Synopsis: (U) SAMUEL LITTLE allegedly murdered SARAH THOMPSON BROWN in New Orleans in 1973.

Details:

The writer received an FBI news article dated November 27, 2018 concerning the convicted serial killer SAMUEL LITTLE, who is more fully identified below. LITTLE has been the subject of extensive media coverage and has confessed to at least 90 murders. The article provided details about LITTLE's activities including an "unmatched confession" to the murder of a black female possibly named "SARAH" in 1973. The woman possibly worked at a restaurant in New Orleans.

In February 2019, FBI New Orleans received a media inquiry concerning the murder of SARAH. The inquiry asked if the FBI was investigating the murder of SARAH THOMPSON BROWN. Her family spoke with the media and said she worked at a restaurant on Canal Street in New Orleans and was last seen waiting for a bus in 1973. Further, BROWN's purse was found in Carrollton, but she was never found.

The writer had previously received information about LITTLE from the Behavioral Analysis Unit (BAU). The information read, in part, that [Redacted]

On March 27, 2019, SA [REDACTED] and the writer spoke with [REDACTED] on the phone. They live in [REDACTED] and have phone numbers [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] sent a photo of SARAH BROWN to a media representative who forwarded it to the FBI.

On March 28, 2019, the writer spoke with Texas Ranger [REDACTED] at [REDACTED]. He is handling the LITTLE investigation in Texas and has interviewed LITTLE extensively. Ranger [REDACTED] relayed how LITTLE remembered the murder in New Orleans. LITTLE took the victim to a location near a waterfall and talked with her. The victim got upset being near water because her ex-husband or ex-boyfriend drowned in a fishing accident.

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Ranger [REDACTED] said LITTLE provided details about the murders he committed; he will not claim responsibility for something he did not do. Ranger [REDACTED] described how he has shown numerous photos of victims to LITTLE. The writer forwarded the photo of SARAH BROWN to Ranger [REDACTED] via email.

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The writer contacted [REDACTED] the same day. [REDACTED] lived in Illinois when she went missing. [REDACTED] did not know if [REDACTED] had a boyfriend at the time or if she had a boyfriend who passed away, but said he would contact [REDACTED] in New Orleans and ask.

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Later that day, the writer met with Detectives (Det.) [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at the New Orleans Police Department (NOPD). Det. [REDACTED] said they had not been able to locate the original file, which was a missing person's case, but the search will continue. The writer forwarded SARAH's photo to Dets. [REDACTED]

SARAH was working at a restaurant on Canal Street (Agent note: New Orleans, Louisiana). On the night she went missing, the weather was too bad for her to get across the river; it was raining that night. SARAH was supposed to stay with her sister. Three days later, they filed a missing persons report because she had not shown up.

SARAH's ex-husband, [REDACTED] was alive at the time and living in Rockford, Illinois. [REDACTED] did not know if [REDACTED] had a boyfriend when she went missing.

[REDACTED] was interviewed over the phone at phone number [REDACTED] by Special Agent (SA) [REDACTED]. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and the nature of the interview, [REDACTED] provided the following information:

SARAH had a boyfriend named JOE MCCURRY who had been killed; he was shot. SARAH was still alive when he died.

BROWN's [REDACTED] also known as [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] did not know the restaurant where SARAH worked. She was a chef. When he was younger, she worked the evening shift and would get him jobs washing dishes. She worked at a number of different restaurants.

SARAH did not have a car. Her sister was WILLETTA DUNCAN (DUNCAN) who is now deceased. SARAH was supposed to stay with DUNCAN that night.

SARAH was not really afraid of the water. When [REDACTED] was younger, they used to go swimming. They lived in Plaquemines parish and SARAH would also go swimming.

[REDACTED] believed SARAH was 37 years old when she went missing. She was 5'5"-6" tall, and weighed 130 pounds. She had a scar on the left side of her mouth which ran from her lip to her chin; she had stitches there. [REDACTED] was not sure how she got the scar, but said it could have been from fighting or a car accident.

[REDACTED] was not familiar with SARAH having a boyfriend named [REDACTED] but commented that that did not mean she did not.

Where SARAH was that night was close to the French Quarter. It was close to the mouth of the river almost to the Canal Street Ferry.

