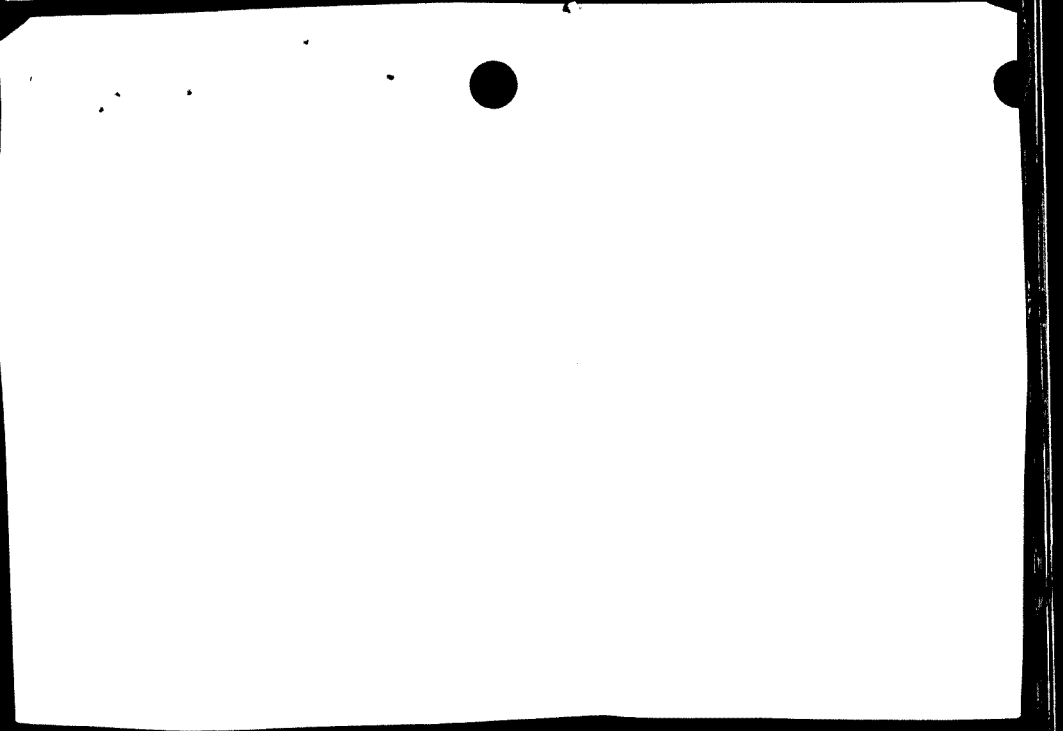
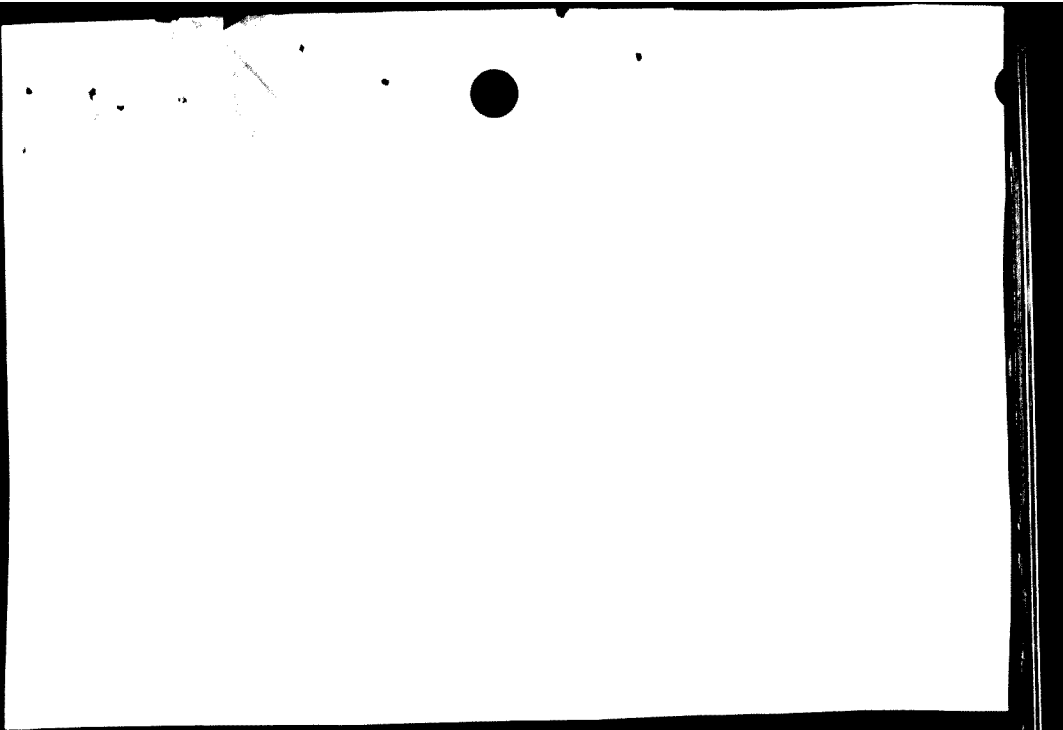



