At approximately 8:00 am on August 4, 2012, [redacted] drove into the
parking lot of the Sikh Temple in Oak Creek, Wisconsin. As [redacted] drove
into the parking lot, he saw two white/male/adults sitting inside a pick-up
truck. [redacted] described the truck as an older model, but not beaten up.
[redacted] did not recognize either man but thought maybe they were there to
work on the temple (water repair, wall repair, etc). [redacted] was in the
temple for only about 5 minutes and when he came out and drove away, the
two males were still in their pick-up truck. [redacted] described the men as 22
- 23 years old, both wearing muscle shirts. He could not remember the make
of the vehicle, but described it as being either green or black in color.

At approximately 8:04am or 8:05 am on August 5, 2012, [redacted] drive into
the parking lot of the Sikh Temple in Oak Creek, Wisconsin, behind another
vehicle. While [redacted] could not completely see the driver of the vehicle
ahead of him, [redacted] could tell the driver was not of Indian lineage. While
[redacted] parked very close to the front door of the temple, the other driver
parked his vehicle in a parking space near the front door. [redacted] saw the
driver of the other vehicle and could tell he was a white/male/adult,
approximately 25 years old.

[redacted] entered the temple and after a short time, he came back out of
the temple and got back into his vehicle. As [redacted] drove away from the
temple, the other driver was still inside his vehicle. [redacted] described the
vehicle as an SUV. [redacted] could not remember the color of the vehicle and
thought it might have been a Chevrolet, but was not sure.

SA [redacted] showed [redacted] a video depicting a man who had been outside of
the Sikh Temple appearing to make a video recording on his cell phone.
[redacted] watched the video but did not recognize the man nor did the man seen
in the video look like any of the men [redacted] saw around the Sikh Temple.