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NOPD investigating whether woman's 1973 disappearance is connected to serial killer Samuel Little

NEW ORLEANS (WVUE) - There is new information connected to the case of a man the FBI says may be among the most prolific serial killers in U.S. history. In a FOX 8 exclusive, we have learned that New Orleans Police are investigating whether convicted killer Samuel Little was involved in the 1973 disappearance of a woman in New Orleans.

The NOPD said its investigators have been in touch with the family of the missing woman, Sarah Brown. Texas Rangers and the FBI are also looking into it.

According to the FBI, 78-year-old Little has confessed to 90 murders. Investigators are working to match his confessions to evidence in states across the country - including Louisiana - during

the years from 1970 to 2005.

Little is currently in a Texas prison, where the FBI says he's drawing pictures of the women he killed. On Monday (April 1), the FBI posted on its website that one of those sketches is of a black woman whom Little reportedly confessed to killing in 1973. According to what the FBI calls an "unmatched confession" from Little, the victim was possibly named Sarah and may have worked at a restaurant in New Orleans.

We spoke with Sarah Brown's only child, Kenneth, who wants investigators to figure out if Little is responsible for his mother's killing. He said she worked at a Canal Street restaurant and was last seen waiting for a bus. He said her purse was later found on Carrollton Avenue, but she was never seen again.

We spoke with Kenneth Brown just weeks before the sketch was released, and he told us how important closure is for him.

"I've had it in the back of my brain for so long that I really never thought an opportunity like this would come, but now it's here looking me in the face, you know, and I can't let go of it," Brown said.

FOX 8 spoke with Brown again today (April 2), and he said he has talked to both NOPD and FBI investigators about his mother's case.

New Orleans Police said this case is still under investigation. The NOPD is asking anyone with information to call their homicide detectives at (504) 658-5300 or call Crimestoppers anonymously at (504) 822-1111.

[redacted] On the night BROWN went missing, [redacted] asked BROWN to come to her house because the bridge was washed out. However, BROWN was supposed to stay with another sister, WILLETTA (Agent note: WILLETTA DUNCAN). DUNCAN lived behind a Winn Dixie off Almonaster Avenue. [redacted] could not remember the name of the street. The Winn Dixie may still be there.

BROWN lived in Bridge Plaza on Murl Street on the West Bank. Bridge Plaza is called DeGaulle Manor, but is now closed. BROWN lived in building 16, apartment 604.

[redacted] was not sure where BROWN worked. BROWN was either a short-order cook or a waitress at a short-order place on or around Canal Street.

[redacted] was about [redacted] years old when BROWN went missing. At one point she referred to BROWN as [redacted]

[redacted] told BROWN to take a taxi, but BROWN said someone was giving her a ride to "Aunt BELL's" (Agent note: DUNCAN's) house. BROWN was by the Rexall Drug store on Canal Street. [redacted] was listening to the conversation between [redacted] and BROWN. [redacted] just knew where the bus stop was located; BROWN was at the bus stop. The storm was too bad and BROWN could not cross the bridge. This was at night, or at least it was dark. [redacted] commented it may have been dark because of the storm. [redacted] could not remember the date when BROWN went missing.

BROWN did not make any reference to what the person was driving. There was also no description of the person.

The Greater New Orleans Bridge which went over the river was out at that time.

Investigations by the New Orleans Police Department have been unsuccessful in determining the whereabouts of Mrs. Sarah G. Brown, 2331 Murat St., Algiers, who was reported missing since April 16 by her sisters.

Mrs. Willetta Duncan, 3156 Toulouse St., and Mrs. Shirley Merrick, 3150 Alvar St., sisters of 39-year-old Mrs. Brown, said they reported Mrs. Brown missing to police when she could not be found after leaving work at 11:30 p.m. April 16.

Mrs. Duncan said Mrs. Brown called her that night and asked if she could spend the night at her home. It was a rainy night, Mrs. Duncan said, which made it difficult for Mrs. Brown to get to her own home in Algiers.

Mrs. Duncan said that Mrs. Brown called her from Canal and Camp after being given a ride to the corner of Canal and Basin by a fellow worker.

"But she never arrived at my house," Mrs. Duncan said.

April 17, Mrs. Brown's purse was found thrown across the fence of the Sealtest Dairy Co. on Carrollton by a worker there, but the wallet was missing. Mrs. Duncan said that the night of April 16 her sister was paid, but no money was found in the purse.

