On 4/10/1979, the bodies were exhumed and positive identification of the bodies as FRAMPTON and FARMER were made via dental records.

On 12/1/2016, SILAS BOSTON was arrested by the FBI and charged in Federal Court with two counts of Homicide, Title 18 USC 1111.

For the prosecution of the captioned case, the AUSA's would like to have the graves of FRAMPTON and FARMER located and exhumed for examination. DNA has been collected from living family members of FRAMPTON and FARMER and DNA will be extracted from the remains and compared to the family for a positive identification.

Legat San Salvador has attempted to locate the graves for FRAMPTON and FARMER at the Puerto Barrios cemetary. Due to the size of the cemetary and lack of records at the cemetery, the graves have not been located. Sacramento appreciates the assistance of San Salvador and understands the huge difficult task of locating the graves in the Puerto Barrios cemetary.

To assist San Salvador, the Sacramento Division via the Forensic
Anthropology Department at Chico State University, Chico, California,
has been in contact with the Fundacion
de Antropologia Forense de Guatemala. and his agency
primarily focus on the collection and analysis of human remains from
the armed conflict that occurred in Guatemala in the 1980's.
