



He told the staff member that he had numerous concerns and he was asked to put them in writing. He said he did not want to put anything in writing because the FBI would kill him.

Details: On March 25, 2003, two (2) U.S. Senators and one (1) U.S. Representative received letters containing an unknown substance (granular powder). The Cobb County Fire Department (CCFD) HAZMAT Team; the Atlanta Fire Department (AFD) HAZMAT Team; and the Gwinnett County Fire Department HAZMAT Team responded to the three different incident locations and provided on-site analysis and properly packaged the letters for transport to the Georgia Public Health Laboratory (GPHL) in Decatur, GA, by law enforcement personnel for anthrax testing. Preliminary tests by the CCFD and AFD determined the unknown substance to be onion salt.

GPHL tested the Chambliss and Millers letters on 3/25/03 which resulted in negative results for Anthrax. GPHL completed the test for Anthrax on the Linder letter on 3/26/03 with the same negative results.

All three of these letters, contained in numerous plastic bags, with the corresponding negative lab reports and

properly executed chains-of-custody were released to the writer by GPHL personnel on 3/26/03.

On 3/27/03, the GPHL released two letters with negative test results for anthrax. The first letter had been received at the offices of U.S. Representative Phil Gingrey late 3/26/03 and was transported by Cobb County Hazmat to the GPHL. The return address was the Libertarian Party of Gwinnett, 3361 Poplar Drive, Lawrenceville, Georgia 30044. The second letter had been transported by Atlanta Fire/Hazmat to the GPHL early on 3/27/03 and was addressed to the "REPUBLICAN PARTY OF GEORGIA" at 5600 Roswell Rd, East Building, Suite 200, Atlanta, GA 30342. The return address was listed as the "LIBERTARIAN PARTY OF DEKALBV", "P.O. BOX 930385, NORCROSS, GA 30003". Copies of said letters and police/Hazmat reports are attached hereto.

AUSA was contacted on 3/25/03, and provided an initial positive opinion for prosecution.

It is recommended that this matter be opened as a 279C investigation and assigned.