Mrs. Brown is a black woman of medium complexion, with brown eyes and medium brown hair. She is five feet, five inches tall and about 150 pounds. Her sisters said Mrs. Brown also has a scar on her lip.

She was last seen wearing a blue skirt, a long sleeve white blouse, blue and white shoes and a white rain coat.

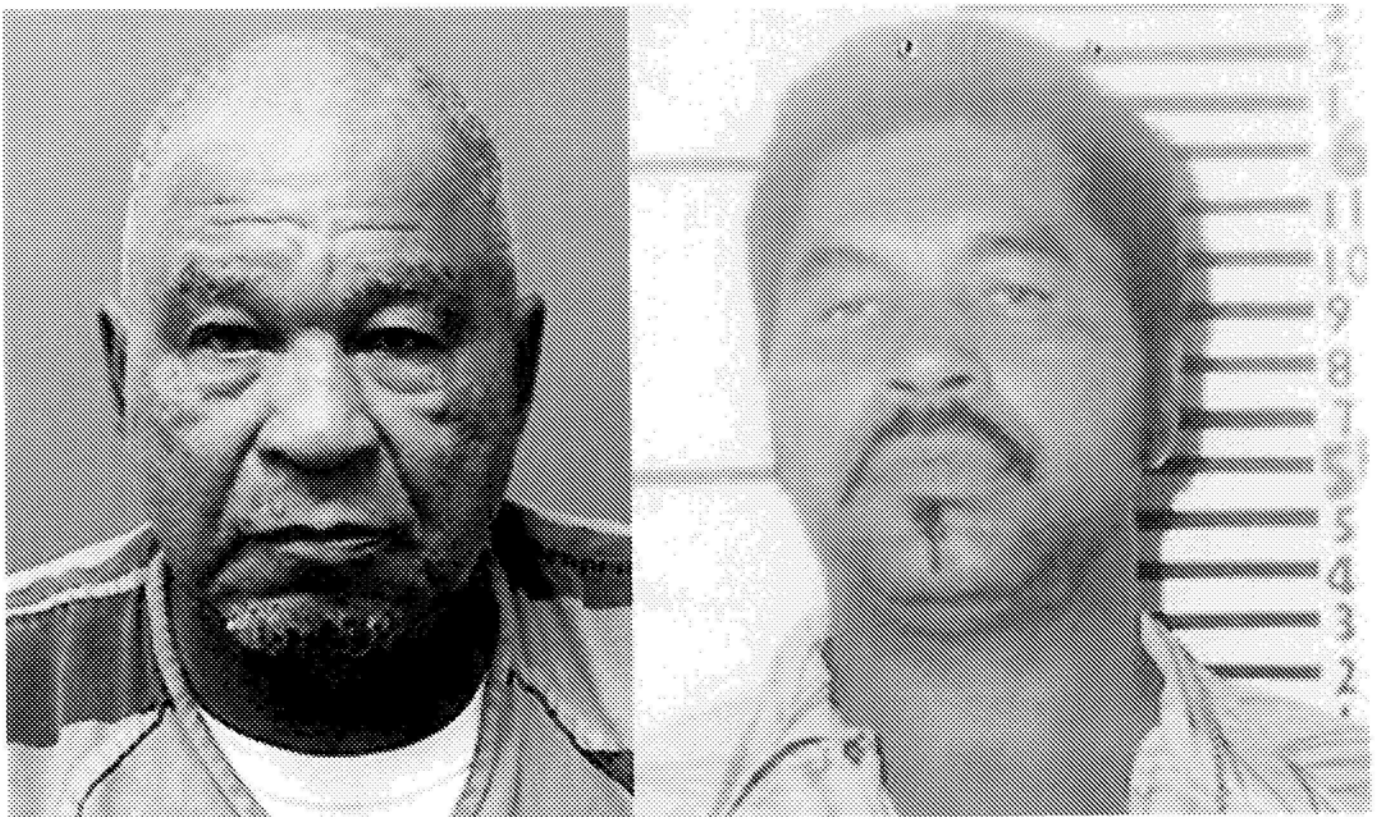

The "most prolific serial killer in U.S. history" is now connected to another New Orleans case, according to new information from the FBI released October 1.

