Vehicles. Further investigation revealed that the individual that Agents observed with subject on the night of April 5, 1951 was MAX FINESTONE and not ARTHUR CARL BOUDIN, FINESTONE having borrowed BOUDIN'S automobile that night. This subsequent identification is reflected in reference report dated 7/25/51.

An amended synopsis was prepared for report date 5/10/51 and five copies of page two of this report were forwarded to the Bureau for insertion in the Bureau's copies if this met with the Bureau's approval.