The informant recently met "NICKY" (SCARFO), who introduced himself to the informant. He referred to SCARFO as "just a kid" and said that to his knowledge, SCARFO is not a member of the Organization.

The informant had also learned that ROCCO SCAFIDI had been incarcerated at the Philadelphia Detention Center with PHILIP TESTA. He said that SCAFIDI's father, TOM GAETANO, had been a member of the Organization, but that he had never heard that any of the SCAFIDI boys had become members. He said it was very doubtful if ROCCO would be accepted as a member, as he is "too radical". The Organization has used ROCCO at different times on matters where he could not hurt them. [REDACTED]

The pending Federal prosecution of BRUNO and others under the extortion and related statutes was discussed, together with any additional pressure that such a prosecution might bring to bear on the individuals involved.

During the informant's remarks concerning this, he said that he feels sure that IGNAZIO DENARO would "stand up" through any ordinary pressure as a result of prosecution, but if there was a good likelihood that he would receive a sentence of ten years or more, then DENARO might not be able to stand this pressure. He said that such pressure might cause DENARO to "open up".

ARMANDO COLIANNI was described by the informant as only an errand boy of DENARO, and he said that he felt sure that COLIANNI is not a member of the Organization.

HARRY RICCOBENE, a member of the Organization in Philadelphia, has tried to have John's Vending buy out Penn-Jersey Vending completely, but ANGELO BRUNO does not want to make the complete sale.

BRUNO claims that the portion of Penn-Jersey that he continues to control furnishes him a living and a salary to his wife and possibly one other person.

The Bureau realizes that your office in the past has covered the hoodlum activities of some of the named subjects through your investigations of more prominent and active members of captioned organization. However, in the interest of having a separate case file on each member of La Cosa Nostra containing complete background data on these hoodlum figures, the above-named investigative targets have been selected by the Bureau for penetration.

These investigations must receive prompt attention by your office. The Bureau will closely follow the progress of your efforts to insure that all La Cosa Nostra members within your division are receiving appropriate investigative attention. You are reminded that 22 field offices, including Philadelphia, on 1/28/63 were advised that separate investigative reports on members of captioned organization who had not previously been the subjects of Anti-Racketeering cases under the Criminal Intelligence Program be prepared and submitted suitable for dissemination by the Bureau to the Department.

If some justifiable reason exists for not conducting the requested investigation on any of these subjects for reasons possibly unknown to the Bureau, immediately advise the Bureau in that regard.

GIIF, Philadelphia Division, period covering 10/30/51 to 4/30/52, reflects the following regarding captioned individual:

Two other members of the Mafia who frequent the neighborhood of 10th and Christian Streets and 8th and Christian Streets, which is the neighborhood in which the Greasers operate, were FRANK NICOLETTA and SALVATORE SABELLI. NICOLETTA is described as approximately 38 years of age, 5'6" in height and of slender build. SABELLI resides in Glendale, Pa., but is in South Philadelphia every day. He was described as approximately 63 or 64 years of age, 5'7" in height, of slender build, has white hair and wears glasses.

Another group of individuals whose names are often associated with the Greasers are persons closely associated with LITTLE HARRY RICCOBENE. RICCOBENE, who has previously been arrested for use of narcotic drugs, of recent date has been managing large crap games in Wilmington, Del. ANGELO BRUNO, a prominent member of the Mafia in Philadelphia, according to [Redacted] is associated with RICCOBENE in this venture along with [Redacted] MICHAEL MAGGIO and SALVATORE SABELLI.