Samuel Little, who has been behind bars since 2012 and last year told investigators he was responsible for about 90 killings across

While in prison, Little has drawn portraits based on the memories of his victims, and they've been released starting in 2018. One of the most recent portraits obtained by the FBI reveals what investigators say is his second New Orleans victim, a white woman between 33-44 years old who was also killed in 1982.

The FBI hasn't released any additional information on Little's second New Orleans victim.

Little told investigators his first New Orleans victim was drowned somewhere in New Orleans East. In that case, he took the Little Woods exit off Interstate 10 and pulled off of a dirt road along a canal, where he killed her.

"She was pretty. Light colored, honey brown skin," he said with a small smile in a videotaped prison interview. "She was tall for a woman. Beautiful shape. And, uh, friendly."

It was 1982, and they met in a club. She left with him in his Lincoln, and they parked by a bayou.

"That's the only one that I ever killed by drowning," he said.

The 79-year-old Little is serving multiple life sentences in California. He has said he strangled his 93 victims, nearly all of them women.

In a news release on Sunday, the FBI announced that federal crime analysts believe all of his confessions are credible, and officials have been able to verify 50 confessions so far.

The FBI has provided 30 drawings of his victims — color portraits that were drawn by Little himself, mostly of black women.

Some of his victims were on the margins of society. Many were originally deemed overdoses, or attributed to accidental or undetermined causes. Some bodies were never found.

In addition to his two New Orleans victims, Little has admitted to a third Louisiana killing, near Monroe.

