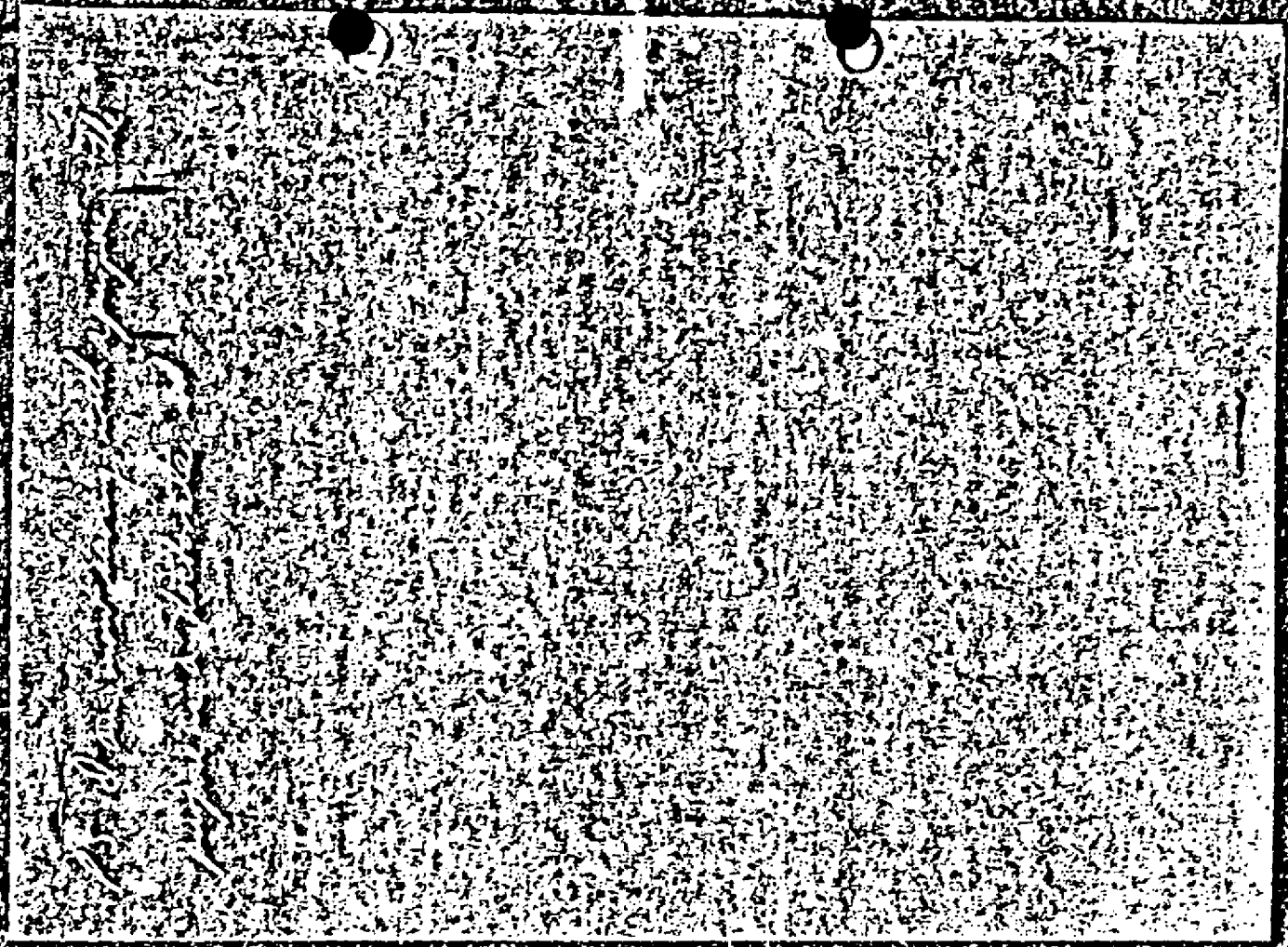
I've been away to the mountains on a camping trip for a few days and just got your letter. Had a great time at the price of only some foot blisters and a little pack.