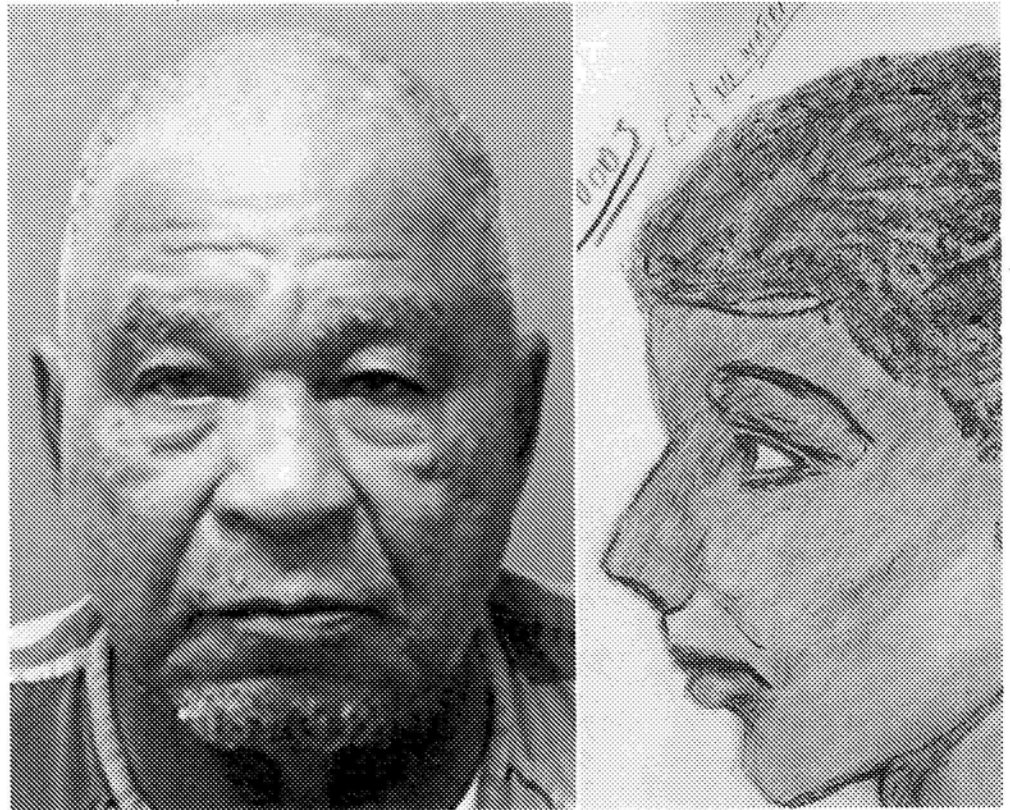

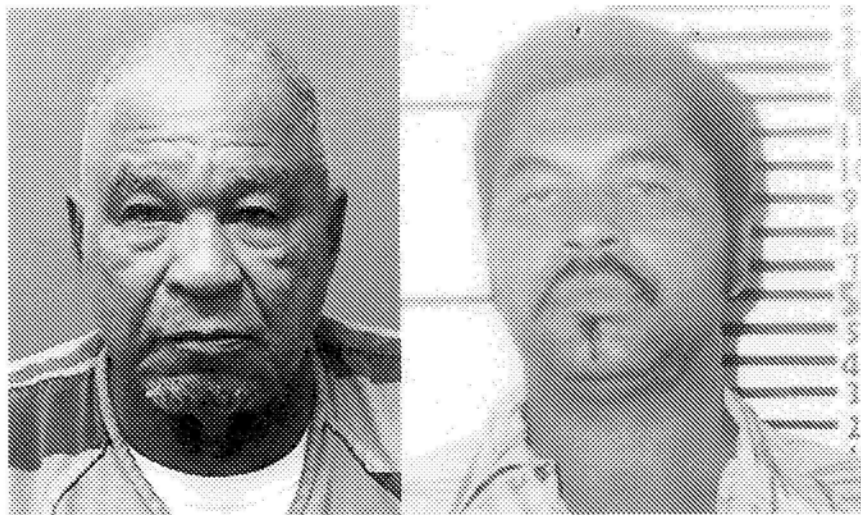

Hoping the new information will help them solve a mystery, authorities released additional details Wednesday about a woman they believe was drowned in New Orleans by prolific serial killer Samuel Little.

Little, who is serving multiple life sentences in California, told investigators he killed two women in New Orleans and a third near Monroe.

On Wednesday, the FBI's New Orleans field office released more details about one of the women Little said he killed in New Orleans.

He said he met the woman at a club in 1982, maybe in the fall. She was there for a birthday party with a group of friends and one of her two sisters.

She was black, 30 to 40 years old, 5'8" or 5'9" and about 160 pounds, he said. She had medium-length, straight hair and was wearing a "pretty dress with buttons on the front," he told investigators.

"She was pretty. Light colored, honey-brown skin," he said in a videotaped prison interview. "She was tall for a woman. Beautiful shape. And, uh, friendly."

She lived with her mother, who was sick.

Little said the woman gave him the keys to her house and they left the club in his Lincoln Continental Mark III.

Little drove the woman to the Little Woods exit off Interstate 10, where he turned down a dirt road along a canal that was being dredged.

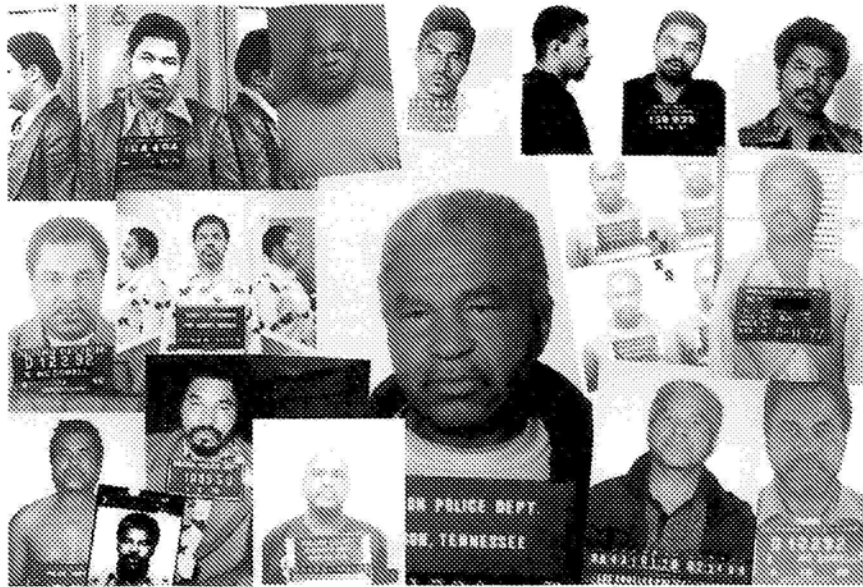
They got out of the car, and he pulled her to the canal, drowned her and left her body, he told investigators.

"That's the only one that I ever killed by drowning," he said.

He then drove back to a motel in Pascagoula, Miss., where he was staying.

Little has described the other victim in New Orleans as a white woman 33-44 years old who he killed in 1982. Authorities have not released any additional information about her or what happened.

Little has confessed to 93 murders between 1970 and 2005, and the Federal Bureau of Investigation said it believes the confessions are credible. The FBI has provided 30 drawings of his victims — color portraits that were drawn by Little himself, mostly of black women.

Law enforcement agencies have confirmed 50 of the deaths, with more pending.

Many of the deaths were originally ruled overdoses or attributed to accidental or undetermined causes, the FBI said. Some bodies were never found.

On October 15, 2019, the writer went to City Park in New Orleans, Louisiana to look for a fountain and an area possibly matching the description provided by SAMUEL LITTLE as the area where he killed SARAH BROWN. LITTLE is described more fully elsewhere in the file.

The writer observed water spilling over a rock foundation, similar to a small waterfall, near the corner of North Carrollton Avenue and City Park Boulevard. The writer noted how there are small islands within the body of water in City Park. There are houses on the south side of City Park Boulevard. The writer took photos of the location, but later determined them to be of poor quality.

LITTLE described the area where he killed BROWN as a large, block sized area which was a grassy field. It was next to another block with houses. The water fountain emptied into a pool; it sounded to [REDACTED] like a park. LITTLE said it was an island which was a grassy wooded area surrounded by streets (reference 343G-NO-3087625 serial 9).

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On October 16, 2019, the writer met with [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. They met in an office conference room located at 1 Palm Drive, New Orleans, Louisiana. She offered to check with another employee who may know if the water feature was present in 1973. The writer asked her to inquire if any human remains were ever found in the general area as well.

On October 17, 2019, the writer returned to the location and took photographs. The first three, attached hereto and labeled "City Park fountain," show the following respectively: view of the fountain looking east from the bank of the pond; close up view of the fountain; view of the fountain looking northeast from the south bank of the pond. The second three, attached hereto and labeled "Views City Park," show the following respectively: view from the pond looking west; view from the pond towards City Park Boulevard; and view from City Park Boulevard looking north/northwest.

[REDACTED] called the writer on October 18, 2019 to report talking with a retired park employee named [REDACTED]. He was at [REDACTED] and retired [REDACTED]. Up until his retirement, he was the [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told her the waterfall was not there in 1973; it was on the Bayou St. John side of the road. It was built about a year before Hurricane Katrina, which would have been 2004.

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No one [REDACTED] spoke with remembered anything about human remains being located in the park. She offered to check the park board meeting minutes from the time period which are online.

He ran diagonally across the street in to the "L" Street entrance to the Mission Bar. At this point I contacted Sgt. [Redacted] via portable radio and asked him to meet me in the Colonial Motel in about ten minutes.

He walked north and then west around the corner of 19th and "L" towards Ernies Bar and I lost sight of him. He came back about one minute later and said that a ride was on the way. We waited together not speaking for about a minute and then he suggested that I get a room at the Bakersfield Hotel for my \$5 as it did not look like a taxi was going to show up. I stated I did not want to go in to the Bakersfield Hotel.

At this point a light blue color with primer spots Ford van truck came southbound on "J" from 19th. The truck was occupied by two white male adults about 20 years with blond hair. Samuel Little appeared to know the subjects as he flagged them down in the middle of the street and walked around and talked to the driver. He then called to [redacted] and myself and stated they would take us out to the Colonial Motel. He opened up the doors of the truck and the right front passenger moved to the rear of the van and Samuel told [redacted] and me to sit in the front and he would ride along with us in the back. 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On 4/16/75 a review of the Illinois Bell Telephone Directory for Springfield, Illinois, dated November, 1974, failed to reveal a current listing for [REDACTED] or SAMUEL LITTLE under their true names or aliases.

On 4/16/75 physical spot checks of Broadway Street in Springfield revealed that this street is approximately two blocks long in the downtown business district of Springfield and that these two blocks contain business buildings with street numbers of 200 and 300 Blocks of North Broadway.

Arrest checks conducted at Springfield, Illinois Police Department and Sangamon County Sheriff's Office, Springfield, were negative regarding [REDACTED] and SAMUEL LITTLE under true names and aliases.
